



CROCHET PATTERN

Christmas Gonk

MATERIALS


1 skein of Toucan col. 15
2 skeins of Peacock col. 06
1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/8 col. 01
1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/8 col. 40

Crochet hook 3 mm / US D/3
Crochet hook 6 mm / US J/10
Stitch marker
Polyester Filling 300g / 10.5z

YARN QUALITY

 **Toucan**, Hobbii
100 % Polyester
100 g / 3.5 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

 **Peacock**, Hobbii
100 % Polyester
100 g / 3.5 oz = 65 m / 71 yds

 **Friends Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii
100 % Cotton
50 g / 1.75 oz = 75 m / 82 yds

GAUGE

Across first 5 rounds (when laying flat) = 10
cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 18 cm / 7"
Height: 30.5 cm / 12"

PATTERN INFORMATION

If you have mastered the usual techniques such as the magic ring, crocheting single crochet stitches in spiral rounds and crocheting in rows, the pattern should not be a problem for you. Other techniques, such as the loop stitch, are explained separately in the pattern.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
 sc = single crochet
 dc = double crochet
 tr = treble crochet
 sl st = slip stitch
 dec = decrease
 ls = loop stitch
 pm = place marker
 rep = repeat
 RS = right side
 WS = wrong side

INFO AND TIPS

When fastening off, leave a 25 cm / 10" tail, this tail can then be used to sew the pieces together. Be careful to not pull the Toucan yarn too hard as it will snap, this will leave a short tail and the piece may then fall apart if the ends are not sewn in correctly. Pm in the first st of each round, moving marker up each round. Beginning chains do not count as sts unless otherwise stated.

Loop Stitch (ls) – Insert hook into stitch, wrap yarn around index finger and keep finger to desired length for loop (approx. 2.5 cm / 1"). Wrap hook clockwise around the yarn (yarn under) laying front of the index finger and then grab the yarn laying behind the index finger. Pull yarn through st (2 loops on hoop). Yarn over, pull through remaining loops. Remove finger from loop.

BODY

Round 1: Using hook 3 mm and Toucan, 6 sc into magic ring (6 sts)
 Round 2: *Sc 2 in next st* rep from * 6 times (12 sts)
 Round 3: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next* rep from * 6 times (18 sts)
 Round 4: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 2 sts* rep from * 6 times (24 sts)
 Round 5: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 3 sts* rep from * 6 times (30 sts)
 Round 6: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 4 sts* rep from * 6 times (36 sts)

Round 7: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 5 sts* rep from * 6 times (42 sts)

Round 8: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 6 sts* rep from * 6 times (48 sts)

Rounds 9-13: Sc in each st around

Round 14: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts* rep from * 6 times (42 sts)

Rounds 15-17: Sc in each st around

Round 18: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts* rep from * 6 times (36 sts)

Rounds 19-21: Sc in each st around

Round 22: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 4 sts* rep from * 6 times (30 sts)

Round 23: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts* rep from * 6 times (24 sts)

Round 24: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 1 st* rep from * 8 times (16 sts)

Begin to stuff the gonk, continue to stuff as you complete the next rows.

Round 25: *Dec over next 2 sts* rep from * 8 times (8 sts)

Round 26: *Dec over next 2 sts* rep from * 8 times, fasten off.

FEET

Make 2

Round 1: Using hook 3 mm and Toucan, 6 sc into magic ring (6 sts)

Round 2: *Sc 2 in next st* rep from * 6 times (12 sts)

Round 3: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next* rep from * 6 times (18 sts)

Rounds 4-5: Sc in each st around.

Round 6: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 1 st* rep from * 6 times (12 sts)

Round 7: Pm, sc in each st around, fasten off.

BEARD

Row 1 (RS): Using hook 3 mm and Friends Cotton 8/8 Colour 01, ch 2, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook (3 sts)

Row 2 (WS) : Ls 2 in next st, ls to last st, ls 2 in last st, ch 1, turn (5 sts)

Row 3: Sc 2 in next st, sc to last st, sc 2 in last st, ch 1, turn (7 sts)

Rep rows 2 and 3 four times.

Row 12: Ls 2 in next st, ls to last st, ls 2 in last st, ch 1, turn (21 sts)

Row 13: Sc in each st across

Row 14: Ls in each st across.

Rep rows 12 and 13 three times and fasten off.

NOSE

Round 1: Using hook 3 mm and Friends Cotton 8/8 colour 40, dc 6 into magic ring (6 sts)

Round 2: *Sc 2 in next st* rep from * 6 times (12 sts)

Round 3: *Sc 2 in next st, 1 sc in next st* rep from * 6 times (18 sts)

Rounds 4-7: Sc in each st around, fasten off.

ARMS

Make 2

Round 1: Using hook 3 mm and Friends Cotton 8/8 colour 01, ch 16, sl-st join to beg ch, sc in each st around, sl-st join, ch 1 (16 sts)

Round 2: Sc in each st around, sl-st join, join in colour 40, ch 1

Round 3: Sc in each st around

Round 4: Sc in each st around, sl-st join, join in colour 01, ch 1

Rep Rounds 2-4 two times.

Round 11: Sc in each st around, sl-st join, join in Toucan, fasten off colour 01, ch 1

Round 12: *Sc in next 2 sts, miss next st* rep from * 4 times, sc in next 4 sts, sl-st join, ch 1 (12 sts)

Rounds 13-14: Sc in each st around

Round 15: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next st* rep from * 4 times (8 sts)

Round 16: *Dec over next 2 sts* rep from * 4 times (4 sts)

Fasten off and use tail to sew through last 4 sts and pull tight to close the opening, stuff the hand and stop where the arm starts.

HAT

Round 1: Using hook 6 mm and Peacock, 12 tr into magic ring, sl-st join, ch 2 (12 sts)

Round 2: * Tr 2 in next st, tr 1* rep from * 6 times, sl-st join, ch 2 (18 sts)

Rounds 3-7: Tr in each st around, sl-st join, ch 2

Round 8: * Tr 2 in next st, tr 2* rep from * 6 times, sl-st join, ch 2 (24 sts)

Rounds 9-10 : Tr in each st around

Round 11: * Tr 2 in next st, tr 3* rep from * 6 times, sl-st join, ch 2 (30 sts)

Rounds 12-13: Tr in each st around

Round 14: * Tr 2 in next st, tr 4* rep from * 6 times, sl-st join (36 sts)

HAT POM POM

Round 1: Using hook 3 mm and Friends Cotton 8/8 colour 01, 6 sc into magic ring, (6 sts)

Round 2: * Sc 2 in next st* rep from * 6 times (12 sts)

Round 3: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next* rep from * 6 times (18 sts)

Round 4: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 2 sts* rep from * 6 times (24 sts)

Round 5: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 3 sts* rep from * 6 times (30 sts)

Rounds 6-10: Sc in each st around

Round 11: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts* rep from * 6 times (24 sts)

Round 12: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts* rep from * 6 times (18 sts)

Round 13: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 1 st* rep from * 6 times (12 sts)

Round 14: *Dec over next 2 sts* rep from * 6 times (6 sts)

Stuff the pom pom firmly and use the tail to weave in and out of the remaining 6 sts to close the opening, sew the pom pom to the closed end of the hat.

CONSTRUCTION

Firstly, sew the feet to round 8, sew on the first foot and then leave a space of 4 sts and sew the next foot, then sew the beard to round 18 of the body lining the point of the beard up with the centre of two feet.

Sew both arms to opposite sides of the beard on round 18 and sew the nose in the centre of the beard, stuff the nose as you sew around.

Lastly sew the hat on to round 18 of the body.
