## MATERIALS

### Toucan

1 skein of each colour:  
Ecru (02), Sand (04), Pastel Yellow (05),  
Mustard (06), Orange (09), Coral (10),  
Red (15), Bordeaux (20), Plum (26),  
Mint (27), Sage (28), Forest Green (29)

### Rainbow Cotton 8/8


1 skein of each colour:  
Natural white (002), Beige (004)


Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8

600 grams of Fiberfill  
(lightly stuffed)

Yarn needle  
Stitch marker  
Long sewing pins  
Scissors  
Fabric glue (optional)

## YARN QUALITY

 **Toucan**, Hobbii  
100% Polyester  
100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii  
100% Cotton  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 75 m (82 yds)

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Corn, leek, beetroot, radish, onion, eggplant  
and carrot (with leaves): approx. 20 cm / 8"  
tall

Bell pepper, pumpkin and tomato: approx. 15  
cm / 6" tall

# Pattern



## ABBREVIATIONS

MR = magic ring

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

BLO = work the stitch in the back loop only

FLO = work the stitch in the front loop only

inc = work 2 stitches in the same st to increase

dec = invisible crochet decrease (crochet 2 sts together in only front loops)

Rnd = round/rounds

Row = row/rows

slst = slip stitch

st = stitch/stitches

bo = bobble stitch (2dc bobble st)

## INFO AND TIPS

- Read the pattern before you start crocheting.
- Crochet in continuous, spiral rounds unless otherwise stated in the pattern.
- Stuff your amigurumi as you go.
- Always mark the beginning of each round or row using a stitch marker.
- Pattern has a beginner friendly level.
- When you close the piece or make ridges or bumps (bell pepper, pumpkin) be careful with pulling the yarn too hard, because it breaks easily.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**Bobble stitch (bo)** – Yarn over, insert hook into indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through the first 2 loops. 2 loops will remain on the hook. Repeat the process one more time. You should have 3 loops on your hook. Yarn over and pull through all 3 loops.

**Bobble stitch increase (boinc)** – Make two bobble stitches into the same stitch.

## EGGPLANT



### Body

With Toucan col. 26. Stuff as you go.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

**Rnd 4:** (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

**Rnd 5:** (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

**Rnd 6:** (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

**Rnd 7:** (5sc, scinc) x6 (42)

**Rnd 8 – Rnd 11:** 1sc in each stitch around – 4 rounds (42)

**Rnd 12:** (5sc, scdec) x6 (36)

**Rnd 13 – Rnd 15:** 1sc in each stitch around – 3 rounds (36)

**Rnd 16:** (4sc, scdec) x 3, 1sc in each of the rest stitches of this round (33)

**Rnd 17 – Rnd 18:** 1sc in each stitch around – 2 rounds (33)

**Rnd 19:** (3sc, scdec) x3, 1sc in each of the rest stitches of this round (30)

**Rnd 20 – Rnd 22:** 1sc in each stitch around (30)

**Rnd 23:** (3sc, scdec) x6 (24)

**Rnd 24:** (2sc, scdec) x6 (18)

**Rnd 25:** (1sc, scdec) x6 (12)

**Rnd 26:** scdec x6 (6)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Leaves

With Toucan col. 29

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** 1sc in each stitch around (6)

**Rnd 3:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 4:** (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

**Rnd 5:** (8sc, scinc) x2 (20)

**Rnd 6:** (sc, hdc, dcinc, hdc, sc) x4 (24)

Fasten off, leave a long tail to sew the leaves into the top of the eggplant.

## TOMATO



### Body

With Toucan col. 15. Stuff as you go.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

**Rnd 4:** (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

**Rnd 5:** (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

**Rnd 6:** (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

**Rnd 7:** (5sc, scinc) x6 (42)

**Rnd 8:** (6sc, scinc) x6 (48)

**Rnd 9 – Rnd 13:** 1sc in each stitch around – 5 rounds (48)

**Rnd 14:** (6sc, scdec) x6 (42)

**Rnd 15:** (5sc, scdec) x6 (36)

**Rnd 16:** (4sc, scdec) x6 (30)

**Rnd 17:** (3sc, scdec) x6 (24)

**Rnd 18:** (2sc, scdec) x6 (18)

**Rnd 19:** (1sc, scdec) x6 (12)

**Rnd 20:** scdec x6 (6)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Leaves

With Toucan col. 28.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** [ch5, 1sc into second chain from the hook, 1sc in each chain across, slst into the next st] repeat [...] 5 more times.

Fasten off, leave a long tail to sew the leaves into the top of the tomato.

## CARROT



### Body

With Toucan col.10. Stuff as you go.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** 1sc in each stitch around (6)

**Rnd 3:** (1sc, scinc) x3 (9)

**Rnd 4:** 1sc in each stitch around (9)

**Rnd 5:** (2sc, scinc) x3 (12)

**Rnd 6:** 1sc in each stitch around (12)

**Rnd 7:** (3sc, scinc) x3 (15)

**Rnd 8:** 1sc in each stitch around (15)

**Rnd 9:** (4sc, scinc) x3 (18)

**Rnd 10:** 1sc in each stitch around (18)

**Rnd 11:** (5sc, scinc) x3 (21)

**Rnd 12:** 1sc in each stitch around (21)

**Rnd 13:** (6sc, scinc) x3 (24)

**Rnd 14:** 1sc in each stitch around (24)

**Rnd 15:** (7sc, scinc) x3 (27)

**Rnd 16 – Rnd 18:** 1sc in each stitch around – 3 rounds (27)

**Rnd 19:** (7sc, scdec) x3 (24)

**Rnd 20:** (6sc, scdec) x3 (21)

**Rnd 21:** (5sc, scdec) x3 (18)

**Rnd 22:** (4sc, scdec) x3 (15)

**Rnd 23:** (3sc, scdec) x3 (12)

**Rnd 24:** scdec x6 (6)

## Leaves

With col. 28.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** [ch14, 1sc into second chain from the hook, 1sc in each chain across, slst into the next stitch] repeat [...] 5 more times

Fasten off, leave a long tail to sew the leaves into the top of the carrot.

## LEEK



## Body

Start with col. 02. Stuff as you go.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

**Rnd 4:** (5sc, scinc) x3 (21)

**Rnd 5 - Rnd 14:** 1sc in each stitch around – 10 rounds (21)

At the end of the Rnd 14, change the colour to col. 27 and fasten off col. 28.

**Rnd 15 – Rnd 19:** 1sc in each stitch around – 5 rounds (21)

At the end of the Rnd 19, change to col. 28 and fasten off col. 27.

**Rnd 20 – Rnd 22:** 1sc in each stitch around – 3 rounds (21)

**Rnd 23:** BLO, 1sc in each stitch around (21)

**Rnd 24:** (5sc, scdec) x3 (18)

**Rnd 25:** (1sc, scdec) x6 (12)

**Rnd 26:** scdec x6 (6)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

## Leaves

With Toucan col. 28.

**Row 1:** Join col. 28 into the front loop of Rnd 23, make sc into the same stitch as join. 6sc, ch1, turn. (7)

**Row 2 – Row 9:** 7sc, ch1, turn – 8 rows. (7)

**Row 10:** 1scdec, 3sc, 1scdec, ch1, turn. (5)

**Row 11:** 1scdec, 1sc, 1scdec. (3)

Fasten off, weave in ends.

Repeat Row 1 – Row 11, two more times.

### Roots

With Rainbow Cotton 8/8 col. 002

Cut 14 strands of yarn about 15cm / 6" long. Loop two strands at the time around each sc of the Rnd 1 of the leek. You should have seven loops of two strands at the end. Trim the roots.

## ONION



### Body

With Toucan col. 04. Stuff as you go.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc in MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

**Rnd 4:** (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

**Rnd 5:** (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

**Rnd 6:** (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

**Rnd 7:** (5sc, scinc) x6 (42)

**Rnd 8:** (6sc, scinc) x6 (48)

**Rnd 9 – Rnd 11:** 1sc in each stitch around – 3 rounds (48)

**Rnd 12:** (6sc, scdec) x6 (42)

**Rnd 13 – Rnd 14:** 1sc in each stitch around – 2 rounds (42)

**Rnd 15:** (5sc, scdec) x6 (36)

**Rnd 16:** (4sc, scdec) x6 (30)

**Rnd 17:** (3sc, scdec) x6 (24)

**Rnd 18:** BLO (2sc, scdec) x6 (18)



**Rnd 19:** (1sc, scdec) x6 (12)

**Rnd 20:** scdec x6 (6)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Join Toucan col. 04 into the front loop of the Rnd 18

**Rnd 1:** FLO, 1sc in each stitch around (18)

**Rnd 2:** 3sc, 3hdc, 3dc, 3hdc, 3sc, 3slst. (18)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

## Leaves

With Toucan col. 28. We're going to make three leaves of different lengths.

### Leaf 1

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2 – Rnd 11:** 1sc in each stitch around – 10 rounds (6)

### Leaf 2

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2 - Rnd 7:** 1sc in each stitch around – 6 rounds (6)

### Leaf 3

**Rnd 1:** 6sc into MR (6)

**Rnd 2 – Rnd 5:** 1sc in each stitch around – 4 rounds (6)

Fasten off all leaves and leave long tails to sew them into the top of the onion.

## Roots

With Rainbow Cotton 8/8 col. 004.

Cut 14 strands of yarn about 15 cm /6" long. Loop two strands at the time around each sc of the Rnd 1 of the onion. You should have seven loops of two strands at the end. Trim the roots.

## BEETROOT



## Body

With Toucan col. 20. Stuff as you go.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc in MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

**Rnd 4:** (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

**Rnd 5:** (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

**Rnd 6:** (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

**Rnd 7:** (5sc, scinc) x6 (42)

**Rnd 8:** (6sc, scinc) x6 (48)

**Rnd 9 – Rnd 11:** 1sc in each stitch around – 3 rounds (48)

**Rnd 12:** (6sc, scdec) x6 (42)

**Rnd 13 – Rnd 14:** 1sc in each stitch around – 2 rounds (42)

**Rnd 15:** (5sc, scdec) x6 (36)

**Rnd 16:** (4sc, scdec) x6 (30)

**Rnd 17:** (3sc, scdec) x6 (24)

**Rnd 18:** (2sc, scdec) x6 (18)

**Rnd 19:** 1sc in each stitch around (18)

**Rnd 20:** (1sc, scdec) x6 (12)

**Rnd 21:** 1sc in each stitch around (12)

**Rnd 22:** scdec x6 (6)

**Rnd 23:** scdec x3 (3)

**Rnd 24:** scdec, 1sc (2)

**Rnd 25:** scdec (1)

To finish, make a few chains to create a root and fasten off. Weave in all ends.

## Leaves

(make 3)

Start with Toucan col. 20

Ch11, start with a second chain from the hook, 1sc in each chain across. Fasten off.

Join Toucan col. 29 into the first sc and now we're going to make green round around our foundation chain: 3slst, 3sc, 3hdc, dcinc x4, 3hdc, 3sc, 3slst

Fasten off and leave a long tail to sew the leaf into the top of the beetroot.

## SWEETCORN



### Body

With Toucan col. 05. Stuff as you go.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc in MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1bo, 1boinc) x6 (18)

**Rnd 4 – Rnd 11:** 1bo in each stitch around – 8 rounds (18)

**Rnd 12:** (1sc, scdec) x6 (12)

**Rnd 13:** scdec x6 (6)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Leaves

(make 2)

With Toucan col. 27

Ch8, start with the second chain from the hook

**Row 1:** 6sc, 3sc into one stitch, 6sc, 1scinc (16)

**Row 2:** 6dc, dcinc x3, 6dc, dcinc x2 (22)

**Row 3:** 6dc, (1dc, dcinc) x3, 6dc, (1dc, dcinc) x2 (27)

Slst into the next stitch. Fasten off, leave a long tail to sew the leaves to the corn.

## RADISH



### Body

Start with Toucan col. 15. Stuff as you go.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc in MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

**Rnd 4:** (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

**Rnd 5:** (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

**Rnd 6:** (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

**Rnd 7:** (5sc, scinc) x6 (42)

**Rnd 8 – Rnd 9:** 1sc in each stitch around – 2 rounds (42)

**Rnd 10:** (5sc, scdec) x6 (36)

**Rnd 11 – Rnd 13:** 1sc in each stitch around – 3 rounds (36)

**Rnd 14:** (4sc, scdec) x6 (30)

At the end of the Rnd 14, change the col. 02 and fasten off col. 15.

**Rnd 15:** (3sc, scdec) x6 (24)

**Rnd 16:** (2sc, scdec) x6 (18)

**Rnd 17:** (1sc, scdec) x6 (12)

**Rnd 18:** 1sc in each stitch around (12)

**Rnd 19:** scdec x6 (6)

**Rnd 20:** scdec x3 (3)

**Rnd 21:** scdec, 1sc (2)

**Rnd 22:** scdec (1)

To finish, make a few chains to create a root. Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Leaves

(make 3)

With Toucan col. 28

Ch15, start from the third chain from the hook

6dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 5slst

Now we're going to work on the other side of the foundation chain.

5slst, 1sc, 1hdc, 6dc. Slst into the first dc, ch1.

Make a row of slst through the middle of the leaf, from the top to the bottom and fasten off leaving a long tail.

## BELL PEPPER



### Body

With Toucan col. 06. Stuff as you go.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc in MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** (1sc, scinc) x6 (18)

**Rnd 4:** (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

**Rnd 5:** (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

**Rnd 6:** (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

**Rnd 7 – Rnd 12:** 1sc in each stitch around - 6 rounds (36)

**Rnd 13:** (5sc, scinc) x6 (42)

**Rnd 14 – Rnd 16:** 1sc in each stitch around – 3 rounds (42)

**Rnd 17:** (6sc, scinc) x6 (48)

**Rnd 18 – Rnd 20:** 1sc in each stitch around – 3 rounds (48)

**Rnd 21:** (6sc, scdec) x6 (42)

**Rnd 22:** (5sc, scdec) x6 (36)

**Rnd 23:** (4sc, scdec) x6 (30)

**Rnd 24:** (3sc, scdec) x6 (24)

At the end of the Rnd 24, change the col. 28 and fasten off col. 06

**Rnd 25:** (2sc, scdec) x6 (18)

**Rnd 26:** (1sc, scdec) x6 (12)

**Rnd 27 – Rnd 31:** 1sc in each stitch around – 5 rounds (12)

**Rnd 32:** scdec x6 (6)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

You can leave the pepper as it is, but you can also give it a bit of shape. To do so, take a long piece of main colour and a long needle. Insert the needle through the centre on the bottom of our pepper. Bring it back up through the pepper between the green and mustard, then wrap the yarn around the outside of the pepper and insert the needle through the centre of the bottom again, pulling the yarn a little bit (not too hard, to avoid breaking the yarn). Repeat this process to create as many bumps as you like. I made three of them.

## PUMPKIN



### Body

With Toucan col. 09.

Ch25,

**Row 1:** hdc into the second chain from the hook and hdc into the rest chains down the row, ch1, turn (24)

**Row 2:** BLO, hdc in each stitch, ch1, turn (24)

**Row 3 – Row 25:** repeat Row 2 – 22 rows (24)

Fold our rectangle into a half, short sides together and join with the row of slst.

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail.

Now turn the pumpkin inside out and using a needle sew a running stitch around the bottom opening to close it up. Pull it tight, fasten off and weave in ends.

Start stuffing a pumpkin.

Cut another long piece of yarn and sew up the top of the pumpkin in the same way as the bottom, add more stuffing if necessary, cinch the top closed and knot the yarn.

Do not fasten off. We're using the rest of our yarn to make a few ridges on the pumpkin.

Insert the needle through the bottom of the pumpkin, wrapping the yarn around the outside and come out (through the middle of the pumpkin) to the top. Repeat the process to create as many ridges as you like.



## Stem

Using Toucan col. 28.

**Rnd 1:** 6sc in MR (6)

**Rnd 2:** scinc x6 (12)

**Rnd 3 - Rnd 4:** 1sc in each stitch around - 2 rounds (12)

Fasten off, leave a long tail to sew the stem into the top of the pumpkin.

You can put a little bit of stuffing into the stem, before sew.
