## INFO AND TIPS

## Seamless color change

Work in the color A until two loops of the last stitch remain on the hook.
Use the color B to complete the stitch.

## Tapestry Crochet

A color-changing technique that allows you to work a single row of stitches in more than one color, it is worked very tightly with the non-working color carried inside the stitch.
When working the RS:
When using one color more than once in the same row, crochet working over the unused color parallel to the foundation row, inserting your hook through both loops of your stitch and underneath the unused color and working your stitch as normal.

When working the WS:
When using one color more than once in the same row, make sure to take the unused color of your work to the WS, which is the one facing you. Work the new color, hiding the unused one by carrying it inside the stitch when needed.

Row 9: ch 1, 3 sc, with E 14 sc (17), turn
Row 10: ch 1,8 sc, with B 4 sc, with E 2 sc, with A 3 sc (17), turn
Row 11: ch 1, 3 sc, with E 2 sc, with B 4 sc, with E 8 sc (17), turn

## Back Side (make 4)

Work with color A
Row 1: ch 17,1 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook, 1 sc in next 16 chs (17), turn
Rows 2 - 17: ch 1, 17 sc (17)

Place back and front tiles on top of each other and work through both layers, sc in each st around. Work 3 sc in each corner st. Follow the color pattern of the front tile. (pics. 13-18)

Embroider the mouth line with I (pic. 22)
Embroider the eyebrows with I.

Row 11: with D ch $1,6 \mathrm{sc}$, with G 11 sc (17), turn
Row 12: ch 1, 11 sc, with D 6 sc (17), turn

Row 3: ch 1, 15 sc, with H 2 sc (17), turn
Row 4: ch 1,3 sc, with C 14 sc (17), turn
Row 5: ch $1,13 \mathrm{sc}$, with H 4 sc (17), turn
Row 6: ch 1, 4 sc, with C 13 sc (17), turn
Rows 7-10: rep Rows 5 and 6
Row 11: ch 1, 14 sc, with H 3 sc (17), turn
Row 12: ch 1, 3 sc, with C 14 sc (17), turn
Row 13: ch 1, 15 sc, with H 2 sc (17), turn
Row 14: ch 1, 2 sc, with C 15 sc (17), turn
Row 15: ch 1, 5 sc, with G 12 sc (17), turn
Row 16: ch $1,8 \mathrm{sc}$, with H 2 sc , with G 2 sc , with C 5 sc (17), turn
Row 17: ch $1,5 \mathrm{sc}$, with G 2 sc , with H 2 sc , with G 5 sc , with H 2 sc , with G 1 sc (17)
Fasten off and weave in ends.

Row 1: ch 17,1 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook, 1 sc in next 16 chs (17), turn
Rows 2 - 3: ch 1, 17 sc (17), turn
Row 4: ch $1,15 \mathrm{sc}$, with G 2 sc (17), turn
Row 5: ch $1,3 \mathrm{sc}$, with C 14 sc (17), turn
Row 6: ch $1,13 \mathrm{sc}$, with G 4 sc (17), turn
Row 7: ch $1,4 \mathrm{sc}$, with C 13 sc (17), turn
Row 8: ch $1,12 \mathrm{sc}$, with G $5 \mathrm{sc}(17)$, turn
Row 9: ch $1,5 \mathrm{sc}$, with C 12 sc (17), turn
Row 10: ch 1, 12 sc , with G 5 sc (17), turn
Row 11: ch 1, 6 sc , with C $11 \mathrm{sc}(17)$, turn
Row 12: ch 1, 10 sc, with G 1 sc, with H 2 sc, with G 4 sc (17), turn
Row 13: ch 1, 4 sc, with H 2 sc, with G 2 sc, with C 9 sc (17), turn
Row 14: ch 1, 8 sc, with G 9 sc (17), turn
Row 15: ch $1,10 \mathrm{sc}$, with C $7 \mathrm{sc}(17)$, turn
Row 16: ch $1,7 \mathrm{sc}$, with G 10 sc (17), turn
Row 17: ch 1,1 sc, with H 2 sc, with G 8 sc, with C 6 sc (17)
Fasten off and weave in ends.

## Back Side (make 4)

Work with color C
Row 1: ch 17,1 sc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook, 1 sc in next 16 chs (17), turn
Rows 2 - 17: ch 1, 17 sc (17)

Place back and front tiles on top of each other and working through both layers, sc in each st around. Work 3 sc in each corner st. Follow the color pattern of the front tile. (pics. 13-18)
