# Sophie Slipover

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design



#### **MATERIALS**

5 (5) 6 (6) 8 (8) 10 skeins of Milky Way col. 02

Circular needles 15 mm and 12 mm (US 17, 19)

One extra needle/Cable needle Tapestry needle for sewing

# YARN QUALITY

Milky Way, Hobbii 53% Wool, 47% Acrylic 100 g (3.5 oz) = 50 m (54 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm  $(4'' \times 4'') = 7$  sts x 10 rows cable – 15 sts = 15 cm (5.9'')

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit
p = purl
eg st = edge stitch
CO = cast on
BO = bind off

#### SIZE

XS (S) M (L) XL (XXL) XXXL

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 44 (49) 55 (61) 63 (66) 69 cm / 17.3 (19.2) 21.6 (24) 24.8 (25.9) 27.1" Length: 50 (52) 56 (60) 62 (66) 66 cm / 19.6 (20.4) 22 (23.6) 24.4 (25.9) 25.9"

#### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

Chunky warm slipover with a cable, made of the beautiful Milky Way yarn in a gorgeous color. The project is perfect for advanced beginners made of two pieces and ribs sewn together at the end, and thanks to the thick yarn, it is very quick to make.

# **INFO AND TIPS**

The slipover consists of two parts. The front one has a cable in the center, and a stockinette stitch on the sides of the cable. The back part is all made with stockinette stitch. At the end you pick up stitches around the armholes and neckline and make the ribbing.

The edge stitches are worked as knit stitches.

Stitches used in the pattern:

Rib stitch: k 2, p 2

**Stockinette stitch:** k on the wrong side, p on the right side.

# Cable (15 sts in all sizes):

put 5 k sts to the back on an extra needle,

work 5 k sts, then 5 k sts from an extra needle,

work 5 k sts,

work 5 rows in stockinette stitch (just as the sts come out) and in the next row:

work 5 k sts,

put 5 sts to the front on an extra needle,

work 5 k sts, then 4 sts from an extra needle,

work 5 rows in stockinette stitch. Repeat the entire sequence.



# **FRONT PIECE**

With 12 mm needles CO 30 (32) 36 (40) 40 (44) 46 sts.

Work 6 (6) 8 (10) 10 (12) 12 rows in a rib stitch. In the last row of the rib, increase:

Size XS: 5 sts, 1 st every 5 sts Size S: 7 sts, 1 st every 4 sts

Size M: 7 sts, 1 st every 5 sts

Size L: 7 sts, 1 st every 5 sts Size XL: 9 sts, 1 st every 4 sts

Size XXL: 7 sts, 1 st every 6 sts Size XXXL: 7 sts, 1 st every 6 sts

When the rib is finished, change to 15 mm needles and work the first row of stockinette stitch as follows:

Size XS: 1 eg st, p 9, k 15, p 9, 1 e st = 35 sts

Size S: 1 eg st, p 11, k 15, p 11, 1 eg st = 39 sts

Size M: 1 eg st, p 13, k 15, p 13, 1 eg st = 43 sts

Size L: 1 eg st, p 15, k 15, p 15, 1 eg st = 47 sts

Size XL: 1 eg st, p 16, k 15, p 16, 1 eg st = 49 sts

Size XXL: 1 eg st, p 17, k 15, p 17, 1 eg st = 51 sts

Size XXXL: 1 eg st, p 18, k 15, p 18, 1 eg st = 53 sts

Row 2-4 of stockinette stitch: work the sts just as the sts comes out.

Row 5: in place of k 15, start working the cable pattern as described in the INFO AND TIPS section.

Continue working in stockinette stitch and the cable pattern for 12 (12) 12 (14) 16 (18) 18 rows counting from the beginning of the stockinette stitch.

In the next row start forming the underarm cut, BO on both sides, in every other row: 3 sts, 1 st, 1 st (all sizes).

In the 35th (37th) 39th (41st) 43rd (45th) 45th row, BO the middle 9 (9) 11 (11) 11 (13) 13 sts for the neckline. Then, in every second row, from the neckline side BO 1 st then, 1 st. Work the remaining stitches on the shoulders with separate strands of yarn. After 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 (54) 54 rows of stockinette stitch, BO all sts.

#### **BACK PIECE**

With 12 mm needles CO the same number of sts as in the front piece.

Work in a rib stitch the same number of rows and increase in the same way like in the front piece. When you finish the rib, change to 15 mm needles and start to work in a stockinette stitch so that the purl stitches are on the right side of the vest.

Continue working as the front piece.



# **FINISHING**

Join the shoulders and the sides of the vest.

On circular needles 12 mm pick up 44 (46) 48 (48) 48 (48) 48 sts around the armhole. Work 4 rows in a rib stitch (k 2, p 2). BO all sts.

Repeat on the second armhole.

Then, on circular needles 12 mm pick up 48 (48)) 50 (50) 50 (54) 54 sts around the head opening and work 4 rows in a rib stitch (k 2, p 2).

BO all sts and secure all ends.
