MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

1 (2) 3 3 4 4 5 5 5 skein(s) of color 108 1 (1) 1 1 2 2 2 2 2 skein(s) of color 91

1 (2) 2 2 2 2 2 2 3 skein(s) of color 21

1 (1) 1 1 1 1 1 1 skein of color 33

1 (1) 1 1 1 1 1 1 1 skein of color 38

Crochet hook 3 mm / US D/3 Other: green sewing thread

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100 % Cotton 50 g / 0.9 oz = 160 m / 246 yds

GAUGE

1 square = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain sl st = slip stitch sc = single crochet dc = double crochet rep = repeat

INFO AND TIPS

All the squares are sewn with a needle and green thread or Friends Cotton 8/4 color 108 to achieve neat, flat seams.

Also, you have flexibility in adjusting the top's length by incorporating extra rows of squares or by adding more granny stitch rows at the bottom.

SQUARE PATTERN

With col. 38 ch 4, join with sl st to the first ch.

Round 1 (col. 38): Ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc into the circle, ch 2, * 3 dc into the circle, ch 2 **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Round 2 (col. 33): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Round 3 (col. 21): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 4 (col. 21): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) twice, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) twice **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sI st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Round 5 (col. 91): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) three times, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) three times **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Round 6 (col. 108): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) four times, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) four times **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.



Sew 7 (8) 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 squares together in a circle. Add two more rounds of squares.





BORDER

With col. 108, connect the yarn to any ch-1 space of the bottom or the upper part of the top and start crocheting:

Round 1 (col. 108): Ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 1, * (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) rep to next ch-2 space, dc in next ch-2 space, dc in the place between 2 sewed squares, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 2 (col. 108): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-1 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 1, * 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sI st to top of ch 3.

Round 3 (col. 108): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-1 space, sc in the same space, 5 dc in next ch-1 space, * sc in next ch-1 space, 5 dc in next ch-1 space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sI st to the first sc. Fasten off.



Straps

Row 1 (col. 108): Crochet a foundation dc row 57 (62) 67 72 77 82 87 92 97 dc.

Row 2-3 (col.108): Ch 2 (count as the first dc), turn, dc in each dc to the end of the row.

Mark places for straps and sew them to the marked places with a needle and thread.
