Adorned Pullover

Garter Yoke Pullover

MATERIALS

Hobbii x Pom Pom Garland

Shade: Heart of Glass; 9 (10, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17) balls

4mm / US 6 circular needle, 60-80cm / 24-32" length, **and** needles of choice suitable for working small circumference in the round 3mm / US 3 needles of choice suitable for working small circumference in the round 3.5mm / US 4 circular needle, 40-60cm / 16-24" length

Always use a needle size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

1 stitch marker, stitch holders or scrap yarn, tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Garland, Hobbii x Pom Pom Worsted weight
70% Cotton, 30% Alpaca
105m / 114yd per 50 g

SIZE

1 (2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9)

MEASUREMENTS

Finished chest (fullest point) circumference: 96.5 (104, 114, 120, 130.5, 140.5, 151.5, 159, 170.5) cm / 38 (41, 45, 48, 51½, 55¼, 59¾, 62½, 67¼)" – to be worn with 16-22 cm / 6¼ – 8¾" positive ease Model has a 86.5cm / 34" chest circumference and is wearing a size 2.

PATTERN INFORMATION

Adorned is worked from the top down, knit in the round, in one piece. Starting at the neckline, increases are worked throughout the yoke until the upper body is completed. The yoke is then separated into lower body and sleeves, and each part is worked separately, in the round.

Pattern







GAUGE

20 sts & 28 rows = 10cm / 4" over st st pattern on 4mm / US 6 needles after blocking.
21 sts & 36 rows = 10cm / 4" over garter st pattern on 4mm / US 6 needles after blocking.
22 sts & 38 rows = 10cm / 4" over garter st pattern on 3.5mm / US 4 needles after blocking.
23 sts & 42 rows = 10cm / 4" over garter st pattern on 3mm / US 3 needles after blocking.

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg: beginning
Dec: decrease
Inc: increase

K: knit

K2tog: knit two stitches together

Kfbfb: knit into front and back of same stitch twice

Kwise: knitwise

P: purl

P2tog: purl two stitches together

PM: place marker

Rep: repeat

RS: right side of work

SI: slip

Ssk: Slip 2 stitches knitwise one at a time, knit them together through back loop

St(s): stitch(es)

St st: stocking stitch / stockinette

WS: wrong sideYo: yarn over



STITCH GLOSSARY

Garter st

Round 1: K to end.
Round 2: P to end.

Rep rounds 1-2 for pattern.

Latvian cast on

Start as for a long-tail cast-on, leaving a tail that is 3 - 4 times longer than the length of final cast on edge and with a slip knot.

Now place the tail over the left thumb and the working yarn over the left index finger. Hold the tail and the working yarn with the other left fingers.

You will alternate between a normal long-tail cast on st, and one picked up from the strand of your thumb slightly differently, as follows:

Cast on st 1 (traditional long-tail cast on): pick up the tail thread below your thumb, from front to back, then knit it with the working thread above, which is located over your index finger.

Cast on st 2: pick up the tail thread above your thumb, from below, then knit it with the working thread above, on your index finger. Switch the position of the thumb if necessary to make this st easier.

Repeat these two cast on sts until all the sts have been cast on.

Yarnover Increases

Increases are worked as yarnovers on knit rounds. Close the yarnover on the following round by knitting or purling it through the back loop.

Make Bobble (MB)

Round 1 (RS): Kfbfb, turn. 4 sts

Row 2 (WS): P4, turn. Row 3 (RS): K4, turn.

Row 4 (WS): P2tog, p2tog, turn. 2 sts

Row 5 (RS): SI1, k1, pass slipped st over. 1 st



PATTERN

Note: When working the round following an increase round, close the yarnovers by knitting or purling them through the back loop.

Neck

Using the Latvian cast-on method and short 3mm circular needles, cast on 104 (106, 108, 110, 120, 124, 132, 136, 138) sts. Turn.

Round 1: K to end. Join for working in the round being careful not to twist. PM to indicate beg of round.

Round 2: P to end.

Work a further 4 rounds in Garter st.

Inc round 1: [K2, yo] to end. 156 (159, 162, 165, 180, 186, 198, 204, 207) sts

Next round: P to end, closing yarnovers by purling them through the back loop.

Work 4 rounds in Garter st.

Change to 3.5mm needles.

Work 8 rounds in Garter st.

Inc round 2: [K3, yo] to end. 208 (212, 216, 220, 240, 248, 264, 272, 276) sts

Next round: P to end, closing yarnovers.

Work 2 rounds in Garter st.

Change to 4mm needles.

Inc round 3: [K104 (17, 27, 55, 20, 62, 132, 34, 69), yo] 2 (12, 8, 4, 12, 4, 2, 8, 4) times, k0 (8, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0). 210 (224, 224, 224, 252, 252, 266, 280, 280) sts

Note: Close yarnovers while working the next round.

Work rows 1-14 of Chart, working 14-st rep 15 (16, 16, 16, 18, 18, 19, 20, 20) times across round. Knit 2 rounds.

Sizes 1 (7) ONLY:

Next round (inc): K53 (67), yo, k105 (133), yo, k to end. 212 (268) sts

Next round: Knit, closing yarnovers.

ALL Sizes again

Inc round 4: [K4, yo] to end. 265 (280, 280, 280, 315, 315, 335, 350, 350) sts

Next round: K to end, closing yarnovers.

Work in St st for 11 (14, 14, 14, 14, 14, 14, 14) rounds.



Inc round 5: [K6 (5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5), yo] until last 1 (0, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0, 0) st, k to end. 309 (336, 336, 336, 378, 378, 402, 420, 420) sts

Next round: K to end, closing yarnovers.

Sizes 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9 ONLY:

Work in St st for - (-, 14, 14, 16, 22, 22, 28, 28) rounds.

Inc round 6: [K- (-, 12, 7, 14, 6, 7, 6, 4), yo] until last - (-, 0, 0, 0, 0, 3, 0, 0) sts, k to end. - (-, 364, 384, 405, 441, 459, 490, 525) sts

All sizes again

Continue straight in St st until the Yoke measures 23.5 (24.5, 25, 25.5, 26, 28.25, 29.5, 32.5, 33.5)cm / 9¹/₄ (9³/₄, 9³/₄, 10, 10¹/₄, 11, 11¹/₂, 12³/₄, 13¹/₄)" measured at the center back.

Divide Body and Sleeves

Next round: K44 (48, 53, 54, 59, 64, 67, 71, 77) sts, slip next 66 (72, 76, 84, 84, 92, 94, 102, 108) sts to stitch holder or scrap yarn, cast on 8 (8, 8, 12, 12, 16, 16, 16) sts with backwards loop method, k89 (96, 106, 108, 119, 129, 136, 143, 155) sts, slip next 66 (72, 76, 84, 84, 92, 94, 102, 108) sts to stitch holder or scrap yarn, cast on 8 (8, 8, 12, 12, 12, 12, 16, 16, 16) sts with backwards loop method, k44 (48, 53, 54, 59, 64, 68, 72, 77). Remove marker, k48 (52, 57, 58, 65, 70, 75, 79, 85) sts, PM to indicate new beg of round. 193 (208, 228, 240, 261, 281, 303, 318, 341) sts

BODY

Work straight in St st until Body measures 22.5 (23.5, 24, 24, 24, 24, 24.5, 25, 25.5, 25.5)cm / 8% (9%, 9%, 9%, 9%, 9%, 9%, 9%, 10, 10)" from underarm or 1cm / %" less than desired length.

Work 4 rounds in Garter st, ending on a p round. Cast off knitwise.

SLEEVES (both alike)

Using 4mm needles, beg at center of underarm, pick up and knit 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts from underarm cast-on, k66 (72, 76, 84, 84, 92, 94, 102, 108) from stitch holder or scrap yarn, pick up and knit 4 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6, 8, 8, 8) sts from underarm cast-on, PM to indicate beg of round. 74 (80, 84, 92, 96, 104, 110, 118, 124) sts

Work 2 rounds in St st.

Dec round: K2tog, k to last 2 sts, ssk. 2 sts dec

Rep Dec round every 7 (5, 5, 4, 4, 3, 3, 3, 2)th round a further 11 (3, 15, 2, 12, 7, 7, 23, 3) times, then every 8 (6, 6, 5, 5, 4, 4, 4, 3)th round 1 (12, 2, 16, 8, 17, 17, 5, 28) times. 48 (48, 48, 54, 54, 54, 60, 60, 60, 60) sts



Work straight until sleeve measures $38.5 \,\mathrm{cm}$ / $15\frac{1}{4}$ " from underarm or $3 \,\mathrm{cm}$ / $1\frac{1}{4}$ " before desired sleeve length.

Work 4 rounds in Garter st.

Change to 3.5mm needles and work 4 rounds in Garter st. Change to 3mm needles and work 4 rounds in Garter st. Cast off all sts kwise.


FINISHING

Weave in ends and block to measurements.

B. Length (hem to underarm): 22.5 (23.5, 24, 24, 24, 24.5, 25, 25.5, 25.5)cm / 8¾ (9¼, 9½, 9½, 9½, 9¾, 9¾, 10, 10)"

C. Yoke depth: 23.5 (24.5, 25, 25.5, 26, 28.25, 29.5, 32.5, 33.5)cm / 9¹/₄ (9³/₄, 9³/₄, 10, 10¹/₄, 11, 11¹/₂, 12³/₄, 13¹/₄)"

D. Sleeve length: 41.5cm / 161/4"


E. Upper arm circumference: 37 (40, 42, 46, 48, 52, 55, 59, 62)cm / 14½ (15¾, 16½, 18, 19, 19¾, 21¾, 23¼, 24½)"

F. Neck circumference : 45 (46, 47, 48, 52, 54, 57, 59, 60)cm / 17¼ (18, 18½, 19, 20½, 21½, 22½, 23½, 23½)"
