MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

2 3 (3) 4 4 5 5 5 6 skeins of color 108 1 1 (1) 2 2 2 2 2 3 skein(s) of color 91 2 2 (2) 2 2 2 2 3 4 skeins of color 21 1 1 (1) 1 1 1 1 1 1 skein of color 33 1 1 (1) 1 1 1 1 1 1 skein of color 38

Crochet hook 3 mm / US D/3 Other: green sewing thread

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
 100 % Cotton
 50 g / 0.9 oz = 160 m / 246 yds

GAUGE

1 square = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain sl st = slip stitch sc = single crochet dc = double crochet rep = repeat

SIZE

XS S (M) L XL 2XL 3XL 4XL 5XL

Plus, you can easily adjust the width at the waist using a cord, and adding extra width squares won't restrict your step length. This design creates a flattering, slim waist silhouette. With clear instructions and step-by-step guidance, it's perfect for crocheters of all skill levels.

INFO AND TIPS

All the squares are sewn with a needle and green thread or Friends Cotton 8/4 color 108 to achieve neat, flat seams.

Also, you have flexibility in adjusting the skirt's length by incorporating extra rows of squares or by adding more granny stitch rows at the bottom.

SQUARE PATTERN

With col. 38 ch 4, join with sl st to the first ch.

Round 1 (col. 38): Ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc into the circle, ch 2, * 3 dc into the circle, ch 2 **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Round 2 (col. 33): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Round 3 (col. 21): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 4 (col. 21): Sl st in next 2 dc, sl st in next ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) twice, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) twice **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Round 5 (col. 91): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) three times, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) three times **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

Round 6 (col. 108): Connect the yarn to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) four times, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 dc in the same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) four times **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.



Sew 8 9 (10) 11 12 13 14 14 16 squares together in a circle. Add two more rounds of squares.



BORDER

With col. 108, connect the yarn to any ch-1 space of the upper part of the skirt and start crocheting:

Round 1 (col. 108): Ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 1, * (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) rep to next ch-2 space, dc in next ch-2 space, dc in the place between 2 sewed squares, dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 2 (col. 108): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-1 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, * 3 dc in next ch-1 space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sI st to top of ch 3.

Round 3 (col. 108): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in the space between 2 groups of 3 dc sts, sc in the same space, 5 dc in next space between 2 groups of 3 dc sts, * sc in next space between 2 groups of 3 dc sts, 5 dc in next space between 2 groups of 3 dc sts **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sI st to the first sc. Fasten off.

Cord tie

Crochet a foundation hdc row, 225 240 (255) 270 285 300 315 330 345, pull the cord through the second row of the upper part of the skirt.





With col. 108, connect the yarn to any ch-1 space of the bottom part of the skirt and start crocheting:

Round 1 (col. 108): Ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 1, * (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1) rep to next ch-2 space, (3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1) twice **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 2-4 (col. 108): Ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in the same space, ch 1, * 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Round 5 (col. 108): SI st in next 2 dc, sI st in next ch-1 space, sc in the same space, 5 dc in next ch-1 space, * sc in next ch-1 space, 5 dc in next ch-1 space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sI st to the first sc. Fasten off.
