



CROCHET PATTERN

Bear

Hooded Cowl

MATERIALS

2 (2) 2 skeins of Fluffy Day XL col. 13

Crochet hook 7 mm (K/L)

Yarn needle

Scissors

YARN QUALITY

 **Fluffy Day XL**, Hobbii

100% Acrylic

100 g (3.5 oz) = 140 m (153 yds)

GAUGE

10 sts x 9 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

hdc = half double crochet

ss = slip stitch

hdc2tog = half double crochet 2 together

inc = increase (2 hdc in 1 stitch)

SIZE

1-4 years (4-10 years) 10+ years

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 20 (25) 30 cm / 8 (10) 12 inch

Length: 34 (38.5) 43 cm / 13 (15) 17 inch

PATTERN INFORMATION

This beginner friendly pattern is worked in rounds of hdc, followed by rows of hdc. The top is slip stitched together and the ears are sewn on afterwards. The pattern contains written instructions per round/row and total stitch counts for each round/row.

INFO AND TIPS

The turning chains do not count as stitches. Work into all the stitches of the previous row.
Slip stitch into the first stitch of the row to join the round.

Ch 51 (56) 61

Row 1

50 (55) 60 hdc starting in the 2nd ch from the hook, ss join, ch 1, turn [50] ([55]) [60]

Row 2-10

50 (55) 60 hdc, ss join, ch 1, turn [50] ([55]) [60]

Rows 11-21 (25) 29

50 (55) 60 hdc, **do not join**, ch 1, turn [50] ([55]) [60]

Row 22 (26) 30

24 hdc, hdc2tog, 24 hdc (26 hdc, hdc2tog, 27 hdc) 29 hdc, hdc2tog, 29 hdc, ch 1, turn [49] ([54]) [59]

Row 23 (27) 31

49 (54) 59 hdc, ch 1, turn [49] ([54]) [59]

Row 24 (28) 32

23 hdc, hdc2tog, 24 hdc (26 hdc, hdc2tog, 26 hdc) 28 hdc, hdc2tog, 29 hdc, ch 1, turn [48] ([53]) [58]

Row 25 (29) 33

48 (53) 58 hdc, ch 1, turn [48] ([53]) [58]

Row 26 (30) 34

22 hdc, 2 hdc2tog, 22 hdc (24 hdc, 2 hdc2tog, 25 hdc) 27 hdc, 2 hdc2tog, 27 hdc, ch 1, turn [46] ([51]) [56]

Row 27 (31) 35

46 (51) 56 hdc, ch 1 turn [46] ([51]) [56]

Row 28 (32) 36

21 hdc, 2 hdc2tog, 21 hdc (23 hdc, 2 hdc2tog, 24 hdc) 26 hdc, 2 hdc2tog, 26 hdc, ch 1, turn [44] ([49]) [54]

Row 29 (33) 37

44 (49) 54 hdc, ch 1, turn [44] ([49]) [54]

Row 30 (34) 38

19 hdc, 3 hdc2tog, 19 hdc (21 hdc, 3 hdc2tog, 22 hdc) 24 hdc, 3 hdc2tog, 24 hdc, ch 1, turn [41] ([46]) [51]

Row 31 (35) 39

17 hdc, 3 hdc2tog, 18 hdc (20 hdc, 3 hdc2tog, 20 hdc) 22 hdc, 3 hdc2tog, 23 hdc, ch 1, turn [38] ([43]) [48]

Slip stitch the top shut

Fold your work in half. Place a ss in the 1st and last stitch; in the 2nd and 2nd to last stitch; in the 3rd and 3rd to last stitch and so on. Fasten off and sew in the end of the yarn. Turn your hat inside out, so your ss are on the inside of the hat. Also sew in the end of the yarn at the bottom of the cowl closing the initial chain.

Ears (make 2; same for all sizes)**Row 1**

Work 4 hdc into a magic circle, ch 1, turn [4]

Row 2

4 inc, ch 1, turn [8]

Row 3

(1 hdc, 1 inc) x4, ch 1, turn [12]

Row 4

(2 hdc, 1 inc) x 4, fasten off [16]

Sew on the ears 8 (9) 10 stitches from the front between rows 4 and 8 from the top.

Optional

ss around the front edge of the cowl for a clean finish.
