## Babydoll <br> Dress

## MATERIALS

3 (3) 3 (4) 4 skeins of Friends Cotton Silk color 113
8 (8) 9 (9) 9 skeins of Friends Kid Silk color 113

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G/6
Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8
4 stitch markers
Scissors
Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

((3) Friends Cotton Silk, Hobbii
77 \% Cotton, 23 \% Silk
$50 \mathrm{~g} / 1.8 \mathrm{oz}=120 \mathrm{~m} / 131 \mathrm{yds}$
(0) Friends Kid Silk, Hobbii

72 \% Mohair, 25 \% Silk, 3 \% Wool
$25 \mathrm{~g} / 0.9 \mathrm{oz}=200 \mathrm{~m} / 219 \mathrm{yds}$

## GAUGE

Friends Cotton Silk and 4 mm / US G/6 crochet hook:
17 sts $\times 8$ rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$

Friends Kid Silk and $5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US} \mathrm{H} / 8$ crochet hook:
14 sts $\times 8$ rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$
(Before blocking, in the V-stitch texture used in pattern)

## SIZE

$S(M) L(X L) 2 X L$

## MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 100 (108) 121 (134) 142 cm / 39.4" (42.5") 47.6" (52.8") 55.9"

Skirt length: 50 cm / 19.7" or desired length
The dress is designed with a loose fit. The following measurements are for the actual dress, not your size when pulling the measuring tape snug around your chest.

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This design is a top-down construction with a beautiful and airy V-stitch texture. The foundation chain is your neckline. You will be crocheting in the round.

ABBREVIATIONS<br>ch = chain<br>chs $=$ chains<br>st = stitch<br>sts = stitches<br>sl st = slip stitch<br>sc = single crochet<br>dc = double crochet<br>rep $=$ repeat<br>sk = skip

## BODY

Foundation ch: Use Friends Cotton Silk and crochet hook size $4 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US}$ G/6. Ch 10, insert st marker in last ch/st. Ch 18, insert st marker in last ch/st. Ch 21, insert st marker in last ch/st. Ch 18, insert st marker in last ch/st. Ch 11 (you should have a total of 78 chs/sts). SI st in $1^{\text {st }}$ ch (NB! Make sure your ch is not twisted at this point). You will be crocheting in the round.

- 1. Ch 1 (does not count as a st). ( $1 \mathrm{sc}+\mathrm{ch} 1$ - which will count as $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ in round throughout pattern, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same/1 ${ }^{\text {st }}$ st. Sk next 2 sts. *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same st, sk next 2 sts* rep from * until you reach the $1^{\text {st }}$ st marker st; (1dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same st (your $1^{\text {st "corner"). Always replace st marker in ch }}$ 1 space which is underlined. Sk next 2 sts. *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same st, sk next 2 sts* rep from * until you reach the $2^{\text {nd }}$ st marker st; ( 1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1,1 dc) in same st (your $2^{\text {nd }}$ "corner"). Sk next 2 sts. *(1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) in same st, sk next 2 sts* rep from * until you reach the $3^{\text {rd }}$ st marker st; ( 1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 , 1 dc ) in same st (your $3^{\text {rd } " c o r n e r ") . ~ S k ~ n e x t ~} 2$ sts. *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same st, sk next 2 sts* rep from * until you reach the $4^{\text {th }}$ and last st marker st; ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1$ dc, ch 1, 1 dc ) in same st (your $4^{\text {th }}$ and last "corner"). Sk next 2 sts. *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same st, sk next 2 sts* rep from * until end of round. SI st in $1^{\text {st }}$ st in round (the ch 1 on top of the $\left.1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc} s t\right)$. Do not turn.
- 2. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}+$ ch 1 , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 1 space from previous round. *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1$ dc) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until next ch 1 space with a st marker ( $1^{\text {st }}$ "corner"). ( 1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space. *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in
next ch 1 space* rep from * until next ch 1 space with a st marker ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ "corner"). (1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space. *( 1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until next ch 1 space with a st marker ( $3^{\text {rd }}$ "corner"). ( 1 dc ch 1, 1 $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space. *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until next ch 1 space with a st marker ( $4^{\text {th }}$ "corner"). ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1$ dc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space. *( 1 dc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until end of round. SI st in $1^{\text {st }}$ st in round (the ch 1 on top of the $1^{\text {st }}$ sc st). Do not turn.
- 3.         - 8. (9.) 10. (11.) 12. Rep round 2.
- 9. (10.) 11. (12.) 13. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}+$ ch 1 , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 1 space from previous round. *( 1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until next ch 1 space with a st marker ( $1^{\text {st }}$ "corner"). ( 1 dc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space (you will not complete the "corners" in this round, leave the st markers for now). Create $1{ }^{\text {st }}$ sleeve hole: ch 11 (11) 17 (17) 17. Crochet next st directly into next ch 1 space with a st marker (you will be skipping all sts between $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ st marker in round); *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space. *( 1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until next ch 1 space with a st marker ( $3^{\text {rd }}$ "corner"). ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space (again, you will not complete the "corners" in this round). Create $2^{\text {nd }}$ sleeve hole: ch 11 (11) 17 (17) 17. Crochet next st directly into next ch 1 space with a st marker (you will be skipping all sts between $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ st marker in round). *( 1 dc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space. *( 1 dc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until end of round. Sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ st in round (the ch 1 on top of the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc} s t$ ). Do not turn.
- 10. (11.) 12. (13.) 14. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}+\mathrm{ch} 1$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 1 space from previous round. *(1 dc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until you reach $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 11 (11) 17 (17) 17 section from previous round. Sk first 2 chs/sts, *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch/st. Sk next 2 chs/sts* rep from * until you reach the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 1 space after the 11 (11) 17 (17) 17 chs: ( 1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space. *( 1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until you reach $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch 11 (11) 17 (17) 17 section from previous round. Sk first 2 chs/sts, *(1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) in next ch/st. Sk next 2 chs/sts* rep from * until you reach the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 1 space after the 11 (11) 17 (17) 17 chs: ( 1 dc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this ch 1 space. *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until end of round. SI st in $1^{\text {st }}$ st in round (the ch 1 on top of the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$ st). Do not turn.
- 11. (12.) 13. (14.) 15. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}+$ ch 1 , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 1 space from previous round. *( 1 dc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until end of round. SI st in $1^{\text {st }}$ st in round (the ch 1 on top of the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$ st). Do not turn.
- 12. (13.) 14. (15.) 16. - 21. (22.) 23. (24.) 25. (or until desired placement of waistline). Rep round 11. (12.) 13. (14.) 15. After round 21. (22.) 23. (24.) 25., fasten off.


## SKIRT

Use Friends Kid Silk and crochet hook size $5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US}$ H/8.

- 1. Start crocheting in the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{ch} 1 \mathrm{sp}$ from the previous round, 21. (22.) 23. (24.) 25. from BODY section: (ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}+$ ch 1 (counts as 1 dc ), ch $1,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ). *( 1 dc , ch $1,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until end of round. Sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ st in round (the ch 1 on top of the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc} s t$ ). Do not turn.
- 2. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}+$ ch 1 , ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 1 space from previous round. * $(1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1,1 dc) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until end of round. Sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ st in round (the ch 1 on top of the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc} s t$ ). Do not turn. Tip! Make sure to only crochet into the ch 1 spaces, the 2 dc sts placed next to one another can easily cause confusion!
- 3.         - 38. (or until desired length of skirt) Rep round 2.
- 39. Continue using Friends Kid Silk but change to crochet hook size $4 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US} \mathrm{G} / 6$. Ch 1.1 sc in every dc st and ch 1 space throughout round. SI st in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$ in round, fasten off.


## SLEEVES

Use Friends Kid Silk and crochet hook size $5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US} \mathrm{H} / 8$.
You will be crocheting into one of the sleeve holes you made in round 9. (10.) 11. (12.) 13.

- 1. Locate the $6^{\text {th }}\left(6^{\text {th }}\right) 9^{\text {th }}\left(9^{\text {th }}\right) 9^{\text {th }}$ ch from your ch 11 (11) 17 (17) 17 in round 9 . (10.) 11 . (12.) 13., start crocheting in this ch/st. (Ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}+\mathrm{ch} 1$ (counts as 1 dc ), ch $1,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same ch/st, sk next $2 \mathrm{chs} / \mathrm{sts}$. *( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same ch/st, sk next 2 chs/sts* rep from * 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 time(s) in total. Locate the last dc st after/before your ch 11 (11) 17 (17) 17 from round 9. (10.) 11. (12.) 13 .: ( 1 dc , ch 1,2 $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this dc st (the st will be positioned horizontally). ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space ("corner" st from round 8 ). *( 1 dc , ch $1,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until you reach the last dc st after/before your ch 11 (11) 17 (17) 17 from round 9. (10.) 11. (12.) $13 .:$ ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in this dc st (the st will be positioned horizontally). Sk next $2 \mathrm{chs} / \mathrm{sts}$. *(1 dc, ch $1,2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in same ch/st, sk next 2 chs/sts* rep from * 1 (1) 2 (2) 2 time(s) in total. Sl st in $1^{\text {st }}$ st in round (the ch 1 on top of the $1^{\text {st }}$ sc st). Do not turn. Tip! The spaces with st markers count as ch 1 spaces in this round, even though they already have stitches in them from round 9. (10.) 11. (12.) 13. from the BODY section.
- 2. ( $1 \mathrm{sc}+\mathrm{ch} 1$, ch $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$ ) into the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 1 space from previous round. *( 1 dc , ch 1,1 dc) in next ch 1 space* rep from * until end of round. SI st in $1^{\text {st }}$ st in round (the ch 1 on top of the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc} \mathrm{st}$ ). Do not turn.
- 3.         - 24. (or until desired length) Rep round 2 . After completing round 24 , fasten off.
- 25. Use Friends Cotton Silk and crochet hook size $4 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US} \mathrm{G} / 6$. Start crocheting in the $1^{\text {st }}$ ch 1 space from the previous round (24): Ch 1,1 sc in this ch 1 space. Sk next ch 1 space! *1 sc in next ch 1 space, sk next ch 1 space!* until end of round. Sl st in $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$ st in round (if you have one last ch 1 space leftover, simply place 1 sc in this space as well before ending with a slst). Do not turn.
- 26. Ch 1 . Sc in every sc st in round. SI st in $1^{\text {st }}$ sc st in round, fasten off. Rep round 1.-26. for your second sleeve.

Sew in all your loose ends, block your work, and you are finished!
