## MATERIALS

1 skein of Friends Wool in each colors:

Turquoise (94)
Aqua (91)
Sapphire (85)
Purple Rain (70)
Maroon (49)
Tomato (40)
Buckthorn (29)
Sunflower (24)
Artichoke (110)
Bottle Green (112)
To make them in one single color you will need 3 skeins of Friends Wool

Knitting needles 4 mm
Stitch holder
Stuffing
Darning needle
Scissors

## YARN QUALITY

(44) Friends Wool, Hobbii

100\% wool
$50 \mathrm{~g}(1.75 \mathrm{oz})=100 \mathrm{~m}(109 \mathrm{yds})$

## INFO AND TIPS

- Each number is knitted twice. Then the two pieces are joined together by sewing and stuffing is added as you go.
- Each piece are worked from bottom to top except numbers 7 and 9 .
- When you must cast on stitches during a row, use the Knitted Cast On Method.
- Don't stuff too much, or the stuff will pop out.


## NUMBER ZERO (make 2)

With color 94

Cast on 10 sts
Rs 1 and 2: k all sts. Turn. (2 rows, 10 sts)
R3: k1, kf\&b, $k$ all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (12 sts)
R4: k all sts. Turn. (12 sts)
Rs 5 to 10: rep Rs 3 and 4. (6 rows, 18 sts after R10)
R11: k7, place them on hold, BO 4 sts, $k$ all remaining sts. ( 14 sts)
Now we will work only on 7 sts from the needles.
Rs 12A to 30A: k all sts. Turn (19 rows, 7 sts)
Cut the yarn and put sts on hold.

Pick up the 7 sts you put on hold R11 to restart in the middle of the row and rejoin the yarn. (Pic. 1)

Rs 12B to 30B: k all sts. Turn (19 rows, 7 sts)
R31: k7, CO 4 sts. Place the 7 sts you have on hold on the left needle and knit them, (Pic. 2). Turn (18 sts). We now work on all sts.
R32: k all sts. Turn (18 sts)
R33: k2tog, $k$ until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (16 sts)
Rs 34 to 39: rep Rs 32 and 33. (6 rows, 10 sts after R40)
R40: k all sts. Turn (10 sts)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew
Place each piece on each other. With another piece of yarn, start sewing the central space of the number and then, with the yarn tail you left, sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.

## NUMBER ONE (make 2)

With color 91

CO 8 sts
Rs 1 to 26: k all sts. Turn (26 rows, 8 sts)
CO 6 sts.
Rs 27 and 28: $k$ all sts. Turn (2 rows, 14 sts)
R29: k2tog, k all sts. Turn (13 sts)
R30: $k$ all sts. Turn
Rs 31 to 40: rep Rs 29 and 30. (10 rows, 8 sts left after R40)
R41: k2tog, $k$ all sts. Turn (7 sts)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew
Place each piece on each other and sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.

## NUMBER TWO (make 2)

With color 85

CO 16 sts
Rs 1 to 10: $k$ all sts. Turn ( 10 rows, 16 sts)
R11: BO 8 sts, $k$ all sts. Turn ( 8 sts)
R12: k2tog, $k$ all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn ( 8 sts )
R13: $k$ all sts. Turn (8 sts)
R14 to 31: rep Rs 12 and 13.
CO 8 sts and work some short rows
Rs 32 to 35: k4, turn. (4 rows, 4 sts)
Rs 36 and 39: k all sts. Turn (4 rows, 16 sts)
R40: k2tog, $k$ all sts until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (14 sts)
R41: k all sts. Turn (14 sts)
Rs 42 to 45: rep Rs 40 and 41. (4 rows, 10 sts)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew

Place each piece on each other and sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.

## NUMBER THREE (make 2)

With color 70

CO 8 sts
Rs 1 and 2 : $k$ all sts. Turn. ( 2 rows, 8 sts)
R3: k1, kf\&b, k all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (10 sts)
R4: $k$ all sts. Turn. (10 sts)
Rs 5 to 10: rep R3 and 4. Turn (6 rows, 16 sts after R10)
Work some short rows:
Rs 11 and 12: k2. Turn (2 rows, 2 sts)
Rs 13 and 14: k3. Turn (2 rows, 3 sts)
Rs 15 and 16: k4. Turn (2 rows, 4 sts)
Rs 17 and 18: k5. Turn (2 rows, 5 sts)
R19: BO 9 sts. K all remaining sts. Turn (7 sts)
Rs 20 to 22: k all sts. Turn. (3 rows, 7 sts)
R23: k1, kf\&b, k until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (7 sts)
Rs 24 to 26: $k$ all sts. Turn. (3 rows, 7 sts)
CO 7 sts.
R27: $k$ all sts until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (13 sts)
R28: k all sts. Turn (13 sts)
Rs 29 to 32: rep rows 26 and 27. (4 rows, 11 sts after R31)
R33: k all sts. Turn (11 sts)
R34: k1, kf\&b, k all sts. Turn. (12 sts)
Rs 35 and 36: rep rows 32 and 33. (2 rows, 13 sts after R35)
R37: BO 7 sts. k until 2 sts left. Kf\&b, k1. Turn (7 sts)
Rs 38 to 40: k all sts. Turn. (3 rows, 7 sts)
R41: k2tog, k until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (7 sts)
Rs 42 to 44: $k$ all sts. Turn. (3 rows, 7 sts)
CO 9 sts. Work some short rows:
Rs 45 and 46: k2. Turn (2 rows, 2 sts)
Rs 47 and 48: k3. Turn (2 rows, 3 sts)
Rs 49 and 50: k4. Turn (2 rows, 4 sts)
Rs 51 and 52: k5. Turn (2 rows, 5 sts)
R53: k all sts. Turn. (16 sts)
R54: k2tog, k until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (14 sts)
Rs 55 to 60: rep R53 and 54. Turn (6 rows, 10 sts after R60)
R61: kall sts. Turn. (10 sts)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew

Place each piece on each other and sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.

## NUMBER FOUR (make 2)

With color 49

CO 7 sts
R1 to 10: $k$ all sts. Turn (10 rows, 7 sts)
CO 4 sts
R11: k all sts. Turn (11 sts)
CO 10 sts
R12 to 20: k all sts. Turn (9 rows, 21 sts)
R21: BO 4 sts, $k$ the next 6 sts. You have 7 sts on the right needle, put them on hold. BO 3 sts, $k$ the remaining sts. (7 sts on stitch holder, 7 sts on needle)

R22A to 24A: $k$ all sts. Turn (3 rows, 7 sts)
R25A: k1, kf\&b, k until 2 sts left, k2tog. (7 sts)
R26A to 33A: rep Rs 22 to 25 twice. (8 rows, 7 sts)
R34A: $k$ all sts. Turn (7 sts). Cut the yarn and put the sts on hold.

With the wrong side facing, pick up the stitches you left on hold on R21. Rejoin the yarn. (Pic. 3)

R22B to 34B: $k$ all sts. Turn ( 13 rows, 7 sts)
R35: $k$ the 7 sts, pick up the sts from the stitch holder, $k$ all the sts. Turn. (14 sts) (Pic. 4)
R36: k all sts. Turn (14 sts)
R37: k until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (13 sts)
R38: $k$ all sts. Turn (13 sts)
R39 to 44: rep 37 and 38 three times. (6 rows, 10 sts after R44)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew
Place each piece on each other. With another piece of yarn, start sewing the central space of the number and then, with the yarn tail you left, sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.

## NUMBER FIVE (make 2)

With color 40

CO 8 sts
Rs 1 and 2: k all sts. Turn. (2 rows, 8 sts)
R3: k1, kf\&b, $k$ all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (10 sts)
R4: $k$ all sts. Turn. (10 sts)
Rs 5 to 8: rep R3 and 4. Turn (4 rows, 14 sts after R8)
R9: rep R3. (16 sts)
Work some short rows:
R10 and 11: k2. Turn (2 rows, 2 sts)

Rs 12 and 13: k3. Turn (2 rows, 3 sts)
Rs 14 and 15: k4. Turn (2 rows, 4 sts)
Rs 16 and 17: k5. Turn (2 rows, 5 sts)
R18: BO 9 sts. K all remaining sts. Turn ( 7 sts )
R19 to 25: k all sts. Turn. (7 rows, 7 sts)
CO 9 sts ( 16 sts)
R26: $k$ until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn. ( 15 sts)
R27: $k$ all sts. Turn. ( 15 sts)
R28 to 33: rep R26 and 27. (6 rows, 12 sts after R33)
R34: rep 26. (11 sts)
R35: BO 4 sts. K remaining sts. (7 sts)
R36 to 42: $k$ all sts. Turn. (7 rows, 7 sts)
CO 9 sts. ( 16 sts)
R43 to 51: $k$ all sts. Turn. (9 rows, 7 sts)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew
Place each piece on each other and sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.

## NUMBER SIX (make 2)

With color 29

CO 10 sts
Rs 1 and 2: $k$ all sts. Turn. (2 rows, 10 sts)
R3: k1, kf\&b, $k$ all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (12 sts)
R4: k all sts. Turn. (12 sts)
Rs 5 to 10: rep rows 3 and 4. ( 6 rows, 18 sts after R10)
R11: k7, place them on hold, BO 4 sts, k all remaining sts. (14 sts)
Now we will work only on 7 sts from the needles.
Rs 12A to 20A: $k$ all sts. Turn (9 rows, 7 sts)
Cut the yarn and put sts on hold

Pick up the 7 sts you put on hold R11 to restart in the middle of the row and rejoin the yarn. (Pic. 1)

Rs 12B to 20B: $k$ all sts. Turn (9 rows, 7 sts)
R21: k7, CO 4 sts. Place the 7 sts you have on hold on the left needle and knit them, (Pic. 2). Turn (18 sts). We now work on all sts.
R22: k all sts. Turn (18 sts)
R23: k2tog, k all sts. Turn (17 sts)
Rs 24 to 29: rep rows 22 and 23. (6 rows, 14 sts after R29)
R30: k all sts. Turn (14 sts)
R31: BO 7 sts, $k$ remaining sts (7 sts)

R32: $k$ all sts. Turn (7 sts)
R33: k1, kf\&b, k until 2 sts left, k2tog. (7 sts)
R34 to 41: rep R32 and 33. (8 rows, 7 sts)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew
Place each piece on each other. With another piece of yarn, start sewing the central space of the number and then, with the yarn tail you left, sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.

## NUMBER SEVEN (make 2)

With color 24

CO 18 sts.
R1 to R11: $k$ all sts. Turn ( 18 sts)
R12: BO 10 sts, k remaining sts. (8 sts)
R13 to R15: $k$ all sts. Turn (3 rows, 8 sts)
R16: k1, kf\&b, k until 2 sts left, k2tog. (8 sts)
R17: $k$ all sts. Turn (8 sts)
R18: k1, kf\&b, k until 2 sts left, k2tog. (8 sts)
R19 to R42: rep R13 to R18. (24 rows, 8 sts)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew
Place each piece on each other and sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.

## NUMBER EIGHT (make 2)

With color 110

CO 10 sts
Rs 1 and 2: $k$ all sts. Turn. (2 rows, 10 sts)
R3: k1, kf\&b, $k$ all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (12 sts)
R4: $k$ all sts. Turn. (12 sts)
Rs 5 to 8: rep Rs 3 and 4. (4 rows, 16 sts after R8)
R9: k1, kf\&b, k all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (18 sts)
R10: k7, place them on hold, BO 4 sts, $k$ all remaining sts. ( 14 sts )
Now we will work only on 7 sts from the needles.
Rs 11A to 17A: $k$ all sts. Turn (7 rows, 7 sts)
Cut the yarn and put sts on hold

Pick up the 7 sts you put on hold R10 to restart in the middle of the row and rejoin the yarn. (Pic. 1)

Rs 11B to 17B: $k$ all sts. Turn (7 rows, 7 sts)
R18: k2tog, k5, CO 4 sts. Place the 7 sts you have on hold on the left needle and k until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (16 sts) We now work on all sts.
R19: k all sts. Turn. (16 sts)
R20: k2tog, $k$ until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (14 sts)
R21 and R22: rep R19 and R20. (2 rows, 12 sts after R22)
R23: k1, kf\&b, k all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (14 sts)
R24: $k$ all sts. Turn. (14 sts)
R25 and R26: rep R23 and R24. (2 rows, 16 sts after R26)
R27: k1, kf\&b, k4, place those 7 sts on hold. BO 4 sts. K until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn.
Now we will work only on 7 sts from the needles.
Rs 28A to 34A: $k$ all sts. Turn (7 rows, 7 sts)
Cut the yarn and put sts on hold

Pick up the 7 sts you put on hold R 27 to restart in the middle of the row and rejoin the yarn. (Pic.
1)

Rs 28B to 34B: $k$ all sts. Turn (7 rows, 7 sts)
R35: k 7 sts, CO 4 sts. Place the 7 sts you have on hold on the left needle and $k$ the remaining sts. Turn (18 sts) (Pic. 2)
R36: k2tog, $k$ until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (16 sts)
R37: k all sts. Turn. (16 sts)
R38 to 43: rep R36 and 37. (6 rows, 10 sts after R43)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew
Place each piece on each other. With another piece of yarn, start sewing both central spaces of the number and then, with the yarn tail you left, sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.

## NUMBER NINE (make 2)

With color 112

CO 10 sts
Rs 1 and 2: $k$ all sts. Turn. (2 rows, 10 sts)
R3: k1, kf\&b, k all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (12 sts)
R4: $k$ all sts. Turn. (12 sts)
Rs 5 to 8: rep rows 3 and 4. (4 rows, 16 sts after R8)
R9: k1, kf\&b, k all sts until 2 sts left, kf\&b, k1. Turn (18 sts)
R10: k7, place them on hold, BO 4 sts, $k$ all remaining sts. ( 14 sts )
Now we will work only on 7 sts from the needles.
Rs 11A to 17A: $k$ all sts. Turn (7 rows, 7 sts)
Cut the yarn and put sts on hold

Pick up the 7 sts you put on hold R10 to restart in the middle of the row and rejoin the yarn. (Pic. 1)

Rs 11B to 17B: $k$ all sts. Turn (7 rows, 7 sts)
R18: k7, CO 4 sts. Place the 7 sts you have on hold on the left needle and $k$ all sts. Turn ( 18 sts )
We now work on all sts.
R19: k2tog, k all sts. Turn (17 sts)
R20: k all sts. Turn (17 sts)
R21 to 26: rep R19 and R20 (6 rows, 14 sts after R26)
R27: BO 7 sts, $k$ remaining sts. (7 sts)
R28 to 34: $k$ all sts. Turn (7 rows, 7 sts)
CO 11 sts (18 sts) Work some short rows:
Rs 35 and 36: k2. Turn (2 rows, 2 sts)
Rs 37 and 38: k3. Turn (2 rows, 3 sts)
Rs 39 and 40: k4. Turn (2 rows, 4 sts)
Rs 41 and 42: k5. Turn (2 rows, 5 sts)
R43: k2tog, k until 2 sts left, k2tog. Turn (16 sts)
R44: k all sts. Turn (16 sts)
Rs 45 to 50: rep R43 and 44. Turn (6 rows, 10 sts after R50)

BO all sts. Cut the yarn for the first piece.

Make a second piece in the same way but cut leaving a long tail to sew
Place each piece on each other. With another piece of yarn, start sewing central space of the number and then, with the yarn tail you left, sew all around the two pieces together, adding stuff as you go. Weave in ends.
