# Ines

## Sweater

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design

## MATERIALS

10 (11) 12 (13) skeins of Friends Cotton 8/6  
color 65

Knitting needles 4 mm, 60 cm (US 6)  
Tapestry needle  
Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/6**, Hobbii  
100% Cotton  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 105 m (115 yds)

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 20 sts x 30 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es  
k = knit  
p = purl  
k2tog = knit 2 together  
yo = yarn over  
CO = cast on  
BO = bind off  
kfb = knit in front and back loop of first  
stitch (1 st increased)

## SIZE

S (M) L (XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 47 (51) 55 (59) cm / 18.5 (20) 21.6  
(23.2)"

Length: 48 (50) 54 (60) cm / 18.8 (19.6) 21.2  
(23.6)"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

A minimalist sweater with glamorous sleeves and a boatneck. Simple to knit, entirely made with stockinette stitch, consists of a front piece, back piece and sleeves for which you pick up stitches to create ruffles.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

The sweater is made with stockinette stitch, the front and the back piece are made the same way, then you make the sleeves and ruffles.

## BODY

### FRONT PIECE

On 4 mm needles CO 94 (102) 110 (118) sts and work in stockinette stitch 134 (140) 152 (158) rows *or desired length*. In the next row, BO the middle 32 (all sizes) sts for the neckline.

Continue working the shoulders separately.

In every second row, work k2tog from the neckline side 2 times (S, M, L), 4 times (XL).

Work 6 (6) 6 (8) rows in stockinette stitch. BO all sts.

### BACK PIECE

Work as the front piece.

## SLEEVES

On 4 mm needles CO 50 (50) 52 (54) sts, work in stockinette stitch, increasing from the beginning to the end of the sleeve, in each 6th row, by 1 st on both sides.

Work 34 (36) 38 (38) rows.

\*In the 35th (37th) 39th (39th) row work as follows:

1 edge st, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo - repeat to the end of the row, 1 edge st.

On this row you will pick up stitches for the ruffle, so you can mark it with a stitch marker.

Row 36 (38) 40 (40) - purl sts.\*

Work another 34 (36) 38 (38) rows and repeat from \* to \* then, work again 34 (36) 38 (38) rows and repeat from \* to \*.

BO all sts.

## RUFFLES

### **Ruffle 1** *at the bottom of the sleeve*

In the row where the yo's are made, pick up 62 (64) 66 (66) sts.

On the next row kfb in each stitch to double the amount of stitches on the needle.

Continue to work the ruffle in stockinette stitch for 45 (47) 49 (49) rows. BO all sts.

### **Ruffle 2** *in the middle of the sleeve*

In the row where the yo's are made, pick up 74 (76) 78 (78) sts.

On the next row kfb in each stitch to double the amount of stitches on the needle.

Continue to work the ruffle in stockinette stitch for 45 (47) 49 (49) rows. BO all sts.

### **Ruffle 3** *at the top of the sleeve*

In the row where the yo's are made, pick up 86 (88) 90 (90) sts.

On the next row kfb in each stitch to double the amount of stitches on the needle.

Continue to work the ruffle in stockinette stitch for 45 (47) 49 (49) rows. BO all sts.

## FINISHING

Sew the front and back of the sweater at the shoulder. Sew the sleeves to the armholes.

Finally sew the sleeves and sides together.
