# MATERIALS

#### **Friends Ribbon**

skein of color Antique Rose (53) (A)
skein of color Mustard (28) (B)
skein of color Turkish Blue (88) (C)
skein of color Eucalyptus (98) (D)

Crochet hook 10 mm / US N,P/15

### **YARN QUALITY**

Friends Ribbon, Hobbii 100 % Cotton 250 g / 8.8 oz = 125 m / 136 yds

#### GAUGE

8 sc x 11 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain sl st = slip stitch sc = single crochet dc = double crochet hdc = half double crochet bo = bobble stitch fp = front post bp = back post inc = increase sts = stitches

#### SIZE

One size

#### MEASUREMENTS

Width: 33 cm / 13" Length: 51 cm / 20"

#### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

This is the "Bloom - Bowl Mat" crochet pattern for pets. It's such a fun project that uses a large 10 mm crochet hook, which makes it quick and satisfying to see the mat come together. What makes it really special is that each round uses a different stitch, so you get a beautiful mix of textures and it's never boring to work on. Plus, it comes with a detailed photo guide to walk you through each step, making it perfect for adventurous beginners and experienced crocheters alike. Give it a try and add a unique touch to your home decor and a colorful spot for your pets to enjoy!

# **INFO AND TIPS**

Here's how to crochet a bobble stitch in this pattern:

- 1. Yarn over, insert your hook into the stitch where you want to make the bobble stitch.
- 2. Yarn over and pull up a loop. You should have 3 loops on your hook.
- 3. Yarn over and pull up through 2 loops that are on your hook.
- 4. Yarn over and repeat that process again x 3 times: Insert your hook into the same stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through 2 loops on your hook.
- 5. Yarn over and pull through all the loops.

## Let's begin!

Start with color A.

Ch 24. Crochet in rounds.

Round 1: Starting from the second ch from the hook, sc 22. In the last stitch crochet 3 sc. Now crochet 21 sc on the other side of the foundation chain. Inc in the last stitch. (48)



Continue with color B

Round 2: inc with hdc sts in the first stitch, hdc 21, inc in the next 3 sts with hdc, hdc 21, inc in the next 2 sts with hdc. (54)





Continue with color C

Round 3: hdc, inc in the next stitch with hdc, hdc 21, (hdc, inc in the next stitch with hdc) x 3 times, hdc 21, (hdc, inc in the next stitch with hdc) x 2 times. (60)



Continue with color D

Round 4: Alternate dc fp and dc bp in every stitch of this round (60)



Continue alternating A, B, C and D yarn for the next rounds.

Round 5: dc 2, inc in the next st with dc, dc 21, (dc 2, inc in the next st with dc) x 3 times, dc 21, (dc 2, inc in the next st with dc) x 2 times. (66)






Round 6: Alternate bo and hdc in every stitch of this round. (66)



Round 7: dc 3, inc in the next st with dc, dc 21, (dc 3, inc in the next st with dc) x 3 times, dc 21, (dc 3, inc in the next st with dc) x 2 times. (72)



Crochet the next round into the third loop of every stitch. This loop is located on the back of the stitch, just below the top two loops.

Round 8: dc 4, inc in the next st with dc, dc 21, (dc 4, inc in the next st with dc) x 3 times, dc 21, (dc 4, inc in the next st with dc) x 2 times. (78)





Round 9: Alternate dc fp and dc bp in every stitch of this round. (78)



Round 10: (Skip one st, dc 6 in the next st, skip one st, sl st in the next st) x 19 times. Fasten off and weave in the end.
