

CROCHET PATTERN

Shiny Blossom

T-shirt

MATERIALS

7 (8) 8 (9) 10 (11) 12 skeins of Pearly Haze col. Misty Violet (67)

Crochet hook 6 mm / US J/10 Scissors Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Pearly Haze, Hobbii
73% Viscose, 27% Wool
50 g / 1.75 oz = 110 m / 120 yds

GAUGE

16 sts x 15 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

Ch20, sc in second ch from the hook, *ch1, sk1, sc*

Continue for 18 rows *-* and always place the sc on top of the sc the row below



SIZE

XS (S) M (L) XL (2XL) 3XL

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 43 (49) 54 (59) 65 (70) 75 cm / 17" (19.25") 21.25" (23.25") 25.5" (27.5") 29.5"

Length: 52,5 (54) 55 (56) 57,5 (59) 60 cm / 20.75" (21.25") 21.75" (25") 22.5" (23.25") 23.5"

The piece will widen after once worn so you may use a smaller size if you don't want it to be too oversized.

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Shiny Blossom t-shirt is a quick and easy project with very little assembling.

The whole thing is worked from one side to the other in one piece and needs to be sewn together only on the sides and the sleeves. The fit is cozy and a bit oversized. It can be worn in summer and other seasons as well.

All stitches used in this pattern are beginner-friendly.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain sc = single crochet sk1 = skip one

INFO AND TIPS

The repeated stitch is known as a mesh stitch: you always place the sc on top of each other as you see in the picture below.

Mesh stitch


sc, ch1, sk1



Always place the sc on top of the sc of the previous row Ch1 on top of the ch1 of previous row



The shirt is worked as you see in the graphic below in one piece from left to right starting with one sleeve.



	XS	S	М	L	XL	2XL	3XL
A in rows	65	73	81	89	97	105	113
A ¹ in rows (left and right side both each)	26	30	34	38	42	46	50
A² in rows (behind neckhole)	13	13	13	13	13	13	13
B in st	165	169	173	177	181	185	189
B ¹ in st (under sleeve)	58	58	58	58	58	58	58
B ² in st (sleeve)	49	53	57	61	65	69	73



SLEEVE

Ch 50 (54) 58 (62) 66 (70) 74 Row 1: Sk1, *sc, ch1, sk1* sc Row 2: Ch1, turn, repeat *-* until end of the row, then ch59

BODY

Row 1: turn, repeat *sc, ch1, sk1* (before ending this row take another yarn skein to ch58 on the beginning of the last row of the sleeve, cut the yarn and pull it through, then continue with the original strand)

You should have a total of B (as shown in the chart above) stitches for this row in total.

Row 2: ch1, turn, repeat *sc, ch1, sk1* until end if the row, sc Repeat row 2 until row 26 (30) 34 (38) 42 (46) 50

13 short rows (behind the neck hole) ch1, turn, repeat *sc, ch1, sk1* sc for 83 (85) 87 (89) 91 (93) 95 stitches, turn and repeat until row 13

On the end of row 13 ch35, skip 35 sts and join in stitch 36 on the other front side. Continue *sc, ch1, sk1* sc

Repeat *sc, ch1, sk1* s for 26 (30) 34 (38) 42 (46) 50 more rows

SECOND SLEEVE

Row 1: grab a new yarn and start on the 59th stitch, work B^2 stitches (as shown in chart above) *sc, ch1, sk1* sc

Row 2: ch1, turn, repeat *sc, ch1, sk1* sc, cut the yarn and pull through

Sew the sides under the sleeves together.
