Panettone

1 1 (1) 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 skein of color 05 1 1 (1) 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 skein of color 16 1 1 (1) 1 1 1 1 1 1 skein of color 19 1 1 (1) 1 1 1 1 1 1 skein of color 08 4 5 (6) 8 9 11 12 13 14 skeins of color 03

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US 7 Stitch markers Darning needle Scissor

YARN QUALITY

Panettone, Hobbii 87% Cotton, 7% Polyamide, 6% Metallic fiber 50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

GAUGE

12 rounds square = 29 cm x 29 cm / 11.4" x 11.4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
dc3tog = 3 dc crochet together
rep = repeat
granny stitch = 3 dc in the same ch-1 space

INFO AND TIPS

The length of the dress depends on how many rounds you will crochet in the bottom part. You will need one skein of yarn for each 8 rounds (41 granny stitches in a round).

FRONT PART

Round 1 (col. 05): Make a magic ring, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 11 dc into the ring, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 2 (col. 05): Ch 4 (count as the first dc plus ch-1), * dc in next dc, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 3 (col. 05): SI st in the first ch-1 space, ch 2 (count as a part of the dc3tog), dc2tog in the same space, ch 2, * dc3tog in next ch-1 space, ch 2 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sI st to top of ch 2. 12 petals. Fasten off.

Change the color of the yarn.

Round 4 (col. 16): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 2 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, * ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-1) twice, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space **, rep from * to ** twice, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-1) twice, join with sl st to top of ch 2.

Round 5 (col. 16): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-2 space, ch 2 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 3 times, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space **, rep from * to ** twice, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 3 times, join with sI st to top of ch 2.

Round 6 (col. 16): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-2 space, ch 2 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 4 times, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space **, rep from * to ** twice, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 4 times, join with sI st to top of ch 2. Fasten off.

Change the color of the yarn.



Round 7 (col. 19): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 2 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, * ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 5 times, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space **, rep from * to ** twice, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 5 times, join with sl st to top of ch 2.

Round 8 (col. 19): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-2 space, ch 2 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, * ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 6 times, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space **, rep from * to ** twice, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 6 times, join with sI st to top of ch 2.

Round 9 (col. 19): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-2 space, ch 2 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, * ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 7 times, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space **, rep from * to ** twice, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 7 times, join with sI st to top of ch 2. Fasten off.

Change the color of the yarn.

Round 10 (col. 08): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 2 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, * ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 8 times, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space **, rep from * to ** twice, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 8 times, join with sl st to top of ch 2.

Round 11 (col. 08): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-2 space, ch 2 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, * ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 9 times, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space **, rep from * to ** twice, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 9 times, join with sI st to top of ch 2.

Round 12 (col. 08): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-2 space, ch 2 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, * ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 10 times, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space **, rep from * to ** twice, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) 10 times, join with sI st to top of ch 2. Fasten off.

How you can see your square is increasing. Change the color of the yarn. Continue crocheting 4, 6, (8),10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20 rounds of granny stitches with col. 03. Don't cut the yarn.





SHOULDERS STRAPS

Mark the nearest ch-2 space, count 6 ch-1 spaces and mark the width of the shoulder strap too. Mark the same number of ch-spaces from the other side (photo 1 below).

Please note: the number of the marked spaces can be different. It depends on the width of the neckline you want to get.

Right shoulder (when wearing the dress)

Row 1: SI st in the nearest ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space) 6 times.

Row 2: Ch 4 (count as the first dc plus ch-1), turn, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space) 5 times, ch 1, dc in the last dc (photo 2 below).

Left shoulder (when wearing the dress)

Row 1: Connect the yarn to the red marked stitch, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space) 6 times.

Row 2: Ch 4 (count as the first dc plus ch-1), turn, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space) 5 times, ch 1, dc in the last dc (photo 3 below).







BACK PART

Crochet the back part in the same way. Lay the front and the back part with right sides facing each other. Mark the places for the armholes and work side seams and shoulders seams with sl st through the back loops only.





BOTTOM

Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space of the bottom and crochet 19 rounds of granny stitches.

The last round of the bottom: Connect the yarn to any ch-1 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 5 dc in the same space, sc in next ch-1 space, 6 dc in next ch-1 space, * sc in next ch-1 space, 6 dc in next ch-1 space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to the first st.



ARMHOLES AND NECKLINE

Work a row of granny stitches around the armholes, crochet the last round of the bottom around armholes. Crochet the last round of the bottom around the neck.
