## MATERIALS

### Friends Cotton Silk

2 (3) 4 4 5 5 6 6 skeins of color 73  
2 (2) 2 3 4 5 5 5 skeins of color 57  
2 (2) 2 3 4 5 5 5 skeins of color 07  
2 (2) 3 3 4 5 5 5 skeins of color 33  
1 (1) 1 1 1 1 1 1 skein of colors 03, 21, 51,  
53, 63, 83, 100

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US G/7 - main  
pattern

Crochet hook 3.5 mm / US E/4 - flowers

Stitch markers

Darning needle

Scissor

## YARN QUALITY

 Friends Cotton Silk, Hobbii

78% Cotton, 22% Silk

50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

## GAUGE

19 sts x 18 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

Flower = 6.5 cm / 2.6"

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

tc = triple crochet

## SIZE

S (M) L XL 2XL 3XL 4XL 5XL

## MEASUREMENTS

Chest width: 38 (41) 46 51 56 61 66 71 cm /

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Introducing our charming crochet dress pattern! This dress comes in two parts – the front and the back. Starting from the top, each part is crafted separately and joined using a needle and thread to achieve a neat and even seam. The edges are crocheted using a shell stitch pattern, highlighting the contrast between colors. The addition of crochet flowers not only enhances the beauty but also brings playful and summer notes to the overall look. In this pattern, also, you'll learn how to crochet the moss stitch – a versatile and lovely pattern that you can use in any crochet project.

## INFO AND TIPS

The number of chains is a multiple of 2+3.

To achieve a longer dress, you have two options: either crochet additional moss stitch rows for each color or add another strip of color. This allows you the flexibility to customize the length according to your preference.

## MOSS STITCH PATTERN

### Front part:

Crochet 61 (73) 85 97 109 121 133 145 chains with col. 73.

Row 1 (col. 73): Sc in the third ch from the hook, \* ch 1, skip next ch, sc in next ch \*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to the end of the row.

Row 2 (col. 73): Ch 1 (count as a turning ch), turn, sc in the nearest ch-1 space, \* ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space \*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to the end of the row, in the end of the row ch 1, sc in the last ch-space.

Row 3 (col. 73): Ch 1 (count as a turning ch), turn, sc in the nearest ch-1 space, \* ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space \*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to the end of the row, in the end of the row ch 1, skip the last sc, sc in the turning ch.

Repeat Row 3 until you reach 22 rows.

Change the color of the yarn to the col. 57 and crochet 22 rows of the moss stitch pattern.

Change the color of the yarn to the col. 07 and crochet 5 rows of the moss stitch pattern.  
After that, start crocheting an increasing row:

Increasing row: Ch 1 (count as a turning ch), turn, sc in the nearest ch-1 space, ch 1, sc in the same space, \* ch 1, sc in next ch-1 space \*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* to the end of the row, in the end of the row ch 1, skip the last sc, sc in the turning ch, ch 1, sc in the same ch.

\* Crochet 4 rows of the moss stitch pattern, crochet an increasing row \*\*, repeat 3 times, crochet a row of the moss stitch pattern.

Change the color of the yarn to the col. 33 and crochet 3 rows of the moss stitches, after that - an increasing row. Keep crocheting the moss stitches until you reach 22 rows.

There are 5 increases on the sides, marked with blue pins in the first photo below.

Change the color of the yarn to the col. 73 and crochet 22 rows of the moss stitch pattern without increasings.

Crochet the back part in the same way. Lay 2 parts with right sides facing each other and make side seams with a needle and thread.



## SHOULDER STRAPS

Ensure a 5 cm (2") margin from the seam line on the front part and a 7 cm (3") margin on the back part. Indicate 7 ch-1 spaces from the margined areas.

Connect the col. 33 to the marked space on the front part and crochet the moss stitch pattern across 7 ch-1 spaces. Crochet 45 (45) 48 50 50 52 52 52 rows of the moss stitch pattern.

Sew the shoulders strap to the marked place on the back part with a needle and thread. Crochet the second shoulder strap in the same way.



## EDGE

Connect the col. 73 to any ch-1 space of the bottom, neckline or armholes.

Round 1: Ch 1, sc in the same space, skip next ch-1 space, 5 dc in next ch-1 space, \* sc in next ch-1 space, skip next ch-1 space, 5 dc in next ch-1 space \*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* around, join with sl st to the first sc.

## FLOWER PATTERN

The quantity of flowers can be tailored to your preference. I crocheted ten flowers and then sewed them on the dress.

The color scheme of flowers:

1. The middle col. 83, petals col. 51.
2. The middle col. 53, petals col. 21.
3. The middle col. 63, petals col. 51.
4. The middle col. 100, petals col. 03.
5. The middle col. 51, petals col. 53.
6. The middle col. 21, petals col. 83.
7. The middle col. 21, petals col. 63.
8. The middle col. 03, petals col. 53.
9. The middle col. 83, petals col. 03.
10. The middle col. 51, petals col. 100.

Round 1: Make a magic ring, ch 1 (don't count as a stitch), 6 sc into the circle, join with sl st to the first sc.

Round 2: Ch 1 (don't count as a stitch), 2 sc in each sc around, join with sl st to the first sc. 12 sc.

Round 3: Ch 1 (don't count as a stitch), 2 sc in the first sc, sc in next sc, \* 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc \*\*, rep from \* to \*\* to the end of the round, join with sl st to the first sc. 18 sc.

Round 4: Ch 1 (don't count as a stitch), 2 sc in the first sc, sc in next 2 sc, \* 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc \*\*, rep from \* to \*\* to the end of the round, join with sl st to the first sc. 24 sc.

Round 5 (change the color of the yarn): Connect the yarn to any sc, ch 1 (don't count as a stitch), \* dc and tc in next sc, 3 tc in next sc, tc and dc in next sc, sl st in next sc \*\*, rep from \* to \*\* to the end of the round, join with sl st to the first ch. 6 petals
