## Bucket Hat

## MATERIALS

A: 1 skein of Friends Cotton $8 / 6$ col. 30
B: 1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/6 col. 26
C: 1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/6 col. 23

Crochet hook 3.5mm
Embroidery needle
Stitch markers
Scissors
Tape measure

## YARN QUALITY

(22) Friends Cotton 8/6, Hobbii

100 \% Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g} / 1.75 \mathrm{oz} .=105 \mathrm{~m} / 115 \mathrm{yds}$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=5$ rounds

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
st = stitch
slst = slip stitch
dc = double crochet
inc =increase by 2 stitches in 1 stitch
CC = change colour
\{...\} = end stitch count
*...* $=$ repeat between **

## SIZE

Toddler(Child, Adult)

## MEASUREMENTS

To fit head circumference: 48.25(50.75, 55.75)
cm / 19(20, 21-22) inches

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Here is the Picnic Bucket Hat in a nice checkerboard pattern. The hat is made in rounds with 3 colours starting at the crown and ending at the brim.

Experience of colour changing is recommended.

## INFO AND TIPS

- Colour 30/26/23 is stated as colour A/B/C throughout the pattern
- Throughout the pattern, you will be using two colours per row. Colour B is used for every row, whereas colours A and C are used every two rows.
- Change colour by stopping crocheting right before you pull through the last two loops of a dc, place the new colour over the hook and pull it through the last two loops
- Carry the yarn you are not using along the back of the work and work over it to lock it in place


## Special Stitches:

Fake Double Crochet = insert your hook into the first st and complete a sc like normal. Insert your hook into the first of the two vertical loops, complete a sc like normal.


Crab Stitch = this stitch is worked from left to right if right-handed and right to left if left handed. Instructions written for right-handers. Insert the hook from front to back in the st to the right, yo and pull through the st, yo and pull through both loops - this makes 1 crab st.

## CROWN

Rnd 1: With colour A, start with a magic circle, fake dc, dc 11, CC to C, \{12 dc $\}$

 CC to B dc-inc $1, \underline{\text { CC to } C, ~ s l s t ~ t o ~ f i r s t ~ d c, ~}\{24 \mathrm{dc}\}$


Rnd 3: fake dc, dc-inc 1 in next st, * ${ }^{\text {CC to } B, ~ d c ~ 1, ~ d c-i n c ~ 1, ~ C C ~ t o ~ C, ~ d c ~ 1, ~ d c-i n c ~ 1 * ~ r e p e a t ~} 5$ times, CC to $\mathrm{B}, \mathrm{dc} 1$, dc-inc 1 , slst to first dc, $\{36 \mathrm{dc}\}$

 repeat 5 times, $\underline{C C}$ to $C, d c 2$ dc-inc $1, \underline{C C}$ to $B$, slst to first dc, $\{48 \mathrm{dc}\}$

 repeat 5 times, CC to A, dc 3, dc-inc 1, $\underline{\text { CC to C slst to first dc, }\{60 \mathrm{dc}\}}$


Rnd 6: fake dc, dc 3, dc-inc 1, * $\underline{\text { CC to B B }}$ dc 4, dc-inc 1, $\underline{\mathrm{CC} \text { to C }, ~ d c ~ 4, ~ d c-i n c ~ 1 * ~ r e p e a t ~} 5$ times, CC to B, dc 4, dc-inc 1, CC to C , slst to first dc, \{72 dc\}

 CC to B dc 5, dc-inc 1, slst to first dc, \{84 dc\}
Toddler size - do not fasten off, proceed onto Sides


Rnd 8: fake dc, dc 5, dc-inc 1, * $\underline{\text { CC to } A, ~ d c ~ 6, ~ d c-i n c ~ 1, ~} \underline{\text { CC to B }, ~ d c ~ 6, ~ d c-i n c ~ 1 * ~ r e p e a t ~} 5$ times, CC to C, dc 6, dc-inc 1, CC to B, slst to first dc, $\{96 \mathrm{dc}\}$
Child size - do not fasten off, proceed onto Sides
Rnd 9: fake dc, dc 6, dc-inc in next st, * $\underline{\text { CC to A }, ~ d c ~ 7, ~ d c-i n c ~ 1, ~ C C ~ t o ~ B, ~ d c ~ 7, ~ d c-i n c ~ 1 * ~ r e p e a t ~}$ 5 times, CC to A, dc 7, dc-inc 1, CC to C slst to first dc, $\{108 \mathrm{dc}\}$

## SIDES

## Toddler Size only:

Rnd 1: using colour $B$, fake dc, dc 6, * $\underline{\mathrm{CC} \text { to } A, ~ d c ~ 7, ~} \underline{\mathrm{CC} \text { to } B}$, dc 7* repeat 5 times, $\underline{\mathrm{CC} \text { to } \mathrm{C}}, \mathrm{dc}$ 7, $\underline{\text { CC to B }}$, slst to first dc, $\{84 \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 2: fake dc, dc 6, * $\underline{\text { CC to } A, ~ d c ~ 7, ~} \underline{(C \text { to } B}$, dc 7* repeat 5 times, $\underline{C C}$ to $A, d c 7, \underline{C C}$ to C slst to first dc, \{84 dc\}

## Child Size only:

 to first dc, \{96 dc\}

## All Sizes:

Rnd 3(2,1): using colour C, fake dc, dc 6(7,8), *CC to B, dc 7(8,9), CC to C, dc 7(8,9)* repeat 5 times, CC to B, dc 7(8,9), CC to C slst to first dc, $\{84(96,108) \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 4(3,2): fake dc, dc 6(7,8), *CC to B, dc 7(8,9), CC to C, dc 7(8,9)* repeat 5 times, CC to B, dc $7(8,9)$, slst to first dc, $\{84(96,108) d c\}$

Rnd 5(4,3): fake dc, dc 6(7,8), *CC to A, dc 7(8,9), CC to B, dc 7(8,9)* repeat 5 times, CC to $A$, dc $7(8,9), \underline{C C}$ to B, slst to first dc, $\{84(96,108) \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 6(5,4): fake dc, dc 6(7,8), *CC to A, dc 7(8,9), CC to B, dc 7(8,9)* repeat 5 times, CC to A, dc $7(8,9), \underline{C C}$ to $C_{1}$ slst to first dc, $\{84(96,108)$ dc $\}$

Repeat the last 4 rounds until you have a total of $\mathbf{1 6}(16,17)$ rounds from round 1 of the crown. Do not fasten off.

## BRIM

## Toddler Size only

Rnd 1: using colour B, fake dc, dc 5, dc-inc 1, *CC to A, dc 6, dc-inc 1, CC to B , dc 6, dc-inc 1* repeat 5 times, $\underline{C C}$ to $A$, dc 6 , dc-inc 1, CC to $C$, slst to first dc, $\{96 \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 2: fake dc, dc 6, dc-inc 1, *CC to B, dc 7, dc-inc 1, CC to C, dc 7, dc-inc 1* repeat 5 times, CC to B dc 7, dc-inc 1, CC to C, slst to first dc, $\{108 \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 3: fake dc, dc 7, dc-inc 1, *CC to B , dc 8, dc-inc 1, CC to C , dc 8, dc-inc 1,* repeat 5 times, $\underline{C C}$ to $B, d c 8$, dc-inc 1, CC to A , slst to first dc, $\{120 \mathrm{dc}\}$
Proceed onto the final row below.

## Child Size only

Rnd 1: using colour B, fake dc, dc 6, dc-inc 1, *CC to A, dc 7, dc-inc 1, CC to B , dc 7, dc-inc 1* repeat 5 times, $\underline{C C}$ to $A, d c 7, d c-i n c 1, \underline{C C}$ to $C$, slst to first dc, $\{108 \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 2: fake dc, dc 7, dc-inc * $\underline{C C}$ to $B$, dc 8, dc-inc 1, $\underline{C C}$ to $C$, dc 8, dc-inc 1* repeat 5 times, $\underline{C C}$ to B, dc 8, dc-inc 1, CC to C, slst to first dc, $\{120 \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 3: fake dc, dc 8, dc-inc-1, *CC to B, dc 9, dc-inc 1, CC to C, dc 9, dc-inc 1* repeat 5 times, CC to B, dc 9, dc-inc 1, slst to first dc, $\{132 \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 4: fake dc, dc 9, *CC to A, dc 10, CC to B, dc 10* repeat 5 times, $\underline{C C \text { to } A, ~ d c ~ 10, ~ s l s t ~ t o ~}$ first dc, \{132 dc\}
Proceed onto the final row below.

## Adult Size only

Rnd 1: using colour C, fake dc, dc 7, dc-inc, *CC to B, dc 8, dc-inc 1, CC to C, dc 8, dc-inc 1,* repeat 5 times, $\underline{C C}$ to $B, d c 8$, dc-inc $1, \underline{C C}$ to $C$, slst to first dc, $\{120 \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 2: fake dc, dc 8, dc-inc, *CC to B, dc 9, dc-inc 1, CC to C, dc 9, dc-inc 1* repeat 5 times, CC to B, dc 9, dc-inc 1, slst to first dc, $\{132 \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 3: fake dc, dc 9, dc-inc-1, *CC to A dc 10, dc-inc 1, CC to B , dc 10, dc-inc 1* repeat 5 times, $\underline{C C}$ to $A$, dc 10, dc-inc $1, \underline{C C}$ to $B$, slst to first dc, $\{144 \mathrm{dc}\}$

Rnd 4: fake dc, dc 10, *CC to A dc 11, CC to B dc 11* repeat 5 times, CC to A, dc 11, slst to first dc, \{144 dc\}
Proceed onto the final row below.

## All Sizes

Final Row: using colour A, ch 1, crab st in each st around, fasten off with a needle join to the first st. $\{120(132,144)$ crab sts $\}$

And you are done!
