

**CROCHET PATTERN**

# **Gina**

**Dog bandana**


**Design: It Was Yarn - Kate Kosenko (Veselunka) | Hobbii Design**

## MATERIALS

A: 1 ball of Portobello 04 (cream)  
B: 1 ball of Portobello 85 (sapphire)

Crochet hook 5.5 mm / US I-9  
Scissors  
Measure tape  
Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

 Portobello, Hobbii  
60 % Cotton, 28 % Acrylic, 12 % Wool  
50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

## GAUGE

12 sc x 14 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

## ABBREVIATIONS

rnd = round  
st (s) = stitch (es)  
sp (s) = space (s)  
yo = yarn over  
sl st = slip stitch  
ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
hdc = half double crochet  
dc = double crochet  
tr = treble crochet  
puff = (yarn over, insert hook in space as pattern requires, yarn over and pull up a loop)x3, yarn over and pull through all 7 loops on hook, ch1 to close a puff (does not count as a st)

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Strap length: 18 cm / 7"  
Length of one side of triangle: 36 cm / 14.2"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

The bandana is suitable for dogs of medium breeds. You can use it for dogs of large breeds, but note the need to make longer straps (in this case, two skeins of yarn will also be enough).

**Used stitches:** slip stitch, chain, single crochet, half double crochet, double crochet, treble crochet, puff.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

This bandana consists of four triangles and a border/two straps. The first step is to make a col. A triangle, which is placed in the middle of the bandana. Then you need to make three more col. B triangles, each of which is joined from corner to corner with the col. A triangle (the corner ch3-sps of the col. A triangle is joined to the two col. B triangles) in the last round as-you-go. Then work around the entire bandana as described in the last section. Straps are formed in the second and third rounds of the border. After finishing work, wash your bandana in cool water. No spin. Block it and dry flat.

## TRIANGLE

With col. A, make a magic ring and pull up a loop.

**Rnd 1:** Ch1 (does not count as a st), 6 sc into the ring, join with a sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc. (Total: 6 sc).

**Rnd 2:** Ch4 (counts as dc + ch1), puff in same st as ch4, ch1, (dc in next sc, ch1, puff in same sc, ch1)x5, join with a sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of starting ch4. (Total: 6 dc, 6 puff, 12 ch1-sps).

**Rnd 3:** Ch1 (does not count as a st), sc in same st as ch1, ch5, (sc in next dc, ch5)x5, join with a sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc. (Total: 6 sc, 6 ch5-sps).

**Rnd 4:** Sl st in next ch5-sp, ch3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch5-sp, ch3, 3 dc in same ch5-sp, \*ch2, sc in next ch5-sp, (ch3, sc in same ch5-sp)x2, ch2, (3 dc, ch3, 3 dc) in next ch5-sp\* 2 times, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp, (ch3, sc in same ch5-sp)x2, ch2, join with a sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of starting ch3. (Total: 18 dc, 9 sc, 9 ch3-sps, 6 ch2-sps).

Cut the yarn and secure ends.



## JOINING

You will make 3 col. B triangles, attaching each one to the col. A triangle in round 4. To do this, repeat rounds 1-3 with col. B. To join second triangle to first one, make **rnd 4** this way: Sl st in next ch5-sp, ch3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch5-sp, ch3, 3 dc in same ch5-sp, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp, (ch3, sc in same ch5-sp)x2, ch2, 3 dc in next ch5-sp, ch1, keep triangles wrong sides together, sc in opposite corner ch3-sp of col. A triangle, ch1, 3 dc in same ch5-sp as previous 3 dc, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp, (ch1, sc in opposite ch3-sp of col. A triangle, ch1, sc in same ch5-sp as previous sc)x2, ch2, 3 dc in next ch5-sp, ch1, sc in opposite corner ch3-sp of col. A triangle, ch1, 3 dc in same ch5-sp as previous 3 dc, ch2, sc in next ch5-sp, (ch3, sc in same ch5-sp)x2, ch2, join with a sl st to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of starting ch3.

Cut the yarn and secure ends.

Make 3 col. B triangles joined to col. A triangle.

## BORDER AND STRAP

Keep the work right side facing you all the way. Cut the yarn and secure ends after each round.

**Rnd 1 (col. A):** Slip knot, \*(3 dc, ch3, 3 dc) in corner ch3-sp of col. B triangle, ch2, sc in next ch2-sp, ch1, 2 sc in each of next 2 ch3-sps, ch1, sc in next ch2-sp, ch2, 3 dc in next ch1-sp, 3 tr in next ch3-sp of col. A triangle, 3 dc in next ch1-sp of col. B triangle, ch2, sc in next ch2-sp, ch1, 2 sc in each of next 2 ch3-sps, ch1, sc in next ch2-sp, ch2\* 3 times, join with a sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> dc. (Total: 9 tr, 36 dc, 36 sc, 3 ch3-sps, 12 ch2-sps, 12 ch1-sps).

**Rnd 2 (col. B):** Slip knot, (3 dc, ch3, 3 dc) in corner ch3-sp, **@dc in next 3 dc**, \*2 dc in next ch2-sp, hdc in next sc, sc in next 6 sts/sps, hdc in next sc, 2 dc in next ch2-sp\*\*, **dc in next 9 sts**, **repeat from \* to \*\***, **dc in next 3 dc@@**, (3 dc in next ch3-sp, ch25, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in next 23 chains, 3 dc in same ch3-sp as previous 3 dc, repeat from @ to @@)x2, join with a sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> dc. (Total: 87 dc, 12 hdc, 84 sc, 1 ch3-sp).

**Rnd 3 (col. A):** Slip knot, 3 sc in ch3-sp, (sc in next 45 sts, continue crocheting along the strap (unused side of ch25), sc in next 23 sts, 2 sc in next st, continue crocheting along the strap (around), 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 23 sc)x2, sc in next 45 sts, join with a sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc. (Total: 238 sc).
