#### **MATERIALS**

#### **Friends Extra Fine Merino**

3 skeins of col. 119, Col. A 1 skein of col. 122, Col. B 3 skeins of col. 47, Col. C

Circular needles 3.5 mm / US 4 (length approx. 120 cm / 47 in.)
A DPN or cable needle 3.5 mm / US 4
2 stitch markers (for marking the middle stitch)
Darning needle for weaving in ends

#### YARN QUALITY

Friends Extra Fine Merino, Hobbii 100% 100% Superwash Merino Wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 165 m (180 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

20 sts x 42 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4" x 4" in garter stitch on needles 3.5 mm / US 4 (measured after the work has been washed and blocked)

The fascinating and versatile combination of the classic garter stitch structure known from typical Trachten scarves and the pattern including bubbles, cables and openwork promise a lot of variety and knitting enjoyment. With its unique pattern and color mix, the finished shawl is sure to attract attention.



Approx. 185 cm / 72.75 in.



#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Elastic bind-off = k1 [k1, slip both sts back onto left needle purlwise and knit them together through the back loops], repeat the instructions between [...], until 1 st remains on the needle. Cut the yarn and pull it through the last st.

bm = bubble stitch: Work 5 sts in the same st, i.e. k1 through the front loop, k1 through the back loop, k1 through the front loop, k1 through the back loop, k1 through the front loop; turn your work, p 5 sts; turn your work, slip 3 sts knitwise, k2 sts together, pass the 3 slipped sts over that st.

cn = cable needle

g st= garter stitch: RS row: k all sts. WS row: k all sts

wyif = with yarn in front

k = knit

kfb = knit front back – work 2 sts in the same st, i.e. knit through the front loop of the st leaving the st on the needle; then knit through the back loop of the same st. Watch this video: https://youtu.be/O0ga\_UmIMhl?si=6GP-nOnpiDm945Kl

p = purl

sm = stitch marker(s)

st(s) = stitch(es)



#### **INFO AND TIPS**

- The stitch markers are used to mark and keep track of the middle stitch and are slipped each time from the left needle to the right one.
- All instructions in brackets [...] are always repeated.

Loosely cast on 7 sts with color A.

Set-up rows:

Row 1 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, place sm, 1 r (= middle stitch), place

sm, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 9 sts on your needles.

Row 2 – WS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, k2, sm, p1 (= middle stitch), sm, k2, slip 1 st

(wyif), k1.

Row 3 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 13 sts on your needles.

Row 4 – WS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, k4, sm, p1, sm, k4, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

Pattern 1 (garter stitch)

Row 1 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You have increased 4 sts.

You now have 17 sts on your needles.

Row 2 – WS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, k all sts until sm, sm, p1, sm, k all sts until 2

sts remain, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

Work rows 1-2 a total of 60x.

You now have 253 sts on your needles.

Cut color A.

Change to color **B**.

Work Pattern 1 (rows 1-2) a total of 1x.

Cut color **B**.

You now have 257 sts on your needles.

Change to color **C**.

Pattern 2 (bubble pattern)

Row 1 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 261 sts on your needles.



Row 2 and all even rows - WS rows:

Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, p all sts until 2 sts remain, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

Row 3 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 265 sts on your needles.

Row 5 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 269 sts on your needles.

Row 7 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k1, [k4, bm, k3] 16x, k1, kfb, sm, k1, sm,

kfb, k1, [k3, bm, k4] 16x, k1, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 273 sts on your needles.

Row 9 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 277 sts on your needles.

Row 11 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 281 sts on your needles.

Row 13 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 285 sts on your needles.

Row 15 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 289 sts on your needles.

Row 17 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k2, [k4, bm, k3] 17x, k2, kfb, sm, k1, sm,

kfb, k2, [k3, bm, k4] 17x, k2, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 293 sts on your needles.

Row 19 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 297 sts on your needles.

Row 21 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.



You now have 301 sts on your needles.

Row 23 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 305 sts on your needles.

Cut color C.

Change to color **B**.

Work Pattern 1 (rows 1-2) a total of 1x.

Cut color **B**.

You now have 309 sts on your needles.

Change to color A.

Work Pattern 1 (rows 1-2) a total of 5x.

Cut color **A**.

You now have 329 sts on your needles.

Change to color **B**.

Work Pattern 1 (rows 1-2) a total of 1x.

Cut color **B**.

You now have 333 sts on your needles.

Change to color C.

#### Pattern 3 (cable pattern)

Row 1 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, kfb, sm, k1, sm,

kfb, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 337 sts on your needles.

Row 2 and all even

rows - WS rows: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, work sts as they appear until the sm, sm,

p1, sm, work sts as they appear until 2 sts remain, slip 1 st

(wyif), k1.

Row 3 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k1, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k1, kfb, sm,

k1, sm, kfb, k1, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k1, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 341 sts on your needles.

Row 5 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k2, p1, [p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind

the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1] 16x, p1, k2, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k2, p1, [p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1] 16x, p1, k2, kfb, slip 1 st

(wyif), k1.

You now have 345 sts on your needles.

Row 7 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k3, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k3, kfb, sm,

k1, sm, kfb, k3, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k3, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.



You now have 349 sts on your needles.

Row 9 - RS row:

Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k4, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k4, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k4, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k4, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 353 sts on your needles.

Row 11 - RS row:

Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k1, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1, [p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1] 16x, p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, k1, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k1, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1, [p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1] 16x, p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, k1, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 357 sts on your needles.

Row 13 - RS row:

Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k6, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k6, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k6, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k6, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 361 sts on your needles.

Row 15 - RS row:

Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k7, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k7, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k7, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 16x, p1, k7, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1

You now have 365 sts on your needles.

Row 17 - RS row:

Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1, [p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1] 16x, p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1, [p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1, [p1, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1] 16x, p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 369 sts on your needles.

Row 19 - RS row:

Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, [p1, k8, p1] 18x, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, [p1, k8, p1] 18x, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1. You now have 373 sts on your needles.



Row 21 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 18x, p1, kfb, sm, k1, sm,

kfb, p1, [p1, k8, p1] 18x, p1, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 377 sts on your needles.

Row 23 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k1, p1, [p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind

the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1] 18x, p1, k1, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k1, p1, [p1, place 2 sts on a cn behind the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, place 2 sts on a cn in front of the work, k2, k the sts from the cn, p1] 18x, p1, k1, kfb, slip 1 st

(wyif), k1.

You now have 381 sts on your needles.

Cut color **C**.

Change to color **B**.

Work Pattern 1 (rows 1-2) a total of 1x.

Cut color **B**.

You now have 385 sts on your needles.

Change to color **A**.

Work Pattern 1 (rows 1-2) a total of 5x.

Cut color **A**.

You now have 405 sts on your needles.

Change to color **B**.

Work Pattern 1 (rows 1-2) a total of 1x.

Cut color **B**.

You now have 409 sts on your needles.

Change to color **C**.

#### Pattern 4 (openwork pattern)

Row 1 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 413 sts on your needles.

Row 2 and all even

rows - WS rows: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, p all sts until 2 sts remain, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

Row 3 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k2, [yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1,

pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over, k3] 33x, k2, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k2, [3 r, yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over] 33x, k2, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 417 sts on your needles.

Row 5 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k3, [yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1,

pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over, k3] 33x, k3, kfb, sm, k1,



sm, kfb, k3, [3 r, yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over] 33x, k3, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1. You now have 421 sts on your needles.

Row 7 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 425 sts on your needles.

Row 9 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k2, [yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1,

pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over, k3] 34x, k2, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k2, [3 r, yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over] 34x, k2, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 429 sts on your needles.

Row 11 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k3, [yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1,

pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over, k3] 34x, k3, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k3, [3 r, yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over] 34x, k3, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 433 sts on your needles.

Row 13 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 437 sts on your needles.

Row 15 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k2, [yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1,

pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over, k3] 35x, k2, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k2, [3 r, yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over] 35x, k2, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 441 sts on your needles.

Row 17 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k3, [yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1,

pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over, k3] 35x, k3, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k3, [3 r, yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over] 35x, k3, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 445 sts on your needles.

Row 19 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k all sts until 1 st before the sm, kfb,

sm, k1, sm, kfb, k all sts until 3 sts remain, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif),

k1.

You now have 449 sts on your needles.

Row 21 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k2, [yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1,

pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over, k3] 36x, k2, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k2, [3 r, yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over] 36x, k2, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 453 sts on your needles.



Row 23 – RS row: Slip 1 st (wyif), k1, kfb, k3, [yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1,

pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over, k3] 36x, k3, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb, k3, [3 r, yarn over, slip 2 sts knitwise, k1, pass the 2 slipped sts over, yarn over] 36x, k3, kfb, slip 1 st (wyif), k1.

You now have 457 sts on your needles.

Cut color **C**.

Change to color **B**.

Work Pattern 1 (rows 1-2) a total of 1x.

Cut color **B**.

You now have 461 sts on your needles.

Change to color A.

Work Pattern 1 (rows 1-2) a total of 5x.

Cut color **A**.

You now have 481 sts on your needles.

Change to color **B**.

Row 1 – RS row: K all sts (you may remove the sm)

Bind off all sts using an elastic bind-off method.

#### FINISHING DETAILS

Weave in all ends.

Wash the finished shawl and stretch it out. You do this by laying it on blocking mats, alternatively on towels, pulling it into shape and fixing it with pins. This way, the patterns show themselves at their most beautiful.
