

METRO - HAT & SCARF

Multicolored spike stitch beanie and fringe scarf



Winter is no match for the wooly warmth of the Metro Hat and Scarf set. Both pieces use an addictive spike stitch pattern that allows the vibrant color palette to shine. Thoughtful finishing touches like a fuzzy faux-fur pom pom and playful fringe ensure you'll stand out among the crowd.

The Metro Hat & Scarf pattern is part of the Happy Place pattern collection, designed to complement Happy Place Apricity Yarn. Find even more patterns and get the yarn needed for this project from Hobbii's website.

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PROJECT SUPPLIES

YARN: Hobbii Happy Place Apricity, super bulky weight (#6); 65% alpaca, 28% polyamide, 7% wool [76 yards per 50g skein].

- Hat uses 1 skein each of colors 07, 12, 14, 24, and 25.
- Scarf uses 2 skeins each of colors 07, 12, 14, 24, and 25.

HOOK: US L-11 (8mm) hook and US N/P-15 (10mm) hook – adjust hook size to meet gauge

NOTIONS: Scissors, tapestry needle, 10-cm pom pom, steam blocking supplies

DIMENSIONS

SIZE: Scarf measures 10" (25.5cm) wide x 80" (203.25cm) long, Hat measures 9" (22.75cm) wide x 9" (22.75cm) tall when flat.

GAUGE:

- Hat – 13 sts x 13 rows = 6" (15.25cm) in pattern stitch
- Scarf – 10 sts x 12 rows = 6" (15.25cm) in pattern stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

BLO = back loop only

Cc = change color

Ch = chain

Dc = double crochet

Dec = decrease (see Special Stitches)

Fsc = foundation single crochet ([tutorial](#))

Hdc-slst = half double crochet slip stitch (see Special Stitches)

Rep = repeat

RS = right side

Sc = single crochet

Sk = skip

Sl St = slip stitch

Spike = spike stitch (see Special Stitches)

St(s) = stitch(es)

Tch = turning chain

PATTERN DIRECTIONS

NOTE

- Starting ch-3 = dc + ch 1
- Portions of this pattern are written in crochet shorthand. For example, “sc 3” means to single crochet in each of the next 3 stitches.
- Fasten off the color no longer in use after each color change.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Decrease (*dec*): single crochet 2 together.

Half Double Crochet Slip Stitch (*hdc-slst*): yarn over, insert hook into next stitch, yarn over, pull up a loop, pull through all remaining loops on hook.

Spike Double Crochet (*spike*): working over the chain space, dc in both loops of the next stitch 2 rows below.

HAT

BRIM

ROW 1 (RS): With color 12 and 8mm hook, leave a long tail for sewing and ch 9, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across row, turn.

ROW 2: Ch 1, hdc-slst BLO across row, turn.

ROW 3: Ch 1, sl st BLO across row, turn.

Repeat Rows 2-3 to 43 total rows. Rotate to work along Row Ends with RS facing.

BODY

ROUND 1 (RS): Continuing with color 12, ch 1, sc in each row end, join with a sl st in first sc of round to work in the round, turn. (43 sts)

ROUND 2: Ch 3, sk the sc at base of ch AND next sc, dc in the following sc, (ch 1, sk 1*, dc 1) around, ending last rep at *, sl st in 3rd ch of tch, cc to color 24, turn.

ROUND 3: Ch 1, sc in same st as join, spike 1, (sc 1, spike 1) around, sl st in first st of round, turn.

ROUND 4: Ch 3, sk the sc at base of ch AND next sc, dc in the following sc, (ch 1, sk 1*, dc 1) around, ending last rep at *, sl st in 3rd ch of tch, cc to color 07, turn.

ROUNDS 5-12: Repeat Rounds 3-4 four times. Complete Rounds 5-6 with color 07, Rounds 7-8 with color 14, Rounds 9-10 with color 25, and Rounds 11-12 with color 12. Cc to color 24 at the end of Round 12.

ROUND 13: With color 24, repeat Round 3.

ROUND 14: Ch 1, (sc 3, dec) 8 times, sc 4, turn. (36 sts)

ROUND 15: Ch1, (sc 2, dec) 8 times, sc 4, turn. (28 sts)

ROUND 16: Ch 1, sc 2, (sc 1, dec) 8 times, sc 2, turn. (20 sts)

ROUND 17: Ch 1, sc 2, dec 8 times, sc 2. Fasten off leaving a long tail. (12 sts)

Turn hat inside out. Thread long tail left from Round 17 onto a tapestry needle. Insert needle into each stitch of Round 17, pull tail to close top of hat and weave in end.

Use tail from start of hat to seam short sides of the Brim together. Weave in end.

Weave in all remaining ends. Lightly steam block if desired.

Attach pom pom to top of hat.

SCARF

ROW 1: With color 24 and 10mm hook, leave a 9" (22.75cm) tail and fsc 147, turn. Alternatively, ch 148, sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across row, turn.

ROW 2: Ch 1, dc in first st, (ch 1, sk 1, dc in next sc) across row, cc to color 07, turn.

ROW 3: Ch 1, sc in first st, (spike 1, sc 1) across row, turn.

ROW 4: Ch 1, dc in first st, (ch 1, sk 1, dc in next sc) across row, cc to color 14, turn.

ROWS 5-18: Repeat Rows 3-4 seven times with the following color changes – complete Rows 5-6 with color 14, Rows 7-8 with color 25, Rows 9-10 with color 12, Rows 11-12 with color 24, Rows 13-14 with color 07, 15-16 with color 14, and Rows 17-18 with Color 25. Cc to color 12 at the end of Row 18.

ROW 19: With color 12, repeat Row 3.

ROW 20: Ch 1, sc in first st and each st across row. Fasten off leaving a 9" (22.75cm) tail.

IT'S TASSEL TIME!

Tassels are optional, but they're a great way to avoid weaving in all those ends.

1. Cut 16 18" (45.75cm) lengths of each color.
2. Holding 2 cut strands together, make a tassel on each row end, matching the color of the row. Collect the hanging yarn tails when making your tassels. Find a demonstration of this technique [here](#).
3. Steam tassels and trim to an even length.

Weave in any remaining ends. Lightly steam block to final dimensions.



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
