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CROCHET PATTERN

Calendula Shawl

Wrap with Bobbles and Fringe

MATERIALS

Hobbii x Pom Pom Garland

Yarn A: Chipmunk; 4 balls

Yarn B: Sylvie; 2 balls

Yarn C: Heart of Gold; 2 balls

5mm / US H crochet hook Always use a hook size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

3 stitch markers, tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Garland, Hobbii x Pom Pom Worsted weight 70% Cotton, 30% Alpaca 105m / 114yd per 50 g

GAUGE

18 sts & 18 rows = 10cm / 4" over swatch pattern using 5mm hook after blocking.

Swatch Pattern

Ch22.

Row 1 (RS): Ch2 (counts as first st), work hdc in next st to end, turn.

Row 2 (WS): Ch1 (does not count as first st), work 1sl st in 3lo in each st to end,

Rep rows 1-2 a further 20 times. Fasten off.

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

175cm / 69" long x 45cm / 18" wide

PATTERN INFORMATION

Calendula is crocheted from side to side in one piece. Stitches are increased on one side and left unworked on the other side, creating spikey garlands. The pattern consists of rows of half double crochet and slip stitch in the third loop. Each spike section features rows of contrasting puff stitches. The edging is worked in half double crochet and finished with contrasting tassels. The shawl is reversible, although the two sides are not identical.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg: beginning

ch: chain

dec: decrease/d/ing
hdc: half-double crochet

inc: increase/d/ing
PM: place marker

RS: right side

sk: skip

sl st: slip stitchst/s: stitch/esWS: wrong side

STITCH GLOSSARY

3lo: Third loop only

PS (Puff stitch): [Yo, insert hook into st, draw up a loop] 5 times into same stitch, yo, draw through all 11 loops on hook, ch1.

hdc3tog (Half double crochet 3 together): [Yo, insert hook, draw up a loop] 3 times, yo and draw through 7 loops on hook.

The yarn to be used for each row is indicated in the row label, e.g. "Row 1 (WS, A)" is a WS row worked with yarn A.

US crochet terminology used throughout.



Unless otherwise stated, do not fasten off yarn A between colours, and carry it up on the wrong side of your work. When picking up a carried colour, pull up a loop to the height of a ch before making your first st. Change colours by working the first chain in the new colour.

When working slip stitches in the third loop only, make sure your stitches are not too tight as this will make working into the following row difficult.

PATTERN BEGINS

Note: To help you identify the edge stitches, place a stitch marker into the first stitch of each row.

Using Yarn A, ch3.

Row 1 (RS)(inc): Ch2 (counts as first st on RS rows throughout), 2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st, turn. 4 sts

Rows 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 (WS): Ch1 (does not count as first st), 1sl st in 3lo in each st to end, turn.

Row 3 (RS)(inc): Ch2, [2hdc in next st] twice, 1hdc in next st, turn. 6 sts

Row 5 (inc): Ch2, [2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st] twice, 1hdc in next st, turn. 8 sts

Row 7 (inc): Ch2, [2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st] twice, hdc in next st to end, turn. 10 sts

Row 9 (inc): Ch2, [2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st] twice, hdc in next st to end, turn. 12 sts

Row 11 (inc): Ch2, [2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st] twice, hdc in next st to end, turn. 14 sts

Row 12 (WS): Ch1 (does not count as first st), 1sl st in 3lo in each st to end, turn.

Main Pattern

Row 1 (RS, B)(dec): Using Yarn B, ch2, [PS in next st, ch1, sk1] to last 3 sts, PS in next st, sk1, 1hdc, turn. Fasten off. 1 st dec

Row 2 (WS, C): Using Yarn C, ch2 (counts as first st), [PS in next st, ch1, sk1] 3 times, PS in next st, PM in last st, [ch1, sk1, PS in next st] to last st, 1hdc, turn. Fasten off.

Row 3 (A)(dec): Ch2, [2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st] twice, hdc in each st to marker, remove marker, turn. 5 sts dec

Row 4: Ch1, work 1sl st in 3lo in each st to end, turn.

Row 5 (RS)(inc): Ch2, [2hdc in next st, 1hdc in next st] twice, hdc in each st to end, turn. 2 sts inc

Rows 6-14: Rep rows 4-5 a further 4 times, then rep row 4 only once more. 8 sts inc Rep Rows 1-14 of Main Patt a further 12 times, then rep rows 1-2 only once more. 66 sts

Edging

The edging round is divided into three parts: the short edge, the spikes and the long side.

Short side: With RS facing and Yarn A, ch2 (counts as first st), hdc in each of next 64 sts.



Spike side:

Spike Row 1 (RS): [1hdc, ch2, 1hdc] in next st, 13hdc across side, 1hdc3tog, hdc in each of next 5 sts.

Rep Spike row 1 a further 12 times.

Last spike row (RS): [1hdc, 2ch, 1hdc] in next st, 14hdc across side, 2hdc in next st, hdc, 2hdc in next st.

Long Side: Work hdc across side to end, [1hdc, ch2, sl st] in second ch of beg ch to join. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block to measurements.


Tassel

Cut 8 lengths of yarn B and yarn C, each about 25cm / 10". Attach fringe to ch2-spaces of spikes as follows, alternating yarns B and C: folding the length in half, insert the folded end through the centre of the st using a needle or hook, then draw the loose ends through the loop. Once all fringe has been added, comb through them and trim carefully to 10cm / 4" or desired length.
