



**CROCHET PATTERN**

### **MATERIALS**

**Tweed Delight** 

**A:** 1 (2) skein(s) of color 22 **B:** 1 (1) skein of color 19

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G/6 Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8 Tapestry needle

# **YARN QUALITY**

**Tweed Delight**, Hobbii 85% wool, 10% acrylic, 5% viscose 50 g / 1.75 oz = 100 m / 109 yds

#### **GAUGE**

4 sts and 4 rows = 2.5 cm x 2.5 cm / 1" x 1"in soft moss stitch

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

3LO = third loop only BLO = back loop only ch = chaindc = double crochet dc2tog = double crochet 2 together dc3tog = double crochet 3 together hdc = half double crochet hdc2tog = half double crochet 2 together RS = right side of work sc = single crochet sc2tog = single crochet 2 together sl st = slip stitch st(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side of work yo = yarn over hook rep = repeat

#### SIZE

Child (Adult)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Circumference: 45 (52.5) cm / 18 (21)" Length: 20.5 (26.5) cm / 8 (10.5)"

#### PATTERN INFORMATION

The Ted Beanie is a Unisex hat. It is stitched from a soft and lightweight, wool blend yarn making it perfect for fall and winter. Tweed Delight Yarn offers a wide variety of color in its palette so choosing the colors for the two-toned beanie provides limitless possibilities for different looks.

The brim is worked sideways in a strip and the short ends joined together. The lateral braids are worked in the round, while the soft moss stitch stripes are worked in joined rows.

Blue version: Tweed Delight color 25 and 24.

## **INFO AND TIPS**

## US crochet terms are used throughout.

When single sts are worked one after another (without increasing or decreasing), this is given in the style "Xsc". For example, 5sc = sc in each of next 5 sts.

**Hdc2tog:** [Yo, insert hook into next st, yo and draw up a loop] twice, yo, draw through 5 loops on hook.

**Dc3tog:** [Yo, insert hook into next st, yo and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops] 3 times, yo, draw through 4 loops on hook.

**Dc2tog:** [Yo, insert hook into next st, yo and draw up a loop, yo and draw through 2 loops] twice, yo, draw through 3 loops on hook.

**Sc2tog:** [Insert hook into next st, yo and draw up a loop] twice, yo, draw through 3 loops on hook.

**Invisible Join:** Elongate final st and remove hook, insert hook into first st of round from back to front, replace elongated st on hook and draw through first st. Can be substituted with a sl st join.

#### Soft Moss Stitch (even number of sts)

**Row 1:** Ch1, [1sc in next st, 1dc in next st] to end, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch1, [1sc, 1dc] to end, turn.

**Note:** To keep pattern correct, sc should be worked into dc of previous row and dc should be worked into sc of previous row.









#### **BRIM**

With smaller hook and yarn A, Ch 8 (10).

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch1 (does not count as st throughout), scBLO in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end. 7 (9) sts.

Row 2: Ch1, scBLO to end.

Rep Row 2 for 70 (82) more rows, ending with a RS row.

Fold in half with RS together, [sl st into next st and 1 st from beg ch] to end. Fasten off.

## **BODY**

Change to larger hook.

#### Stripe 1 (Lateral Braid)

Join yarn B.

**Round 1:** Ch1, hdc around working 1 st into the end of each row of brim, work invisible join or sl st. 72 (84) sts.

**Round 2:** Ch1, [hdc into 3lo at back] around, work invisible join or sl st.

Round 3: Ch1, [hdc into 3lo at back] around, work invisible join or sl st.

Fasten off.

## **Stripe 2 (Soft Moss Stripe)**

Turn work to WS. Join yarn A.

Row 1 (WS): Ch1, working into 3rd loop at front, [1sc, 1dc] around, join with sl st, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Ch1, [1sc, 1dc] around, join with sl st, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch1, [1sc, 1dc] around, join with sl st, turn.

Row 4: Rep row 2.

Fasten off.

# **Stripe 3 (Lateral Braid)**

Join yarn B.

**Round 1:** Ch1, hdc around, work invisible join or sl st.

**Round 2:** Ch1, hdc 3lo around, work invisible join or sl st.

**Round 3:** Ch1, hdc 3lo around, work invisible join or sl st.

Fasten off.









**Child Size ONLY:** Rep Stripe 2 once more.

Adult Size ONLY: Rep Stripes 2-3 once more, then work Stripe 2 only once more.

# **CROWN**

#### **Final Lateral Braid**

Join yarn B.

**Dec Round 1:** Ch1, [10hdc, hdc2tog] around, work invisible join or sl st. 66 (77) sts.

**Dec Round 2:** Ch1, working into 3lo [9hdc, hdc2tog] around, work invisible join or sl st, turn.

60 (70) sts.

**Dec Round 3:** Ch1, working into 3lo [8hdc, hdc2tog] around, work invisible join or sl st, turn.

54 (63) sts. Fasten off.

## Top

Turn work to WS. Join yarn A.

**Dec Row 4 (WS):** Ch1, [(1sc, 1dc) 3 times, 1sc, dc2tog] around, join with sl st, turn. 48 (56) sts

Dec Row 5 (RS): Ch1, [(1sc, 1dc) 3 times, sc2tog] around, join with sl st, turn. 42 (49) sts

Dec Row 6: Ch1, [(1dc, 1sc) 2 times, 1dc, sc2tog] around, join with sl st, turn. 36 (42) sts

**Dec Row 7:** Ch1, [(1dc, 1sc) 2 times, dc2tog] around. 30 (35) sts

Dec Row 8: Ch1, [sc, dc, sc, dc2tog] around, join with sl st, turn. 24 (28) sts

Dec Row 9: Ch1, [sc, dc, sc2tog] around, join with sl st, turn. 18 (21) sts

Next round: Ch1, [dc3tog] around. 6 (7) sts

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Sew top closed. Weave in ends.
