# Mini Mandala 

## Rug

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Amigo Giga colour A35, A29, A47, A58 and A16

Crochet hook 9 mm
Stitch markers
Tape measure
Darning needle
Scissors

## YARN QUALITY

(6) Amigo Giga, Hobbii

100\% Acrylic
150 g / 5.3 oz. $=95$ m / 103 yds.

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=$ after round 2 of below pattern

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
st(s) = stitch(es)
slst = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
tr = treble crochet
tl $=$ third loop
fp/bp = front/back post
rep = repeat
*...* = repeat between
(...) = repeat between
$\{. .\}=$. end stitch count
fo = fasten off
rnd = round
sp = space
sk = skip
inc = increase, 2 sts in same st
PM = place marker

## Ahobbii

## Pattern



Rnd 1 (A35): Start with a magic ring, ch 2 (counts as dc), 11 dc into the ring, tighten ring, slst to top of ch 2, fo. \{12dc\}


Rnd 2 (A16):
Start with a standing dc in any st, dc back into the same st, 2 dc in next 11 sts, slst to join, fo. \{24 dc\}


Rnd 3 (A47): dc-vst: (dc 1, ch 2, dc 1) into the same st.
Start with a standing dc-vst in any st, sk st, *dc-vst in next st, sk st* rep 11 times, slst to join, fo. $\{12 \mathrm{v}$-st $\}$


## Ahobbii

Rnd 4 (A29): Start with a standing tr in any sk st from rnd 2 working in front of rnd 3, *work 3 dc into sp of v-st, tr in next sk st from rnd 2* rep 11 times, omit last tr, slst to join, fo. \{36 dc, 12 tr$\}$


Rnd 5 (A58):
puff: *yarn over, insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop* 3 times (7 loops on the hook), yarn over, pull through all loops.
puff-vst: (puff, ch 2, puff) into the same st.
Start with a standing fp-dc around any tr, *ch 2, sk st, puff-vst in next st, ch 2, fp-dc around next st* rep around, omit last fp-dc, slst to join, fo. \{24 puff, 72 ch\}


Rnd 6 (A35): Start with a standing fp-sc around any fp-dc, *fp-hdc around first puff, (dc 1, tr 1 , dc 1) in sp between puffs, fp-hdc around next puff, fp-sc around fp-dc* rep around, omit last fp-sc, fo with needle join. \{24 dc, 24 hdc, 12 tr, 12 sc\}


Rnd 7 (A16): Start with a standing bp-sc around any tr, working on the back side, *2 dc in ch 2 sp from rnd 5, fp-dc around the fp-dc from rnd 5, 2 dc in the next ch sp from rnd 5, bp-sc around the next tr of rnd 6* rep around, omit last bp-sc, slst to join, do not fo $\{48 \mathrm{dc}, 12$ fp-dc, 12 sc$\}$


Rnd 8 (A16): PM in any second hdc of an inc in the rnd to help in the following rnd.
Ch 1, hdc in first st, hdc back in same st (PM), *hdc 1 in next 5, hdc 2 in next st* rep around, omit last inc, fo with needle join $\{84$ hdc\}


Rnd 9 (A47): Start with a standing sc in the TL of the marked st, sc 1 in the TL of each st around, slst to join, do not fo $\{84 \mathrm{sc}\}$


Rnd 10 (A47): ch 1, sc 1 back in the same st, *sc in next 3, sk 3 sts, 10 tr in next st, sk 3 sts, sc in next 4 sts* rep around, omit last sc, slst to join, fo. \{42 sc, 60 tr\}


Rnd 11 (A29):
Start with a standing sc in the 4th sc of a side, *sc in next 2, sk st, (fpdc around next st, dc in space between tr's) 9 times, fpdc around next st, sk st, sc in next 3* rep around, omit last sc, slst to join, fo. $\{30 \mathrm{sc}, 60 \mathrm{fpdc}, 54 \mathrm{dc}\}$


Rnd 12 (A58): Start with a standing sc in the 2 nd sc of a side, ch 1, sk st, *sc 1, ch 1, sk 2, (bpsc 1, ch 1, sk 1) 8 times, bpsc 1, ch 1 , sk 2 , sc 1 , ch 1 , sk st* rep around, omit last sc 1 , ch 1, and sk st, join with a slst, do not fo. \{54 bpsc, 12 sc, 66 ch\}


Rnd 13 (A58): cluster: *yarn over, insert hook into st, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops* rep 3 times, yarn over, pull through all 4 loops slst into ch 1 sp, ch 2, cluster back in same st, ch 1, *cluster in next ch 1 space, ch 1* rep around, slst to join, fo. \{66 clusters, 66 chs\}


Rnd 14 (A35): PM in first hdc of the round. Attach yarn between the first and second cluster of a side, ch 1 , *(hdc 2 in the ch sp, fp-hdc around cluster) rep 9 times, fp-hdc around next 2 clusters* rep around, join with needle join. \{66 fp-hdc, 108 hdc $\}$


Rnd 15 (A16): Attach yarn with a standing sc in the tl of the 14th st from the marker (incl the marker), *sc in tl of next 11 sts, sk 2 sts, 3 dc in tl of next st, sk 2 sts, sc in tl of next 13 sts* rep around, omit last sc, join with a slst, do not fo. \{144 sc, 18 dc$\}$


Rnd 16 (A16): ch 1, *sc in next 6, hdc in next 4, dc in next 7, hdc in next 4, sc in next 6* rep around, join with a slst, do not fo. $\{72 \mathrm{sc}, 48 \mathrm{hdc}, 42 \mathrm{dc}\}$


Rnd 17 (A16): ch 1, *sc in next 4, hdc in next 6, dc in next 7, hdc in next 6, sc in next 4* rep around, join with a slst, fo. $\{48 \mathrm{sc}, 72 \mathrm{hdc}, 42 \mathrm{dc}\}$
