MATERIALS

Honey Bunny Candy

1 skein of Color 01

Honey Bunny

1 skein of Color 22, 33, 45, 62 and 93

Honey Bunny Shine

1 skein of Color 01

Amigo

1 skein of Color 01, 12 and 55

Crochet hook 5.5 mm / US I

Crochet hook 4mm/ US G

Yarn Needle

Scissors

Stuffing

YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny**, Hobbii

100% Polyester

100 g / 3.5 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

 **Honey Bunny Candy**, Hobbii

85% Polyester, 15% Polyamide

100 g / 3.5 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

 **Honey Bunny Shine**, Hobbii

100% Polyester

100 g / 3.5 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

 **Amigo**, Hobbii

100% Acrylic

50 g / 1.75 oz = 175 m / 191 yds

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: Approx. 33 cm / 13 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

Sprinkles is a cuddly colorful friend made with Honey Bunny.

The pattern is worked in the round. You will work with 2 different weight yarns and 2 different size hooks. Body is made using a super bulky 6 weight yarn and the eyes are made using a light 3 weight yarn.

The pattern includes a lot of color changes as well as working on the surface of the project.

ABBREVIATIONS

- Mr: Magic Ring/Circle
- Sc: Single Crochet
- Inc: Increase
- Dec: Decrease
- Hdc: Half Double Crochet
- HdcInc: Half Double Crochet Increase
- Dc: Double Crochet
- Trc: Triple Crochet/Treble Crochet
- Slst: Slip Stitch
- Blo: Back Loop Only

INFO AND TIPS

- Pattern is worked in continuous rounds, so you will not need to ch 1 at the end of the round unless instructed to. You can use a stitch marker to help mark the end of your rows/rounds.
- Gauge is not important for this project since it is not worn, so adjust your hook size as needed to match your personal preference and yarn you're using.
- The "x whatever #" after the parenthesis indicates that you should repeat what is in parenthesis that many times. Example "(Sc, Inc) x3" would be the equivalent of "Sc, Inc, Sc, Inc, Sc, Inc".
- The number at the end of each round in parenthesis is the stitch count; it is how many stitches you should have in that row/round after completing all of the steps.
- Work everything in Honey Bunny yarn with your 5.5mm hook and everything in Amigo yarn with your 4mm.

HEAD & BODY

Work with color: Honey Bunny Candy 01

Rnd 1: Mr 6 - (6)

Rnd 2: Inc - (12)

Rnd 3: (Sc, Inc)x6 - (18)

Rnd 4: Sc, Inc (2sc, Inc)x5, Sc - (24)

Rnd 5: (3sc, Inc)x6 - (30)

Rnd 6: 2sc, Inc, (4sc, Inc)x5, 2sc - (36)

Rnds 7-9: Sc around (3 rounds) - (36)

Rnd 10: 15sc, 6inc, 15sc - (42)

Rnd 11-12: Sc around (2 rounds) - (42)

Rnd 13, 15sc, 6dec, 15sc - (36)

Rnd 14: 2sc, Dec, (4sc, Dec)x5, 2sc - (30)

Rnd 15: (3sc, Dec)x6 - (24)

Rnd 16: Sc, Dec (2sc, Dec)x5, Sc - (18)

- Start stuffing and continue to stuff as you work.

Rnd 17: (Sc, Dec)x6 - (12)

Rnd 18: (Sc, Inc)x6 - (18)

Rnd 19: Sc, Inc (2sc, Inc)x5, Sc - (24)

Rnd 20: (3sc, Inc)x6 - (30)

Rnd 21: 2sc, Inc, (4sc, Inc)x5, 2sc - (36)

Rnds 22-23. Sc around (2 rounds) - (36)

Rnd 24: 2sc, Dec, (4sc, Dec)x5, 2sc - (30)

Rnds 25-27. Sc around (3 rounds) - (30)

Rnd 28: (3sc, Dec)x6 - (24)

Rnds 29-30. Sc around (2 rounds) - (24)

Rnd 31: Sc, Dec (2sc, Dec)x5, Sc - (18)

Rnd 32: Sc around - (18)

Rnd 33: (Sc, Dec)x6 - (12)

- Stuff the next few rows very lightly you will need to be able to roll the tail up.

Rnds 34-52: Sc around (20 rounds) - (12)

Rnd 53: Dec - (6)

- Finish off leaving a long tail to close up any gap you may have at the bottom and secure the tail to the body once rolled.
- Roll the tail onto itself and secure it to the body.



FINS (Make 2)

Work with colors: Honey Bunny 22, 33, 43, 62, and 93

Rnd 1: **In Honey Bunny 22** - Ch 7 - (7)

Rnd 2: Starting in the second Ch from the hook 6sc down the chain then work 6sc up the other side of the Ch - (12) - **Change to Honey Bunny 33**

Rnd 3: Sc around - (12) - **Change to Honey Bunny 43**

Rnd 4: (Dec, 4sc)x2 - (10) - **Change to Honey Bunny 62**

Rnd 5: (Dec, 3sc)x2 - (8) - **Change to Honey Bunny 93**

Rnd 6: (Dec, 2sc)x2 - (6)

- Finish off leaving a long tail to attach to the body.
- Attach the fins to the sides of the body about 3 rows from the head and about 12 stitches apart.



BELLY PATCH

Work with colors: Honey Bunny 22, 33, 43, 62, 93, and Honey Bunny Candy 01

Row 1: **In Honey Bunny 22** - Ch 2 - (2)

Row 2: Starting in the second Ch from the hook Inc, Ch 1 and turn - (2)

Row 3: 2inc, **change to Honey Bunny 33**, Ch 1 and turn - (4)

Row 4: Sc, 2inc, Sc, Ch 1 and turn - (6)

Row 5: Sc, Inc, 2sc, Inc Sc, **Change to Honey Bunny 43**, Ch 1 and turn - (8)

Row 6: (2sc, Inc)x2, 2sc, Ch 1 and turn - (10)

Row 7: (2sc, Dec)x2, 2sc **Change to Honey Bunny 62**, Ch 1 and turn - (8)

Row 8: Sc, Dec, 2sc, Dec, Sc, Ch 1 and turn - (6)

Row 9: Sc 2dec, Sc, **Change to Honey Bunny 93**, Ch 1 and turn - (4)

Row 10: 2dec, Ch 1 and turn - (2)

Row 11: Dec, **Change to Honey Bunny Candy 01**, Ch 1 - (1)

Row 12: Sc around the entire piece - (22)

- Finish off leaving a long tail to attach to the body.
- Attach the belly patch centered on the front of the body about 3 rows below the head.



HORN

Work with color: Honey Bunny Candy 45

Rnd 1: Mr 4 - (4)

Rnd 2: Blo - (Sc, Inc)x2 - (6)

Rnd 3: Blo - Sc around - (6)

Rnd 4: Blo - (2sc, Inc)x2 - (8)

Rnd 5: Blo - Sc around - (8)

Rnd 6: Blo - (3sc, Inc)x2 - (10)

Rnd 7: Blo - Sc around - (10)

- Finish off leaving a long tail to attach to the head and stuff.
- Attach the horn centered on the top front of the head about 1 row away from the Mr.



SPIKES

Work with colors: Honey Bunny 22, 33, 43, 62, and 93

Rnd 1: For the spikes we will be working them directly onto the head and down the body. To make this easier I will break it down into sections by color. Work anything between asterisks ** in the same stitch, and change colors at the end of each section:

- **In Honey Bunny 22** - Use a Slst to attach your yarn to the head just behind the horn centered on the head then Sc back into the same stitch, *Sc, Hdc*, *Dc, Trc, Dc*, *Hdc, Sc*, Slst, *Sc, Hdc*, *Dc, Trc, Dc*, *Hdc, Sc*, Slst
- **In Honey Bunny 33** - (*Sc, Hdc*, *Dc, Trc, Dc*, *Hdc, Sc*, Slst)x2
- **In Honey Bunny 43** - At this point you should be where the head turns into the body, Sc into the indent where the head and body meet (*this will keep your next spike from getting bunched up*) *Sc, Hdc*, *Dc, Trc, Dc*, *Sc, Hdc*, Slst, *Sc, Hdc*, *Hdc, Dc, Hdc*, *Hdc, Sc*, Slst
- **In Honey Bunny 62** - *Sc, Hdc*, *Hdc, Dc, Hdc*, *Hdc, Sc*, Slst, Sc, Hdclnc, Sc, Slst - Change to Honey Bunny 93
- **In Honey Bunny 93** - Sc, Hdclnc, Sc, 2slst, Inc, Slst
- Finish off and weave in your ends.



EYES (Make 2)

Work with colors: Amigo 01, 12, and 55

Rnd 1: In **Amigo 01** - Mr 8 - (8) - **Change to Amigo 12**

Rnd 2: Blo - 4slst, working through both loops - , 4inc - (12)

Rnd 3: Blo - 4slst, working through both loops - (Sc, Inc)x4 - (16)

Rnd 4: Blo - 4slst, working through both loops - 2sc, Inc, Sc - **Change to Amigo 55** - Sc, Inc, 2sc, Inc, Sc - **Change to Amigo 12** - Sc, Inc - (20)

Rnd 5: Blo - Slst around - (20)

- Finish off leaving a long tail to attach to the head.
- Attach the eyes to the sides of the head about 2 rows below the horn and 7 stitches apart.
