MATERIALS Divina

1 skein of color 31 (A) 1 skein of color 02 (B) 1 skein of color 06 (C) 2 skeins of color 03 (D)

Circular needle 6 mm, 40 cm / US 10, 16" Circular needle 6 mm, 100 cm / US 10, 40" Yarn needle

YARN QUALITY

Divina, Hobbii 65% Alpaca, 28% Polyamide, 7% Merino Wool 50 g / 1.75 oz = 150 m / 164 yds

GAUGE

16 sts x 32 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4" in Garter Stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on BO = bind off K = knit Rep = repeat RS = right side St(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 21.5 cm / 8.5" Length: 167.5 cm / 66"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is worked flat entirely in garter stitch. The scarf is made up of one block knit in the log cabin style composed of seven sections. Eight of these blocks sewn together make the scarf. The central section is knit in a bright color and is surrounded by sections of skinny stripes and wide stripes knit in bold black and cream colors. Then two more sections are knit in light gray to bring the block to a finished 20.5 cm / 8" size square. After the blocks are completed, they are sewn together to create the length of the scarf. Finally, stitches are picked up along the long sides of the scarf for two rows of garter stitch. There is a schematic included of the log cabin block at the end of the pattern.

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

INFO AND TIPS Garter Stitch All Rows: Knit.

Log Cabin Block

Use shorter needles to make the block. Make 8 identical blocks.

Section 1 (Solid)

With A, CO 10 sts using long-tail cast-on method or preferred method of cast-on. Row 1 (RS): Knit. Rows 2-16: Knit. BO all sts. Cut A, leaving a 7.5-10 cm / 3-4" tail.

Section 2 (Skinny Stripes)

Row 1 (RS): Turn the block 90 degrees clockwise (BO edge will now be to the right). With B, pick up and knit 10 sts along the left edge of the Section 1 block. Row 2 (WS): Knit. Rows 3 and 4: With C, knit. Rows 5 and 6: With B, knit. Rep Rows 3-6 two times. Rep Rows 3 and 4 one time. With B, BO, leave the remaining st on the needle. Cut C, leaving a 7.5-10 cm / 3-4" tail.

Section 3 (Skinny Stripes)

Row 1 (RS): Turn the block 90 degrees clockwise. With B, pick up and knit 17 sts along the left edge of the Section 2 block. [18 sts] Row 2 (WS): Knit.



Rows 3 and 4: With C, knit. Rows 5 and 6: With B, knit. Rep Rows 3-6 two times. Rep Rows 3 and 4 one time. With B, BO, leave the remaining st on the needle. Cut C, leaving a 7.5-10 cm / 3-4" tail.

Section 4 (Wide Stripes)

Row 1 (RS): Turn the block 90 degrees clockwise. With B, pick up and knit 17 sts along the left edge of the Section 3 block. [18 sts] Rows 2-4: Knit. Rows 5-8: With C, knit. Rows 9-12: With B, knit. Rows 13-16: With C, knit. With B, BO, leave the remaining st on the needle. Cut C, leaving a 7.5-10 cm / 3-4" tail.

Section 5 (Wide Stripes)

Row 1 (RS): Turn the block 90 degrees clockwise. With B, pick up and knit 25 sts along the left edge of the Section 4 block. [26 sts] Rows 2-4: Knit. Rows 5-8: With C, knit. Rows 9-12: With B, knit. Rows 13-16: With C, knit. With B, BO, leave the remaining st on the needle. Cut C, leaving a 7.5-10 cm / 3-4" tail.

Section 6 (Solid)

Row 1 (RS): Turn the block 90 degrees clockwise. With D, pick up and knit 25 sts along the left edge of the Section 5 block. [26 sts] Rows 2-16: Knit. BO, leave the remaining st on the needle.

Section 7 (Solid)

Row 1 (RS): Turn the block 90 degrees clockwise. With D, pick up and knit 33 sts along the left edge of the Section 6 block. [34 sts] Rows 2-16: Knit. BO all sts. Cut D, leaving a 7.5-10 cm / 3-4" tail.

Section 8 (Solid)

This section is only added to <u>one</u> block. This block will be at one end of the scarf. Row 1 (RS): With D, pick up and knit 34 sts along the edge of the block where Section 5 (longer wide striped section) and Section 6 (shorter solid section) are located.




Rows 2-16: Knit. BO all sts. Cut D, leaving a 7.5-10 cm / 3-4" tail.

Finishing

Using the picture as a guide, lay the blocks in the orientation shown. With D, use the mattress stitch seaming technique to seam the blocks together. After all blocks are sewn, lay the scarf with RS facing and the long edges parallel to you. Row 1 (RS): With longer circular needles and D, pick up and knit 266 sts along one long edge. Row 2 (WS): Knit. BO all sts <u>loosely</u>. Rep with the other long edge of the scarf. Weave in loose ends. Block to measurements.
