Cloud

Children's Tank Top

MATERIALS

Amigo

1 skein of colour A02 – Yarn A
2 skeins of colour A16 - Yarn B

Circular needle 5 mm (US 8)
Stitch holder
Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Amigo**, Hobbii
100% HB Acrylic
50 g (1.75 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 21 sts x 29 rows

SIZE

4-6/6-8/8-10/10-12/12-14 years old

MEASUREMENTS

To fit a body chest of: 59/63/69/75/83 cm –
23.25"/24.75"/27.25"/29.50"/32.75"
Back Length: 32/37/42/46/48 cm –
12.50"/14.50"/16.50"/18"/19"

Adorable cloud tank top to wear on a sunny day. Check out the cloud cloche hat to go with it.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

Kf&b = Knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together

SKP = (slip, knit, pass) Slip the first stitch, knit the second stitch then pass the first stitch over the second one – you have decrease 1 stitch

INFO AND TIPS

This top has negative ease and is supposed to stretch quite a lot to give that snug fit.

All pieces are knitted flat individually, the front, the back, the sleeve edges and the clouds. The collar edge is knitted in the round.

FRONT

C/on 48/52/56/60/64 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – (K2, P2) repeat until the end of the row

Repeat the first row 11 times

Change to yarn B

Next row – K row

Next row – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows until your piece measure 20/25/30/34/36 cm –

7.75"/9.75"/11.75"/13.50"/14.25" from the c/on edge, finishing on a P row

You are now going to start the V neck

You are going to work on the last 24/26/28/30/32 sts only and leave the rest of the sts on a sts holder

Next row – K to the last 2 sts, K2tog (22/24/26/28/30 sts)

Next row – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 10/10/10/12/12 sts left, finishing on a P row

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Re-join the 24/26/28/30/32 sts from the sts holder

Next row – SKP, K to the end of the row (22/24/26/28/30 sts)

Next row – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 10/10/10/12/12 sts left, finishing on a P row

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

BACK

C/on 48/52/56/60/64 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – (K2, P2) repeat until the end of the row

Repeat the first row 11 times

Change to yarn B

Next row – K row

Next row – P row

Repeat the last 2 rows until your piece measure the same as your front, finishing on a P row

Next row – K10/10/10/12/12, slide the next 28/32/36/36/40 sts on a sts holder,

K10/10/10/12/12

C/off both sets of 10/10/10/12/12 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Join by sewing the front and the back shoulder seam.

COLLAR EDGE

Pick up evenly a multiple of 4 sts all around the collar with yarn A, by starting down the left side of the neck, following up the right side of the neck and finishing by K28/32/36/36/40 sts from the sts holder

This is knitted in the round as follow:

Round 1 – (K2, P2) repeat to the end of the round

Repeat the last round 6 times

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

SLEEVE EDGE (make 2)

Pick up evenly a multiple of 4 sts with yarn A, 21/22/23/24/25 cm – 8.25"/8.75"/9"/9.50"/9.75" down the front from the shoulder seam and the same 21/22/23/24/25 cm – 8.25"/8.75"/9"/9.50"/9.75" down the back from the shoulder seam

Row 1 – (K2, P2) repeat to the end of the row

Repeat the last row 6 times

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

CLOUD (make 11)

C/on 20 with yarn A

Row 1 – K row

Row 2 – C/on 1, K until the last st, Kf&b (22 sts)

Rows 3 & 4 – K 2 rows

Row 5 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (20 sts)

Rows 6 & 7 – K 2 rows

Row 8 – SKP, K13 TURN YOUR WORK

Row 9 – K10

Continue on those 10 sts only

Row 10 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (8 sts)

Rows 11 to 14 – K 4 rows

Row 15 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (6 sts)

Rows 16 & 17 – K 2 rows

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Re-join the group of 5 sts

Next row – K3, K2tog (4 sts)

Next row – SKP, K2 (3 sts)

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Re-join the group of 4 sts

Next row – SKP, K2tog (2 sts)

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Sew the sleeve edges together and then the side seams of the tank top.

Add each cloud to the top front and back as per the pictures or wherever you feel like it.

Weave in all ends.
