# Rose

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 color 48 **(A)**  
1 skein of Diablo color 01 **(B)**

Crochet hook 3.75 mm / US F/5  
Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US 7  
Metal stitch markers  
Yarn needle  
Scissors

## YARN QUALITY

 **Diablo**, Hobbii  
40 % Acrylic, 30 % Mohair, 30 % Polyamide  
25 g / 0.9 oz = 225 m / 246 yds

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii  
100 % Cotton  
50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 174 yds

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain  
sl st = slip stitch  
blo = back loop only  
hdc = half double crochet  
dc = double crochet  
tr = treble crochet  
Special stitch: third loop (3rd loop) = a horizontal bar behind the top loops of a hdc st in which to work

## SIZE

Rose - One size  
Flower Pieces - Small (Medium) Large

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 5 (6) 7.5 cm / 2" (2.5") 3"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

The rose is crocheted as 3 separate flower pieces that are then layered and joined together.

The separate flower pieces can also be used as stand alone flowers.

This pattern uses stitches such as chains, half double crochet, double crochet and treble crochet.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

To create the rose, 3 separate flower pieces (S, M, L) are worked and then layered and sewn on top of each other to form the rose.

The separate flower pieces can also be used as stand alone flowers.

Color **A** is held double only when working the Large flower.

Color **A** is held as a single strand when working the Small and Medium flower.

Color **B** is always held double no matter what flower is being made.

The Large flower uses a 4.5 mm crochet hook and the Small and Medium flower use a 3.75 mm crochet hook.

Beginning chain stitches do not count as a stitch.

**Before starting:** Create a second ball of yarn from each of the colors. Make each ball be about  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the entire skein of yarn. If you have a scale, to do this, divide the grams of each skein by 4, that is the weight the second ball should be.

Friends Cotton 8/4 (**A**) = about 12.5 g ball; Diablo (**B**) = about 6.25 g ball.

## LARGE

With **A** double stranded and the 4.5 mm hook, ch 6, join to first ch with a sl st.

**Round 1:** Working around the entire loop just made, 12 hdc around, join to first st with a sl st. *12 hdc*

**Round 2:** Ch 3, working this round in the 3rd loop of the hdc sts, 5 tr in each st around, join to first st with a sl st. *60 tr*

**Round 3:** Join **B** double stranded, fasten off **A**, ch 1, in the **blo** sl st in each st around, join to first st with a sl st. *60 sl sts*. Fasten off **B**.

Weave in ends.

## MEDIUM

With **A** single stranded and the 3.75 mm hook, ch 6, join to first ch with a sl st.

**Rounds 1-3:** Repeat Rounds 1-3 of Large flower. Fasten off **B**.

Weave in ends.

## SMALL

With **A** single stranded and the 3.75 mm hook, ch 5, join to first ch with a sl st.

**Round 1:** Working around the entire loop just made, 10 hdc around, join to first st with a sl st. *10 hdc*

**Round 2:** Ch 2, working this round in the 3rd loop of the hdc sts, 6 dc in each st around, join to first st with a sl st. *60 dc*

**Round 3:** Join **B** double stranded, fasten off **A**, ch 1, in the **blo** sl st in each st around, join to first st with a sl st. *60 sl sts*. Fasten off **B**.

## Joining flowers

Place the Large flower flat on a table, place the medium flower on top of the Large, then place the Small flower on top of the Medium. Cut a 30.5 cm / 12" strand of A. Use a yarn needle to sew the flowers together around the centre, weave in ends. The flower can then be attached using metal stitch markers so that it can be removable.
