Color A - 4 (4, 5, 5, 6) skeins Primrose (A35)

Color B - 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) skeins Light Pink (A57)

Color C - 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) skeins Petunia Pink (A56)

Color D - 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) skeins Pool Green (A30)

Color E - 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) skeins Turquoise (A22)

Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8

Scissors

Darning needle

Tape measure

Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Amigo XL, Hobbii

100 % Acrylic

50 g / 1.75 oz = 100 m / 109 yds

GAUGE

13 sts x 16 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

MEASUREMENTS

Wrap circumference: 115 (123, 126, 134, 142) cm / 45.2 (48.4, 49.6, 52.7, 56)"

To fit a bust of 86 (94, 100, 108, 116) cm / 33.9 (37, 39.4, 42.5, 45.7)"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The oversized wrap is made up of squares which are attached with the JAYG (join as you go) method and then built up in sections which makes this wrap easily customizable with width, length and even style..

The attaching of the wrap has step by step diagrams, although once you have done one square you can join them all!

The pattern will follow the color variation on the photos, but will not give a pattern for each of the different color variations of the squares.

INFO AND TIPS

CI – 3dc in the same space or stitch indicated

V-st – (dc, ch1, dc) in the same space or stitch indicated

The squares will be the change for sizing, add rows or omit rows for the desired size. Always finish the square on a cluster row, not a V-stitch row.

COLOR VARIATIONS

If you are following the pattern without using your own color pattern, then my color variation pattern followed:

Color A – Primrose = always the V stitch row in each granny square Color B is always followed by Color C, then Color D, finishing with color E.

Whenever I started a new square I would start with a next color, but always following the same color order B-E



THE GRANNY SQUARE

SMALL GRANNY SQUARES (SS)

Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8

Number of small squares to complete:

S = 9 squares M = 10 squares L = 9 squares XL = 10 squares 2XL = 11 squares

Starting Row (for all sizes) With col. B and begin with a ch4 (counts as 1dc)

SS1: dc into 4th chain from hook (1st chain made), dc in the same st, *ch3, cl in same st repeat from * 2 more times, ch3 slst into 4th st of the starting ch, slst into the bklp of the next 2 dc, slst into the ch3

SS2: ch3, 2dc in same ch3 sp, ch2, cl in same ch3 sp, *(cl, ch2, cl) in next ch3 sp, repeat from * two more times, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3:

Sizes S, M finish here for the small squares, and fasten off, but do not tie in loose ends **Sizes L, XL, 2XL**, slst into bklp of the next 2dc, slst into the ch2 sp then go to SS3

SS3: ch3, 2dc in same ch3 sp, ch2, cl in same ch3 sp, *cl in the next sp (between cl of SS2) (cl, ch2, cl) in the next ch2 sp, repeat 2 more times from * cl in the next sp, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, fasten off, but do not tie in loose ends

MEDIUM GRANNY SQUARES (MS)

Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8
Complete 8 medium granny squares

Starting Row - (for all sizes) With col. B and begin with a ch4 (counts as 1dc)

Complete SS1 & SS2 of the small square section, finish in with a Slst in the ch2 space

MS3: change to color A by finishing the slst, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch 2, v-st in same sp, *ch1, V-st in the next sp (between cl of SS2), ch1, (v-st, ch2, vst) in ch2 corner, repeat from * two more times, ch 1, v-st in the next sp, ch1, slst in the 3rd ch of the ch4, slst in the ch1 sp, slst in the dc, slst in the ch2 sp, change to color C by finishing the slst.

MS4: ch3, dc in same sp, ch2, 2 dc in same sp, *2dc in ch 1 sp of the v-st, sk the next ch1 sp, cl in the next ch1 sp of the v-st, sk the next ch1 sp, 2dc in the next ch1 sp of the v-st, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the corner ch2 sp, repeat from * two more times, 2dc in ch 1 sp of the v-st, sk the next ch1 sp, cl in the next ch1 sp of the v-st, sk the next ch1 sp, 2dc in the next ch1 sp of the v-st, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, slst into bklp of the next dc, slst into the ch2 sp



MS5: ch3, dc in same sp, ch2, 2 dc in same sp, *2dc in the next sp, cl in the next sp (between cl of MS4), cl in the next sp, 2dc in the next sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the corner ch2 sp, repeat from * two more times, 2dc in the next sp, cl in the next sp (between cl of MS4), cl in the next sp, 2dc in the next sp, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, slst into bklp of the next dc, slst into the ch2 sp, change to color A by finishing the slst.

MS6: ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch 2, v-st in same sp, *V-st in the next sp (between cl), repeat to the next corner (v-st, ch2, v-st) in ch2 corner, repeat from * two more times, V-st in the next sp (between cl), repeat to the next corner, slst in the 3rd ch of the ch4, slst in the ch1 sp, slst in the dc, slst in the ch2 sp, change to color D by finishing the slst.

MS7: ch3, dc in same sp, ch2, 2 dc in same sp, *2dc in ch 1 sp of the v-st, (cl in the next ch1 sp of the v-st)x4 more times, 2dc in the next ch1 sp of the v-st, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the corner ch2 sp, repeat from * two more times, 2dc in ch 1 sp of the v-st, (cl in the next ch1 sp of the v-st)x 4 more times, 2dc in the next ch1 sp of the v-st, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, slst into bklp of the next dc, slst into the ch2 sp

Size S, finish here for the medium squares, and fasten off, but do not tie in the loose end

MS8: ch3, dc in same sp, ch2, 2 dc in same sp, *2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp (between cl of previous row)) x5 more times, 2dc in the next sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the corner ch2 sp, repeat from * two more times, 2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp (between cl of previous row))x5 more times, 2dc in the next sp, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, slst into bklp of the next dc, slst into the ch2 sp.

Sizes M, L finish here for the medium squares, and fasten off, but do not tie in this loose end

MS9: ch3, dc in same sp, ch2, 2 dc in same sp, *2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp (between cl of previous row)) x6 more times, 2dc in the next sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the corner ch2 sp, repeat from * two more times, 2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp (between cl of previous row))x6 more times, 2dc in the next sp, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, slst into bklp of the next dc, slst into the ch2 sp.

Sizes XL, 2XL finish here for the medium squares, and fasten off, but do not tie in loose ends

LARGE GRANNY SQUARES (LS)

Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8 Complete 8 large granny squares

Starting Row - (for all sizes) with col. B and begin with a ch4 (counts as 1dc)

Complete SS1 & SS2 of the small square section, finish in with a Slst in the ch2 space



Complete MS3-MS8

2XL size ONLY

LS8.5: ch3, dc in same sp, ch2, 2 dc in same sp, *2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp (between cl of previous row)) x6 more times, 2dc in the next sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the corner ch2 sp, repeat from * two more times, 2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp(between cl of previous row))x6 more times, 2dc in the next sp, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, slst into bklp of the next dc, slst into the ch2 sp.

LS9: change to color A by finishing the slst from the previous row, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch 2, v-st in same sp, *V-st in the next sp (between cl)x8 more times, (v-st, ch2, v-st) in ch2 corner, repeat from * two more times, V-st in the next sp (between cl)x8 more times, slst in the 3rd ch of the ch4, slst in the ch1 sp, slst in the dc, slst in the ch2 sp, change to color E by finishing the slst.

LS10: ch3, dc in same sp, ch2, 2 dc in same sp, *2dc in ch 1 sp of the v-st, (cl in the next ch1 sp of the v-st) x8 more times, 2dc in the next ch1 sp of the v-st, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the corner ch2 sp, repeat from * two more times, 2dc in ch 1 sp of the v-st, (cl in the next ch1 sp of the v-st)x8 more times, 2dc in the next ch1 sp of the v-st, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, slst into bklp of the next dc, slst into the ch2 sp

Size S, finish here for the large squares, and fasten off, but do not tie in loose ends

LS11: ch3, dc in same sp, ch2, 2 dc in same sp, *2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp (between cl of previous row)) x9 more times, 2dc in the next sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the corner ch2 sp, repeat from * two more times, 2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp (between cl of previous row))x9 more times, 2dc in the next sp, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, slst into bklp of the next dc, slst into the ch2 sp.

Sizes M, L finish here for the large squares, and fasten off, but do not tie in loose ends

LS12: ch3, dc in same sp, ch2, 2 dc in same sp, *2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp (between cl of previous row)) x10 more times, 2dc in the next sp, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in the corner ch2 sp, repeat from * two more times, 2dc in the next sp, (cl in the next sp (between cl of previous row))x10 more times, 2dc in the next sp, slst in 3rd ch of the ch3, slst into bklp of the next dc, slst into the ch2 sp.

Sizes XL, 2XL finish here for the medium squares, and fasten off, but do not tie in loose ends



JOINING THE GRANNY SQUARES

Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8

Step 1: Joining the **back panel** - Starting with 1 large Granny Square – Labelled GS1 crochet a round of V-st


Last round GS1: change to color A by finishing the slst from the previous row, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch 2, v-st in same sp, *V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, (v-st, ch2, v-st) in ch2 corner, repeat from * two more times, V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, slst in the 3rd ch of the ch4, slst in the ch1 sp, slst in the dc, slst in the ch2 sp.

Step 2: GS2 – attaching to GS1

Last round GS2: change to color A by finishing the slst from the previous row, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch 2, v-st in same sp, V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, v-st, ch1, slst into a corner ch2 sp of GS1, dc into ch2 sp of GS2, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS1, dc into corner ch2 sp of GS2, (slst in next sp between v-st of GS1, dc in the sp between cl of GS2, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS1, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of GS2) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp. Release GS1 and continue with the round ONLY on GS2. V-st in same ch2 corner, V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, (v-st, ch2, vst) in the corner ch2 sp, V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, slst in the 3rd ch of the ch4, fasten off.

Step 3: Repeat steps one and two for GS3 & GS4





Step 4: attaching the small granny squares for back width

Position a small granny square at the base of the joined GS1&GS2 right sides facing. Keep the joined GS3&GS4 close by.

Attach the yarn (with a color of your choice - I used D) by finishing the last slst st of the previous row to SGS1.



Last round SGS1: ch3, slst into the ch1 sp of the v-st of GS1 shown in the diagram 1 & photo 1 of GS1, dc into the corner ch2 sp of SGS1, slst into the ch2 sp of GS1, ch1, dc in corner ch2 sp of SGS1, ch1, v-st in ch2 sp of the same corner of SGS1, *v-st in the next sp between cl, (repeat one more time for sizes L-2XL), v-st in the next corner ch2 sp of SGS1, ch1, slst into corner ch2 sp of the v-sts of GS3, dc into ch2 sp of SGS1, slst in the corner ch2 sp of GS3, dc in the same corner ch 2 sp of SGS1 **slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS3, dc into corner ch2 sp of SGS1, (slst in next sp between v-st of GS3, dc in the sp between cl of SGS1, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS3, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of SGS1) (repeat from **once more for sizes L-2XL), slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS3, dc into the corner ch2 sp of SGS1, slst into the next v-st of GS3, dc in corner ch2 sp of SGS1, ch1, v-st in ch2 sp of the same corner of SGS1, *v-st in the next sp between cl, (repeat one more time for sizes L-2XL), v-st in the next corner ch2 sp of SGS1, ch1, slst into corner ch2 sp of the relevant (match it up!) v-st of GS1, dc into ch2 sp of SGS1, slst in the corner ch2 sp of GS1, dc in the same corner ch 2 sp of SGS1, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS1, dc into corner ch2 sp of SGS1, (slst in next sp between v-st of GS1, dc in the sp between cl of SGS1, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS1, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of SGS1) (repeat from **once more for sizes L-2XL), slst into the first slst made for this round.

Step 5: Attaching ALL SGS's to the back panel

Continue to attach the small granny squares to the large granny squares in the same way as indicated in this step. Make sure you are always keeping the right sides facing you (the raised join bumps should be on the outside of the pattern)

Attach col. A by finishing the last slst st of the previous row to SGS(2-10).

Last round SGS(2-10): ch3, slst into the ch1 sp of the v-st of GS1-2 shown in the diagram 1 & photo 2 (note: this will be the same moving onto all the SGSs), dc into the ch2, sp of SGS (2-10), slst into the join of GS(1-2) and previous SGS(1-10), ch1, dc in corner ch2 sp of SGS (2-10), slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of previous SGS), dc into corner ch2 sp of SGS(1-10),

*slst in next sp between v-st of previous SGS, dc in the sp between cl of SGS(2-10), slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of previous SGS (2-10), dc in the same sp as the previous dc of SGS(2-10) (repeat from *once more for sizes L-2XL), slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of previous SGS(2-10), dc into SGS(2-10), slst into the ch1 sp of the v-st of the previous SGS(2-10), dc into SGS(2-10), ch1, slst into the join of the GS(3-4) & previous SGS(2-10), repeat from * 2 more times along the GS3-4.

Finish side, slst into corner ch2 sp of the **relevant (match it up!)** v-st of GS(1-2), dc into ch2 sp of SGS(2-10), slst in the corner ch2 sp of GS(1-2), dc in the same corner ch 2 sp of SGS(2-10), slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS(1-2), dc into corner ch2 sp of SGS(2-10), (slst in next sp between v-st of GS(1-2), dc in the sp between cl of SGS(2-10), slst in the ch1 sp of



the next v-st of GS1, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of SGS(2-10) (repeat from **once more for sizes L-2XL), slst into the first slst made for this round.


FRONT PANELS

Step 6: attaching GS5 & GS7

Attach GS5 to GS1 Attach GS7 to GS3

Last round GS5: change to color A by finishing the slst from the previous row, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch 2, v-st in same sp, V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, v-st, ch1, slst into a corner ch2 sp of GS1, dc into ch2 sp of GS5, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS1, dc into corner ch2 sp of GS5, (slst in next sp between v-st of GS1, dc in the sp between cl of GS5, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS1, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of GS5) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp. Release GS1 and continue with the round ONLY on GS5. V-st in same ch2 corner, repeat from, V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, (v-st, ch2, vst) in the corner ch2 sp, V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, slst in the 3rd ch of the ch4, fasten off.

Repeat step six to attach GS7 to GS3 as shown in the diagram



NOTE: S & XL sizes will have a gap where the squares do not match up. Create a line of dc to fill the gap

Slst onto the large granny square ch2 corner, dc in the small granny square first st, sc in each st along, slst in the opposite large granny square, ch2 corner.


Step 7: This is a small step but vital for getting the sleeve holes correct. Get a middle-sized granny square and



Last round MS1: change to color A by finishing the slst from the previous row, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch 2, v-st in same sp, *V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, (v-st, ch2, v-st) in ch2 corner, repeat from * two more times, V-st in the next sp (between cl) to the next corner, slst in the 3rd ch of the ch4, slst in the ch1 sp, slst in the dc, slst in the ch2 sp.

With this complete MGS, using stitch markers attach MGS1 to GS2. Remove the MGS1 and keep the stitch markers in place.

Apply this to the other side of the wrap and mark with stitch markers the space for the sleeves (GS4 & MGS5)



Step 8: This step will complete the body part of the wrap. It follows the same pattern of attaching the GS6 to GS2&GS5 and repeat this step to the other side with attaching GS8 to GS4&GS7

Last round GS6: change to color A by finishing the slst from the previous row, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch1, slst into a corner ch2 sp of GS5, dc into ch2 sp of GS6, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS5, dc into corner ch2 sp of GS6, (slst in next sp between v-st of GS5, dc in the sp between cl of GS6, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS5, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of GS6) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, dc into ch2 sp of GS6, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS5, dc into same corner ch2 sp of GS6. Slst into a the corner join of GS5, GS1 & GS2, ch1, dc into ch2 sp of GS6, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS2, dc into corner ch2 sp of GS6, (slst in next sp between v-st of GS2, dc in the sp between cl of GS6, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS2, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of GS6) **repeat this to where you have placed your stitch marker, v-st in the next sp between cl of GS5 till the next corner.**


v-st in the corner ch 2 sp of GS5, ch1, slst in the corner of GS2, dc into ch2 sp of GS6, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS2, dc into corner ch2 sp of GS6, (slst in next sp between v-st



of GS2, dc in the sp between cl of GS6, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS2, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of GS6) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, dc into ch2 sp of GS6, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS2, dc into same corner ch2 sp of GS6,

ch1, v-st in the same corner ch2 sp of GS6, v-st in the next sp between cl of GS5, v-st in each sp between cl to the ch4 at the beginning of the round, slst into the 3rd st, Fasten off

Repeat this by attaching GS8 to GS4&GS7



ATTACHING THE SLEEVES

Step 9: This step will be repeated for the opposite sleeve.

Repeat step 7 to one more MGS (keep this aside for the other sleeve)

Last round MGS2: change to color A by finishing the slst from the previous row, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch1, slst into a corner ch2 sp of MGS1 (this you completed in step seven), dc into ch2 sp of MGS2, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS1, dc into corner ch2 sp of MGS2, (slst in next sp between v-st of MGS1, dc in the sp between cl of MGS2, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS1, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of MGS2) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, dc into ch2 sp of MGS2, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS1, dc into same corner ch2 sp of MGS2, ch1, v-st in the same corner sp, v-st in the next sp between cl of MGS2, v-st in each sp between cl to the next corner, v-st in the corner of MGS2, ch1,

Slst into the join of the gap left at **GS2**, **GS6** at the under pit of the arm, dc into ch2 sp of MGS2, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS2, dc into corner ch2 sp of MGS2, (slst in next sp between v-st of GS2, dc in the sp between cl of MGS2, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS2, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of MGS2) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, dc into ch2 sp of MGS2, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS2, dc into same corner ch2 sp of MGS2, slst into ch2 sp of GS2, ch1, v-st in the same corner sp, v-st in the next sp between cl of MGS2, v-st in each sp between cl to the next corner, slst to the top of the first v-st made.



Last round MGS3: change to col. A by finishing the slst from the previous row, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch1, slst into a corner ch2 sp of MGS2, dc into ch2 sp of MGS3, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS2, dc into corner ch2 sp of MGS3, (slst in next sp between v-st of MGS2, dc in the sp between cl of MGS3, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS2, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of MGS3) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, dc into ch2 sp of MGS3, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS2, dc into same corner ch2 sp of MGS3, ch1.

Slst join into the **corner join of GS2, GS6 & MGS2**, at the under pit of the arm, dc into ch2 sp of MGS3, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS6, dc into corner ch2 sp of MGS3, (slst in next sp between v-st of GS6, dc in the sp between cl of MGS3, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS6, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of MGS3) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, dc into ch2 sp of MGS3, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of GS6, dc into same corner ch2 sp of MGS3, slst into **corner join of GS2, GS6 & MGS2**

ch1, dc into ch2 sp of MGS3, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS2, dc into corner ch2 sp of MGS3, (slst in next sp between v-st of MGS2, dc in the sp between cl of MGS3, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS2, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of MGS3) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, dc into ch2 sp of MGS3, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS2, dc into same corner ch2 sp of MGS3, slst into ch2 sp of MGS2, ch1, v-st in the same corner sp, v-st in the next sp between cl of MGS3, v-st in each sp between cl to the next corner, slst to the top of the first v-st made. Fasten off



Last round MGS4: change to color A by finishing the slst from the previous row, ch4 (counts as dc, ch1) dc in same sp, ch1, slst into a corner ch2 sp of MGS1, dc into ch2 sp of MGS4, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS1, dc into corner ch2 sp of MGS4, (slst in next sp between v-st of MGS1, dc in the sp between cl of MGS4, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS1, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of MGS4) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, dc into ch2 sp of MGS4, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS1, dc into same corner ch2 sp of MGS4, ch1,



Slst join into the **corner join of MGS1, MGS2 & MGS3**, dc into ch2 sp of MGS4, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS3, dc into corner ch2 sp of MGS4, (slst in next sp between v-st of MGS3, dc in the sp between cl of MGS4, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS3, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of MGS4) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, dc into ch2 sp of MGS4, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS3, dc into same corner ch2 sp of MGS4, slst into **corner join of MGS1, MGS2 & MGS3**

ch1, dc in same sp, ch1, slst into a corner ch2 sp of MGS1, dc into ch2 sp of MGS4, slst into ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS1, dc into corner ch2 sp of MGS4, (slst in next sp between v-st of MGS1, dc in the sp between cl of MGS4, slst in the ch1 sp of the next v-st of MGS1, dc in the same sp as the previous dc of MGS4) repeat this to the next corner ch2 sp, slst into ch2 sp of MGS1, ch1, v-st in the same corner sp, v-st in the next sp between cl of MGS4, v-st in each sp between cl to the next corner, slst to the top of the first v-st made. Fasten off

Repeat step 9 for the second sleeve

FINISHING OFF & WRAP STRINGS

With col. E

RND1: Start at the back where a join for the SGS started and place a sc in each st around (sc, ch2, sc) for the corners. Make sure the wrap's right side is facing you. Slst to join,

RND2: ch2, dc in each sc around, (dc, ch2, dc) I the ch2 of each corner, slst to join.

Wrap ties:

At the two corners made in RND2

RS of wrap: with the wrap facing you attach yarn with a slst in the ch2 corner from RND (on the right side of the wrap) ch as many chains as you wish (the pattern here was 150 ch and it was long) dc in the 3rd ch from the hook and each ch made, slst into the next dc on the front of the wrap.

LS of wrap: create the same ch as the RS, be careful to make sure the stitches are facing the right side of the wrap.
