# Color Splash

## Bucket Hat

## MATERIALS

3 (4) skeins of Rainbow Cotton 8/6, col 14  
1 Friends Cotton 8/4 Mini Color Pack (or  
scrap yarns in a variety of colors)

Crochet hook 6 mm / US J-10  
Tapestry needle  
Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/6**, Hobbii  
100% Cotton  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 105 m (114 yds)

## GAUGE

8 sc and 8 rounds = 5 cm x 5 cm / 2" x 2"  
with yarn held double  
2 sc V-stitch columns = 3 cm / 1.25" wide

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain  
rnd = round  
sc = single crochet  
sk = skip  
sl st = slip stitch  
st(s) = stitch(es)

## SIZE

Child (Adult)

## MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 48 (58.5) cm / 19 (23)"  
Length: 20.5 (25.5) cm / 8 (10)"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This bucket hat will bring happiness on those summer days with its unique look and vibrant hues. Choose your favorite Hobbii colors to match your outfits because you'll want to make more than one!

The hat is worked from the top down using 2 strands of yarn held together. The crown and brim are worked in a single crochet spiral with increases, while the body of the hat is worked in single crochet V-stitch without increases. Colorful lines are embroidered after the hat is complete.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

**Crab stitch (reverse single crochet):** Work single crochet from left to right.

**V-stitch:** Ch1, \*(sc, ch1, sc) into next st, sk 1 st; rep from \* around.

**Custom Sizing:** For a smaller hat, work 1-3 fewer crown rounds, then continue to the body of the hat. For a larger hat, continue increasing in the same manner for 1-2 additional rounds before continuing to the body. On the brim, resume increasing at 6 points around every other round until brim is the desired depth.

## CROWN

**Note:** Crown is worked in a spiral, with 6 stitches increased every round. Place a stitch marker in the first st and move it up each round.

Using 2 strands of Rainbow Cotton 8/6 held together, begin with magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into ring.

**Rnd 2:** (2sc) into each st around, placing a marker in the first st and moving it up each round. 12 sts.

**Rnd 3:** (1sc, 2sc in next st) around. 18 sts.

**Rnd 4:** (Sc in each of next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 24 sts.

**Rnd 5:** (Sc in each of next 3 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 30 sts.

**Rnd 6:** (Sc in each of next 4 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 36 sts.

**Rnd 7:** (Sc in each of next 5 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 42 sts.

**Rnd 8:** (Sc in each of next 6 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 48 sts.

**Rnd 9:** (Sc in each of next 7 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 54 sts.

**Rnd 10:** (Sc in each of next 8 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 60 sts.

**Child Size Only, Rnd 11:** Work 1 round sc, sl st into first st to join. Skip to Body.

Crown now measures about 13 cm / 5" in diameter.



**Adult Size Only, continue:**

**Rnd 11:** (Sc in each of next 9 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 66 sts.

**Rnd 12:** (Sc in each of next 10 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 72 sts.

**Rnd 13:** (Sc in each of next 11 sts, 2sc in next st) around. 78 sts.

**Rnd 14:** Sc around, sl st into first st to join.

Crown now measures about 16 cm / 6.25" in diameter.

**BODY**

**Rnd 1:** Ch1, \*(sc, ch1, sc) into next st, sk 1 st; rep from \* around, join with sl st.

Repeat Rnd 1 a further 8 (11) times, working following V-sts into ch1 spaces of the previous row.

**BRIM**

**Note:** Brim continues in a spiral, with 6 stitches increased on every other round. Place a stitch marker in the first st and move it up each round.

**Rnd 1:** [2sc in first st, sc in next 9 (12) sts] around. 66 (84) sts.

**Rnd 2:** Sc around.

**Rnd 3:** [2sc in first st, sc in next 10 (13) sts] around. 72 (90) sts.

**Rnd 4:** Sc around.

**Rnd 5:** [2sc in first st, sc in next 11 (14) sts] around. 78 (96) sts.

**Rnd 6:** Sc around.

**Rnd 7:** [2sc in first st, sc in next 12 (15) sts] around. 84 (102) sts.

**Rnd 8:** Sc around.

**Rnd 9:** [2sc in first st, sc in next 13 (16) sts] around. 90 (108) sts.

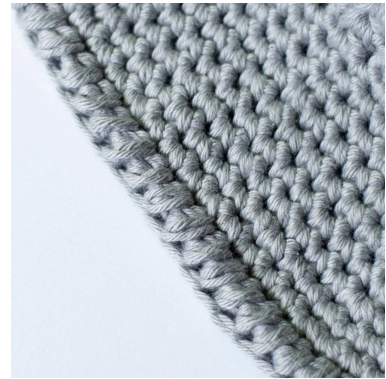
**Child Size Only:** Skip to Edging.

**Adult Size Only, continue:**

**Rnd 10:** Sc around.

**Rnd 11:** [2sc in first st, sc in next 17 sts] around. 114 sts.





### Edging

Work 1 round of crab stitch (image 1) to end.

Work 1 round of sl sts into the third loop at the underside of the crab stitch to end (image 2), join with sl st. Fasten off.

### EMBROIDERY

Using Friends Cotton 8/4 or scrap yarn held double, thread a length onto a tapestry needle. Refer to photos.

#### Body Embroidery

Begin embroidery on the first round of the Body V-stitch. \*Draw needle up through fabric and around 1 V-stitch 4 times, bring needle to wrong side, skip next V-stitch; rep from \* around. Skip 1 round of V-stitch. Work another round of embroidery on next and every other round of Body, aligning the wraps vertically and changing colors as desired.

#### Brim Embroidery

For Brim embroidery, work the first round so that the wraps appear between the wraps of the last body round, then continue by aligning further wraps vertically.





## **FINISHING**

Weave in all ends and block.
