# Picnic

## Scarf

## MATERIALS

4 skeins of Divina color 01 (primary color)  
2 skeins of Divina color 11 (secondary color)

Crochet hook 5.5 mm / US I/9  
Scissors  
Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Divina**, Hobbii  
65% Alpaca, 28% Polyamide, 7% Wool  
50 g / 1.75 oz = 150 m / 164 yds

## GAUGE

15 sts x 10 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"



## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
sk = skip a stitch  
dc = double crochet  
ddc = deep double crochet = dc worked  
into the skipped stitches from previous row  
\*-\* = repeat between \*

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 32 cm / 12.5"  
Length: 200 cm / 78.75"

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

If you like a wider scarf add as many rows as you like.

If you would like to adjust the length of your scarf please make sure to chain a multiple of 6 + 1, then just follow the pattern.

Remember to buy enough yarn if you are adding to the size.

I like to weave in my ends as I go, otherwise it can be quite overwhelming at the end.

## THE PIECE

With primary color, ch 301, turn and sc starting with the second ch from the hook, so in total you should make 300 sc

Row 2: \*ch3, sk3, 3 dc\* , cut the yarn and pull through



Row 3: switch to your secondary color, ch3, turn your work  
Sk3, 3ddc (work into the 3 stitches you skipped last row, shown with the blue needle in the following picture), \*ch3, sk3, 3ddc\*

At the end of the row cut the yarn and pull through



Row 3

Row 4-33 : continue \*ch3, sk3, 3ddc\*  
Color changes: \*2 Rows in primary color, 1 row in secondary color\*



Row 4



Row 5



Row 34: ch1, \*3sc, 3ddc\*

Make sure your first 2 rows and your last row are in your primary color.  
Weave all your ends in and your scarf is done ✓
