MATERIALS

Amigo 5/5/6/6/6 skeins of colour A46 - Yarn A

Friends Cotton 8/4

1 skein of colour 24 - Yarn B 1 skein of colour 123 - Yarn C 1 skein of colour 83 - Yarn D 1 skein of colour 45 - Yarn E 1 skein of colour 108 - Yarn F

Amigo XL 1 skein of colour A04 - Yarn G

Straight or circular needle 5 mm (US 8) DPN needle 5 mm (US 8) and 3.25 mm (US 3) Stitch holder Wooden button 21 mm – 0.80" Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Amigo, Hobbii
100% HB Acrylic
50 g (1.75 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
100% Cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (174 yds)

Amigo XL, Hobbii
100% HB Acrylic
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

GAUGE 10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 21 sts x 42 rows

SIZE

4-6/6-8/8-10/10-12/12-14 years old

MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 78/84/90/97/106 cm – 30.77"/33/35.50/38.25/41.75" Length: 27/30/34/38/42 cm – 10.75"/11.75"/13.50"/15"/16.50"

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit P = purlSt(s) = Stitch(es)C/on = Cast on C/off = Cast off Dec c/off = (Decrease cast off) K2tog from the back of the loop then slip the stitch back to the left needle, repeat to the end of the row Kf&b = Knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work Pf&b = Purl in the front and then the back around the same stitch with the yarn at the front of the work K2tog = Knit the next two stitches together K3tog = Knit the next three stitches together SKP = (slip, knit, pass) Slip the first stitch, knit the second stitch then pass the first stitch over the second one – you have decrease 1 stitch SPP = (slip, purl, pass) Slip the first stitch, purl the second stitch then pass the first stitch over the second one – you have decrease 1 stitch

INFO AND TIPS

The oversized jacket is knitted flat starting at the back, the sleeves are knitted separately then sewn at the end. The edge is worked as an loord and all the appliques are knitted separately then sewn on.

BODY

<u>Back</u> C/on 82/88/94/102/112 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – K row Repeat the first row until your work measure 27/30/34/38/42 cm – 10.75"/11.75"/13.50"/15"/16.50"



<u>Collar</u> Next row – K20/21/21/22/25, dec c/off 42/46/52/58/62, K20/21/21/22/25

Continue working on the last 20/21/21/22/25 sts only (put the other sts on a sts holder)

<u>Front Left</u> Next rows – K 2 rows Next row – K20/21/21/22/25, c/on 21/23/26/29/31 Continue working on these 41/44/47/51/56 sts only Next row – K row

Repeat the last row until your work measure the same as the back

Dec c/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

<u>Front Right</u> Re-join the 20/21/21/22/25 sts from the sts holder Next rows – K 2 rows Next row – C/on 21/23/26/29/31, K20/21/21/22/25 (from the needle)

Continue working on these 41/44/47/51/56 sts only Next row – K row

Repeat the last row until your work measure the same as the back

Dec c/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

SLEEVE (make 2)

C/on 72/74/76/80/80 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – K row

Repeat the first row until your work measure 20/22/22/24/24 cm – 7.87"/8.66"/8.66"/9.45"/9.45"

Dec c/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

APPLIQUE

All the appliques are knitted with needle 3.25 mm (US 3)

Stars x 6

Make 2 with yarn B – 1 with yarn D – 1 with yarn E - 2 with yarn F



C/on 2 Row 1 – K row Row 2 – C/on 2, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (3 sts) Row 3 – K row Row 4 – K row Row 5 – K2, Kf&b (4 sts) Row 6 – K row Row 7 – K row Row 8 – C/on 2, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (5 sts) Row 9 – K row Row 10 – K row Keep all those sts on a sts holder

C/on 2 sts and repeat from row 1 to 10 one more time

Next row – K5, c/on 1, K5 (from the sts holder but turn your work so the tails are going the opposite way of each other) (11 sts) Next rows – K 2 rows Next row – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (9 sts) Next rows – K 2 rows Next row – Kf&b, K until the last st, Kf&b (11 sts) Next rows – Repeat the previous row 3 times (17 sts) Next rows – K 2 rows Next row – C/off 6, K5, c/off 6 (5 sts) Next rows – K 3 rows Next row – SKP, K1, K2tog (3 sts) Next rows – K 3 rows Next row – K3 rows

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Hearts x 3

Make 1 with yarn C – 1 with yarn E - 1 with yarn F

C/on 2 Row 1 – Kf&b x 2 (4 sts) Row 2 – Kf&b, K until the last st, Kf&b (6 sts) Row 3 – K row

Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 16 sts finishing on the second row

Next rows – K 9 rows

Continue working on the last 8 sts only (put the other sts on a sts holder)



Next row – SKP, K4, K2tog TURN YOUR WORK (6 sts) Next row – SKP, K2, K2tog TURN YOUR WORK (4 sts) Next row – SKP, K2tog TURN YOUR WORK (2 sts) Next row – SKP and c/off

Re-join the other 8 sts from the sts holder and repeat the last 4 rows

Cherries x 3

C/on 3 with yarn E

Row 1 – Kf&b, K1, Kf&b (5 sts) Row 2 – K row Row 3 – Kf&b, K3, Kf&b (7 sts) Rows 4 to 6 – K 3 rows Row 7 – SKP, K3, K2tog (5 sts) Row 8 – K row Row 9 – SKP, K1, K2tog (3 sts)

Change to yarn F Row 10 – SKP, K1 (2 sts) Row 11 – K row Repeat the last row for 3.5 cm – 1.38" on those 2 sts, then leave them on a sts holder

Start another cherry and repeat from start to finish once more

You know have 2 sts on the needle from your second cherry

Next row – C/on 3 (5 sts), K4 of these 5 sts, then re-join the first cherry by K2tog (1 from each cherry), K1 (6 sts) Next row – C/on 2, K row (8 sts)

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Clouds x 4

C/on 20 with yarn D

Row 1 – K row Row 2 – C/on 1, K until the last st, Kf&b (22 sts) Rows 3 & 4 – K 2 rows Row 5 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (20 sts) Rows 6 & 7 – K 2 rows Row 8 – SKP, K13 TURN YOUR WORK Row 9 – K10 Continue on those 10 sts only



Row 10 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (8 sts) Rows 11 to 14 – K 4 rows Row 15 – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (6 sts) Rows 16 to 17 – K 2 rows

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Re-join the group of 5 sts Next row – K3, K2tog (4 sts) Next row – SKP, K2 (3 sts) C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Re-join the group of 4 sts Next row – SKP, K2tog (2 sts) C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Ladybug x 1

C/on 4 with yarn E

Row 1 – Kf&b, K until the last st, Kf&b (6 sts) Row 2 – Pf&b, P until the last st, Pf&b (8 sts) Repeat the first 2 rows until you have 12 sts

Next row – K row Next row – P row Repeat the last 2 rows 4 times

Next row – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (10 sts) Next row – SPP, P until the last 2 sts, P2tog (8 sts)

Change to yarn B Next row – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (6 sts) Next row – P row Repeat the last 2 rows once (4 sts) Next row – K row

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Bee x 1 C/on 3 with yarn B

Row 1 – Kf&b, K1, Kf&b (5 sts) Row 2 – K row



Row 3 – Kf&b, K3, Kf&b (7 sts) Rows 4 to 6 – K 3 rows Change to yarn C Rows 7 & 8 – K 2 rows Change to yarn B Rows 9 & 14 – K 6 rows

Repeat the last 8 rows twice more (do not forget to change yarn colour) Now continue with yarn B to the end Next row – SKP, K3, K2tog (5 sts) Next row – SKP, K1, K2tog (3 sts) Next row – K3tog

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

For the wings you are going to make an lcord C/on 2 with yarn C Row 1 – K row and slide both sts back on the left needle Repeat row one until your piece measure 10 cm – 3.94"

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Rainbow x 1

You are going to work each colour separately for the rainbow C/on 5 sts

Row 1 – K row Row 2 – P row

Repeat those 2 rows until your piece measure 20 cm – 7.87" with yarn D Repeat those 2 rows until your piece measure 17 cm – 6.69" with yarn B Repeat those 2 rows until your piece measure 14 cm – 5.51" with yarn E Repeat those 2 rows until your piece measure 12 cm – 4.72" with yarn F

Finishing on a P row, c/off all 5 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Butterfly x 1 Right side C/on 6 with yarn E

Row 1 – K row Row 2 – P row Row 3 – C/on 1, K to the end of the row (7 sts) Row 4 – P row



Repeat the last 2 rows twice (9 sts)

Row 9 – K row Row 10 – P row Row 11 – K row Row 12 – P row Row 13 – SKP, K to the end of the row (8 sts) Row 14 – P row Repeat the last 2 rows 3 more times (5 sts)

Row 21 – C/on 1, K to the end of the row (6 sts) Row 22 – P row Repeat the last 2 rows once more (7 sts)

Row 25 – SKP, K to the end of the row (6 sts) Row 26 – P row Row 27 – SKP, K to the end of the row (5 sts)

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Left side

C/on 6 with yarn E

Row 1 – P row Row 2 – K row Row 3 – C/on 1, P to the end of the row (7 sts) Row 4 – K row Repeat the last 2 rows twice (9 sts)

Row 9 – P row Row 10 – K row Row 11 – P row Row 12 – K row Row 13 – SPP, P to the end of the row (8 sts) Row 14 – K row Repeat the last 2 rows 3 more times (5 sts)

Row 21 – C/on 1, P to the end of the row (6 sts) Row 22 – K row Repeat the last 2 rows once more (7 sts)

Row 25 – SPP, P to the end of the row (6 sts) Row 26 – K row Row 27 – SPP, P to the end of the row (5 sts)



C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Middle

For the body you are going to make an Icord C/on 3 with yarn C Row 1 – K row and slide all 3 sts back on the left needle Repeat row one until your piece measure 7 cm – 2.76"

Next row – K1, Kf&b, K1(4 sts) Next row – K2 and slide both sts back on the left needle (leave the other 2 sts on a sts holder) Repeat the last row for 1.5 cm – 0.59" on those 2 sts

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Re-join the last 2 sts Next row – K2 and slide both sts back on the left needle Repeat the last row for 1.5 cm – 0.59" on those 2 sts

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

Smiley face x 1

C/on 5 with yarn B

Row 1 – Kf&b, K until the last st, Kf&b (7 sts) Row 2 – K row Repeat the first 2 rows until you have 17 sts, finishing on the second row

Next row – K row Repeat the last row 9 times

Next row – SKP, K until the last 2 sts, K2tog (15 sts) Next row – K row Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 5 sts, finishing on the first row

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FRONT & COLLAR EDGE

You will start your edge at the front bottom right of the garment, around the neck then finishing by going down the front left

This is work on DPN 5mm (US 8) and yarn G

• Pick up 1 st from the jacket, c/on 3



- K2, K2tog through the back of the st
- Pick up 1 st, slide all your sts to the right of the same needle

Repeat the last 2 points until you have gone around the whole edge <u>TIP:</u> To keep your corner square before the collar work <u>2 rows</u> straight instead by

• K4, slide all your sts to the right of the same needle

Then continue as above, c/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure when you finished

BUTTON LOOP

For the loop you are going to make an lcord C/on 3 with yarn G and DPN 5mm (US 8)

Row 1 – K row and slide all 3 sts to the right of the same needle Repeat row one until your piece measure 8 cm – 3.15"

C/off all sts, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING UP

Sew the sleeves to the body by aligning the middle of the sleeves with the shoulder. Finish by sewing the sleeve seams and then the side seams of the cardigan.

Add each applique to the jacket as per the pictures or wherever you feel like it. Sew the clouds, hearts, stars and the cherries as they are but follow below for the others:

Bee – Add one eye with yarn C by making a French knot.

Fold each end of the wings and sew in the middle then attach at the top of the bee. Create a flying path with a running stitch and yarn C as per the pictures. Mine start on the front left, then all the way around the back to finish behind the bee on the front right.

Ladybug – Embroider some duplicate stitches with yarn C to make the spots.

Smiley Face – Create a chain stitch around the face with yarn F. Add two eyes with yarn E by making French knots and finish with a nice curved chain stitch for a smiley face with yarn E.

Rainbow – Sew each colour along both sides in order of length starting with the shorter one in the middle.

Butterfly – Add four spots on each side of the butterfly with yarn F by making French knots. Sew the middle part all the way with the two ends separated at the top, finish by adding each wing on each side.



Button Loop – Sew the bottom at the top right corner on the inside of the cardigan, make sure that you can't see it from the front. Then fold the loop in half and sew it on the inside opposite corner of the button, make sure the button fits!

Weave in all ends.
