# Sunshine

#### **MATERIALS**

# Friends Cotton 8/8

2 skeins of color 24 1 skein of color 40

Crochet hook 5mm (US H/8) Darning needle

# **YARN QUALITY**

**Friends Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii 100% cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 75 m (82 yds)

# **GAUGE**

18 sts using crochet hook 5mm (US H/8) = 10 cm / 4"

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
scblo = single crochet through the back
loop only
dc = double crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)
sl st = slip stitch

#### SIZES

Child (Teen)

# **MEASUREMENTS**

Diameter (measured across top): 15.75 (17) cm / 6.25 (6.75)"

Length (crown to brim): 20.25 cm / 8" 2 sizes: 50.75 (55.75) cm / 20" (22")

#### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

The Sunshine Bucket Hat is a top down crocheted hat that uses intarsia crochet to create the rays of the sun at the brim. Starting with a magic circle, stitches are added in the round with increases each round to create the crown. Once the desired measurement for the size you've chosen is reached, rounds continue with and without increases to create the body of the hat. The brim is created with increase rounds followed by intarsia rounds to create the rays of the sun.

# **INFO AND TIPS**

Ch 2 at the beginning of each dc round and ch 1 at the beginning of each sc round.

Beginning ch does not count as st. Slip stitch to the first st of that round.

For both sizes, follow rounds to and including round 8.

When working intarsia rounds at the brim, the color not in use is carried throughout the round (crocheted over).

When changing colors, work the stitch as you normally would, but when pulling through the last loops to complete the stitch, use the new color.

When the first st of the next round calls for a new color, complete the sl st at the end of the current round with the new color, so your next round ch will start with the new color.

# **CROWN**

Make a magic circle. Dc 12 in circle.

Round 2: 2 dc in each st around. (24)

Round 3: 2 dc in first st, dc in next st. Repeat around. (36)

Round 4: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 2 sts. Repeat around. (48)

Round 5: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 3 sts. Repeat around. (60)

Round 6: scblo in each st around. (60)

Round 7: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 4 sts. Repeat around. (72)

Round 8: scblo in each st around. (72)

#### **BODY**

# **CHILD**

Round 9: dc in each st around. (72)

Round 10: scblo in each st around. (72)

Rounds 11-14: Repeat rounds 9 and 10.

Round 15: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 2 sts. Repeat around. (96)

Round 16: scblo in each st around. (96)

Round 17: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 3 sts. Repeat around. (120)



Continue to Brim Section.

#### **TEEN**

Round 9: 2 dc in first st, dc in the next 5 sts. Repeat around. (84)

Round 10: scblo in each st around. (84)

Rounds 11-14: Repeat rounds 9 and 10.

Round 15: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 6 sts. Repeat around. (96)

Round 16: scblo in each st around. (96)

Round 17: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 3 sts. Repeat around. (120)

Continue to Brim Section.

#### **BRIM**

Round numbers start over to coincide with the chart.

Round 1: With color 24, scblo x1, change to color 40, scblo x 1, change to color 24, scblo x 13.

Round 2: With color 40, dc x 3, change to color 24, dc x 12. Repeat around.

Round 3: With color 40, scblo x 4, change to color 24, scblo x 10, change to color 40, scblo x 1. Repeat around.

Round 4: With color 40, dc x 5, change to color 24, dc x 8, change to color 40, dc x 2. Repeat around.

Round 5: With color 40, scblo x 6, change to color 24, scblo x 6, change to color 40, scblo x 3. Repeat around.

Round 6: With color 40, scblo x 7, change to color 24, scblo x 4, change to color 40, scblo x 4. Repeat around.


Round 7: With color 40, scblo x 9, change to color 24, scblo x 1, change to color 40, scblo x 5. Repeat around.

Round 8: Using color 40, sl st in each st around. Break yarn. Weave in ends.
