Avery the Betta Fish

MATERIALS

Honey Bunny

1 skein of color 45

1 skein of color 33

1 skein of color 22

Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8 8mm safety eyes Stuffing

YARN QUALITY

Honey Bunny, Hobbii
100% Polyester

100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

Sc- single crochet

Dec- decrease

Inc- increase

Ch- chain

St-stitch

Ss- slip stitch

Hdc- half double crochet

Dc- double crochet

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 10 cm / 4 inches Length: 20 cm / 8 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

This beautiful Betta fish has a body crocheted in rounds and fins crocheted in panels, so keep that in mind when following this pattern:)

The pattern is versatile. Feel free to get creative with yarn type, color, or overall style!

If you want to make it in a different yarn type, just follow the pattern regularly but with the correct hook size for the yarn in question.

INFO AND TIPS

The body of this betta is made in continuous rounds, do not connect rounds unless specifically stated. The fins are crocheted in panels.

BODY (col. 45)

Round 1: Mc 3sc (3)

Round 2: Inc in each st (6)

Round 3: Inc in each st (12)

Round 4: (inc, 3sc)x3 (15)

Rounds 5-9: sc in each st (15)

Stop here to insert safety eyes in row between rounds 4-5 and on opposite sides when the piece is folded in half.

Round 10: (3sc, dec)x3 (12)

Rounds 11-12: sc in each st (12)

Round 13: (2sc, dec)x3 (9)

Rounds 14-15: sc in each st (9)

Stop here to lightly stuff, making sure to keep the shape basically folded in half to give the perfect fish body shape.

Round 16: (sc, dec)x3 (6)

Round 17: fold your piece and sc across (3)



TAIL FIN (col. 33)

Row 1: chain 12, turn

Row 2: in 3rd st from hook, 4dc, 3hdc, 2sc, ss, chain 1, turn

Row 3: in 2nd st from hook, ss, 2sc, 3hdc, 4dc, ch 7, turn

Row 4: in 3rd ch from hook, 9dc, 3hdc, 2sc, ss, ch 1, turn

Row 5: in 2nd st from hook, ss, 2sc, 3hdc, 7dc. finish off

With col. 22 and hook, ss the lines in the fins as shown in the photos. Join and finish off

TOP FIN (col. 33)

Row 1: chain 11, turn

Row 2: in 3rd, ch from hook, 3hdc, 6sc, ch 1, turn

Row 3: in 2nd ch from hook, sc, 2inc, 6sc, ch 3, turn

Row 4: in 2nd ch from hook, 10sc, 2inc, sc, ch 1, turn

Row 5: in 2nd ch from hook, 3sc, hdc inc, hdc inc, 9sc, ch 1, turn

Row 6: in 2nd ch from hook, 16sc, ch 2, turn

Row 7: in 3rd ch from hook, 7hdc, 3sc, ch 1, turn

Row 8: in 2nd st from hook, 4sc, 4inc, 2sc, Join with ss and finish off

With col. 22 and hook, ss the lines in the fins as shown in the photos. Join and finish off

SIDE FINS (col. 33) (make 2)

Row 1: chain 4, turn

Row 2: in 2nd ch from hook, 2sc, ss, chain 1, turn

Row 3: in 2nd st from hook, ss, 2sc, join with ss and finish off

With col. 22 and hook, ss the lines in the fins as shown in the photos. Join and finish off



BOTTOM FIN (col. 33)

Row 1: chain 10, turn

Row 2: in 2nd ch from hook, 7sc, inc, sc, ch 1, turn

Row 3: in 2nd sc from hook, sc, 2inc, 3sc, join with ss and finish off With col. 22 and hook, ss the lines in the fins as shown in the photos. Join and finish off

ASSEMBLY

To start, sew the tail onto the body on that last row, tie off and weave in ends.

Next, position the top fin centered on the top and starting on row 6 sew, tying off when done and weaving in ends

Situate the bottom fin centered on the bottom and starting at row 7 and sew on, tie off and weave in ends when done

Finally position the fins on either side of the fish and sew on, tying off and weaving in ends
