## MATERIALS <br> Honey Bunny

1 skein of color 01
1 skein of color 79

Crochet hook $5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US} \mathrm{H} / 8$
8 mm safety eyes
Stuffing

## YARN QUALITY

(6) Honey Bunny, Hobbii

100\% Polyester
$100 \mathrm{~g}(3.5 \mathrm{oz})=120 \mathrm{~m}(131 \mathrm{yds})$

## ABBREVIATIONS

Sc- single crochet
Dec- decrease
Ch- chain
St- stitch
Ss- slip stitch
Bob- bobble stitch

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: $15 \mathrm{~cm} / 6$ inches
Length: $20 \mathrm{~cm} / 8$ inches

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This cute Manta Ray is made by crocheting 2 panels that are crocheted together afterwards. This pattern is so versatile. Feel free to get creative with yarn type, color, or overall style!

If you want to make it in a different yarn type, just follow the pattern regularly but with the correct hook size for the yarn in question.

## INFO AND TIPS

This pattern is written as two panels, and then those panels crocheted together afterwards.

## TOP PANEL

With col. 79
Row 1: chain 29, turn (29) put stitch markers in stitches 11 and 18 and leave for later
Row 2: in 2nd st from hook, sc in each st, chain 1, turn (28)
Row 3: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 24sc, dec, chain 1, turn (26)
Row 4: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 22sc, dec, chain 1, turn (24)
Row 5: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 20sc, dec, chain 1, turn (22)
Row 6: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 18sc, dec, chain 1, turn (20)
Row 7: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 16sc, dec, chain 1, turn (18)
Row 8: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 14sc, dec, chain 1, turn (16)
Row 9: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 12sc, dec, chain 1, turn (14)
Row 10: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 10sc, dec, chain 1, turn (12)
Row 11: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 8sc, dec, chain 1, turn (10)
Row 12: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 6sc, dec, chain 1, turn (8)
Row 13: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 4sc, dec, chain 1, turn (6)
Row 14: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 2sc, dec, chain 1 turn (4)
Row 15: in 2nd st from hook, dec, dec, chain 1, turn (2)
Row 16: in 2nd st from hook, dec, join with ss and finish off (1)
Now, turn your project over and go to those stitch markers you put in the first rows, start crocheting from the first marker.
Row 1: sc, bob, 4sc, bob, sc, chain, 1 turn
Row 2: sc in each st (8)
Join with ss, don't finish off, don't cut the yarn, we will be coming back to this! Insert the safety eyes on each of the bob stitches facing forward

## BOTTOM PANEL

With col. 01
Row 1: chain 29, turn (29) put stitch markers in stitches 11 and 18 and leave for later
Row 2: in 2nd st from hook, sc in each st, chain 1, turn (28)
Row 3: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 24sc, dec, chain 1, turn (26)
Row 4: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 22sc, dec, chain 1, turn (24)
Row 5: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 20sc, dec, chain 1, turn (22)
Row 6: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 18sc, dec, chain 1, turn (20)
Row 7: in 2 nd st from hook, dec, 16 sc , dec, chain 1, turn (18)
Row 8: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 14sc, dec, chain 1, turn (16)
Row 9: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 12sc, dec, chain 1, turn (14)
Row 10: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 10sc, dec, chain 1, turn (12)
Row 11: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 8sc, dec, chain 1, turn (10)
Row 12: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 6sc, dec, chain 1, turn (8)
Row 13: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 4sc, dec, chain 1, turn (6)
Row 14: in 2nd st from hook, dec, 2sc, dec, chain 1 turn (4)
Row 15: in 2nd st from hook, dec, dec, chain 1, turn (2)
Row 16: in 2nd st from hook, dec, join with ss and finish off (1)

Now, turn your project over and go to those stitch markers you put in the first rows, start crocheting from the first marker.
Row 1: 8sc, chain 1, turn (8)
Row 2: sc in each st (8)
Join and finish off

## ASSEMBLY

Now, take the two panels and stack them on top of one another, and using the yarn you didn't cut after the top panel, start to crochet all the way around the manta ray. On the outward corners, put 3sc in the stitch so the corner rounds nicely. Once you get to the tail point, chain 9, turn, 8 ss , then return to crocheting around the manta fish. Once you are nearly done, lightly stuff so it still keeps its slightly flat shape. When you meet up with your starting point, join with a ss and finish off, tying off and weaving in ends.
