Vitreous

Puff Stitch Bag

Materials

Hobbii Friends Cotton 8/4 Mercerized

Yarn A: Lilac (63); 3 skeins
Yarn B: Pistachio (108); 3 skeins

Bag is worked with 4 strands of yarn at once

5 mm / US G crochet hook Always use a hook size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

Locking stitch marker, tapestry needle

Yarn Quality

Friends Cotton 8/4 Mercerized, Hobbii Fingering, Sock 100% Mercerized Cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (174 yds)

Gauge

3½ sts & 7 rows = 10cm / 4" over Puff st pattern on 5mm hook with 4 strands of yarn, without blocking Exact gauge is not essential, but fabric should be firm.

Finished Measurements: 15cm / 6" high x

18cm / 7" wide

Pattern Information

Vitreous is worked from the base upwards. The base is a flat rectangle made up of slip stitches, and the body of the bag is made up of puff stitches worked in the round upwards from the base. Straps are applied to the sides of the bag from the bottom up. Four strands of yarn are held together throughout.

US crochet terminology used throughout.

ABBREVIATIONS

blo: back loop only

ch: chain

dc: double crochet

fpdc: front post double crochet

Double Puff st: [Yo, insert hook in stitch, draw up a loop, (yo, insert hook in same st, draw up a

loop) three times (9 loops on hook), yo, draw yarn through all 9 loops on hook] twice

sk: skip

sl st: slip stitch

PATTERN BEGINS

BAG BASE

With 2 strands of Yarn A and 2 strands of Yarn B held together, ch31.

Row 1: SI st in blo in 2nd ch from hook, sI st in blo in every ch across, ch1, turn.

Row 2: SI st in blo in each sI st across, ch1, turn.

Repeat Row 2 a further 16 times.

Next row: SI st in blo in each sI st across, ch2, turn.

BAG BODY

Puff Stitch Section

First Side of Bag (long side): Sk 2 sl sts, double puff st into sl st, ch1, [sk 4 sl sts, double puff st into sl st, ch1] 5 times, sk 2 sl sts, dc into corner of base. Continue to short side of bag.

Second Side of Bag (short side): Work [double puff st, ch1] 3 times across the edge of the short side of the base evenly, dc in corner of bag base.



Repeat long side and short side once more, working final dc as a fpdc into ch2 at the beginning of Puff Stitch section. Do not turn. You will now continue to work in the round. Place a locking stitch marker at corner to mark beginning of round.

Bag Body Set Up round: [(Double puff st, ch1) into each puff st to corner, fpdc in corner dc] four times.

Next round: [(Double puff st, ch1) into each puff st to corner, fpdc in fpdc] four times. Repeat previous round 7 more times.

Final Puff St round: [(Double puff st, ch1) in each puff st to corner, fpdc in fpdc] 3 times, (double puff st, ch1) in each puff st to corner, sl st in fpdc. There should now be 11 rounds of puff sts.

Next round: SI st in each st to end.

Repeat previous round 3 more times. Cut yarn and fasten off.

STRAPS

With 2 strands of Yarn A and 2 strands of Yarn B, attach yarn and draw up a loop at one corner of bag base, on the long side, between puff st and dc. See graphics below for reference.







Working into the ladder created between the fpdcs and puff sts, insert hook under first ladder to sl st. Continue to very loosely sl st up the height of the bag into each ladder. Do not sl st over top sl st edge of bag. Continue by working 42 ch sts. Break yarn and fasten off.

Repeat Strap at each corner of bag. 4 straps total Knot 2 straps together on each side.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Blocking is not essential. Spray with fabric stiffener if desired to help keep bag's shape.
