MATERIALS

Highland Wool

2 skeins of color 37 2 skeins of color 25 1 skein of color 3

Circular needle 3.75 mm, 80 cm /US 5, 31.5"

YARN QUALITY

Highland Wool, Hobbii 100 % Peruvian Highland Wool 50 g / 1.8 oz = 175 m / 191 yds

GAUGE

21 stitches and 44 Rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4" in Garter Stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit P = Purl P3tog = Purl 3 stitches together YO = Yarn Over

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 193 cm / 76" Length: 76 cm / 30"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Evening is a cozy, textured shawl that is perfect for wrapping around your shoulders or neck for a cool evening walk. This triangular shawl is knit on the bias with alternating sections of textured stitches and simple garter rows for a relaxing but interesting project.

PATTERN STITCHES

Written pattern starts at page 6

GARTER STITCH PATTERN USING COLOR 37

(1 stitch increased with each repeat)

Row 1: Knit to the last stitch, YO, K1

Row 2: Knit all stitches

BRAMBLE STITCH PATTERN USING COLOR 3

(5 stitches increased with each repeat)

Row 1: Knit to the last stitch, YO, K1

Row 2: Knit all stitches

Row 3: K2, Purl to the last stitch, YO, K1

Row 4: K2, *K1, P1, K1) all into the same stitch, P3tog* repeat to the last 2 stitches, K2

Row 5: K2, Purl to the last stitch, YO, K1

Row 6: k2, P1, *P3tog, K1, P1, K1) all into the same stitch* repeat to the last 2 stitches, K2

Row 7: K2, Purl to the last stitch, YO, K1

Row 8: K2, P2. *K1 P1, K1) all into the same stitch, P3tog* repeat to the last 2 stitches, K2

Row 9: Knit to the last stitch, YO, K1



Row 10: Knit all stitches

BUBBLE STITCH PATTERN USING COLOR 25

(10 stitches increased with each partial repeat and 25 stitches increased with the full repeat)

Row 1: Knit to the last stitch, YO, K1

Row 2: Knit all stitches

Row 3: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 6 stitches, P4, K1, YO, K1

Row 4: K1, P2, K1, P2, K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 5: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 7 stitches, P4, K2, YO, K1

Row 6: K1, P3, K1, P2, K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to the last two stitches, K2

Row 7: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 8 stitches, P4, K3, YO, K1

Row 8: K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 9: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last stitch, YO, K1

Row 10: K1, P1, *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 11: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K1, YO, K1

Row 12: K1, P2, *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 13: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last 3 stitches, K2, YO, K1

Row 14: K1, P3, *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 15: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 4 stitches, P3, YO, K1

Row 16: K2, P2, K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 17: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 5 stitches, P4, YO, K1

Row 18: K1, P1, K1, P2, K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 19: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 6 stitches, P4, K1, YO, K1

Row 20: K1, P2, K1, P2, K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 21: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last 7 stitches, K4, P2, YO, K1

Row 22: *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2



Row 23: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last 8 stitches, K4, P3, YO, K1

Row 24: K1, *K1, P2, K1, P4 repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 25: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last stitch, YO, K1

Row 26: K1, P1, *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 27: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 2 stitches, P1, YO, K1

Row 28: K1, P1, K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 29: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 3 stitches, P2, YO, K1

Row 30: K1, P2, K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 31: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 4 stitches, P3, YO, K1

Row 32: K2, P2, K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 33: k2, *k4, p4* repeat to last 5 stitches, k4, yo, k1

Row 34: K2, P4, *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 35: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last 6 stitches, K4,P1, YO, K1

Row 36: K1, P1, K1, P4 *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last stitch, K2

Row 37: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last 7 stitches, K4, P2, YO, K1

Row 38: *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 39: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 8 stitches, P4, K3, YO, K1

Row 40: K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 41: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last stitch, YO, K1

Row 42: K2, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to the last two stitches, K2

Row 43: K2, *P4, K4* repeat to last 2 stitches, P1, YO, K1

Row 44: K1, P1, K1, *P4, K1, P2, K1* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 45: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last 3 stitches, K2 YO, K1

Row 46: K1, P3, *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 47: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last 4 stitches, K3, YO, K1



Row 48: K1, P4, *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 49: K2, *K4, P4* repeat to last 5 stitches, K4, YO, K1

Row 50: K2, P4, *K1, P2, K1, P4* repeat to last 2 stitches, K2

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Using Color 37 cast on 3 stitches using the long tail cast on method.

Work the Garter Stitch pattern rows 1 and 2 31 times (34 stitches)

Work the Bramble Stitch pattern Rows 1-10 one time (39 stitches)

Work the Garter Stitch pattern Rows 1 and 2 27 times (66 stitches)

Work the Bramble Stitch pattern Rows 1-10 one time (71 stitches)

Work the Bubble Stitch pattern Rows 1-20 one time and then work Rows 1 and 2 again. (82 stitches)

Work the Bramble Stitch pattern rows 1-10 one time (87 stitches)

Work the Garter Stitch pattern Rows 1 and 2 27 times (114 stitches)

Work the Bramble Stitch pattern Rows 1-10 one time (119 stitches)

Work the Bubble Stitch pattern Rows 1-20 one time and then work Rows 1 and 2 again. (130 stitches)

Work the Bramble Stitch pattern rows 1-10 one time (135 stitches)

Work the Garter Stitch pattern Rows 1 and 2 27 times (162 stitches)

Work the Bramble Stitch pattern Rows 1-10 one time (167 stitches)

Work the Bubble Stitch pattern Rows 1-50 one time. (192 stitches)

Work the Bubble Stitch pattern Rows 3-20 one time and then work Rows 1 and 2 again. (202 stitches)

Work the Bramble Stitch pattern rows 1-10 one time (207 stitches)

Work the Garter Stitch pattern Rows 1 and 2 once followed by Row 1 once. (209 stitches)



Bind off using your favorite stretchy bind off or the Knit Two Together Through the Back Loop bind off below. I like this one for shawls because it leaves a nice finish and is very stretchy without losing structure.

To work the "K2tog TBL" bind off you will start by knitting two stitches. Insert your left-hand needle into the front of both stitches on your right-hand needle and then knit those stitches together. (To me this looks exactly like a Slip, Slip, Knit stitch). Leave that stitch on your right-hand needle and knit the next stitch and bind those off in the same manner. Repeat until you have one stitch left on your needle. Break your yarn and pull the thread through the last loop to secure it. Weave in all ends and block to stated measurements. Block gently and try to avoid stretching the fabric to its full capacity. Stretching the shawl too much will flatten all of those gorgeous textures that you worked so hard to create!
