MATERIALS

Friends Ribbon

1 skein of color 84

1 skein of color 05

Crochet hook 6 mm / US J/10

Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Ribbon**, Hobbii

100 % Cotton

250 g / 8.8 oz = 125 m / 136 yds

GAUGE

13 hdc sl st blo x 11 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm /
4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc sl st = half double crochet slip stitch

blo = back loop only

fo = fasten off

sts = stitches

Inc = increase by making two hdc sl st blo in
the last stitch

Dec = pull up a loop in the first st, pull up a
loop in the second stitch, then pull through

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 25 cm / 9.75"

Length: 38 cm / 15"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Albers Pattern is a fun crochet project that lets you make a cool hanging basket. This basket is perfect for storing yarn, supplies, or anything else you need to keep organized. You'll be using ribbon yarn and a 6 mm crochet hook to make it.

For this project, you'll need two skeins in two different colors. As you crochet, you'll switch between these colors to create a unique pattern that looks awesome on both sides of the basket. Don't worry, there's a helpful photo guide and easy-to-follow instructions to guide you every step of the way.

MAIN PIECE

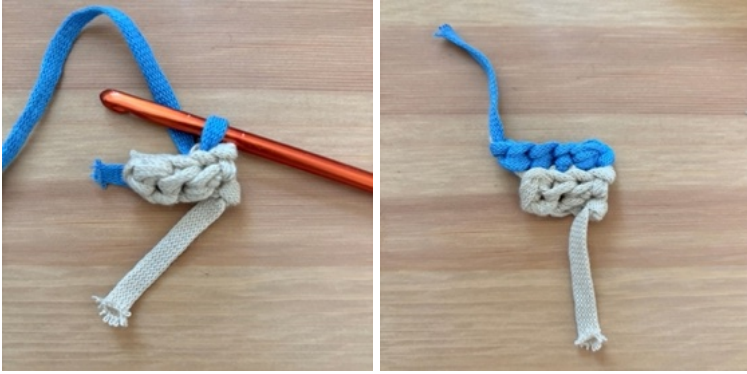
For the main piece, you'll need to crochet a large triangle using half double crochet slip stitch in the back loop only (hdc sl st blo). Here's how to do it: Start with beige yarn and make a foundation chain by first making a slip knot, then chain 4.



R1: starting from the 2 ch from the hook, hdc sl st 3, fo, change color to blue. (3)



R2: ch 1, turn, crochet 2 hdc sl st blo, inc blo in the last stitch, fo, change color. (4)



For each of the following rows, finish by fastening off the yarn. Then, change the yarn color, alternating between beige and blue for each new row.

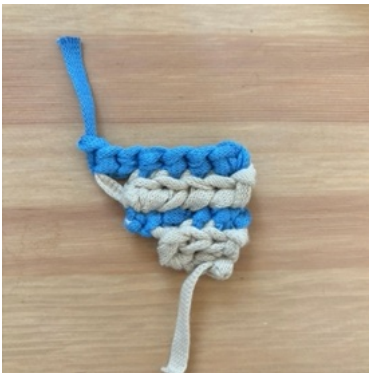
Beige yarn.

R3: ch 1, turn, inc blo, in the next 3 sts hdc sl st blo. (5)



Blue yarn.

R4: ch 1, turn, in the next 4 sts hdc sl st blo, inc in the last st blo. (6)



R5: ch 1, turn, inc blo, in the next 5 sts hdc sl st blo. (7)



Keep increasing until R42 (44 sts)



Start decreasing on the same side of the triangle.

Beige yarn.

R43: ch 1, turn, dec blo, hdc sl st blo in the next 42 sts. (43)

Blue yarn.

R44: ch 1, turn, hdc sl st blo in the next 41 sts, dec blo. (42)

Beige yarn

R45: ch 1, turn, dec blo, hdc sl st blo in the next 40 sts. (41)

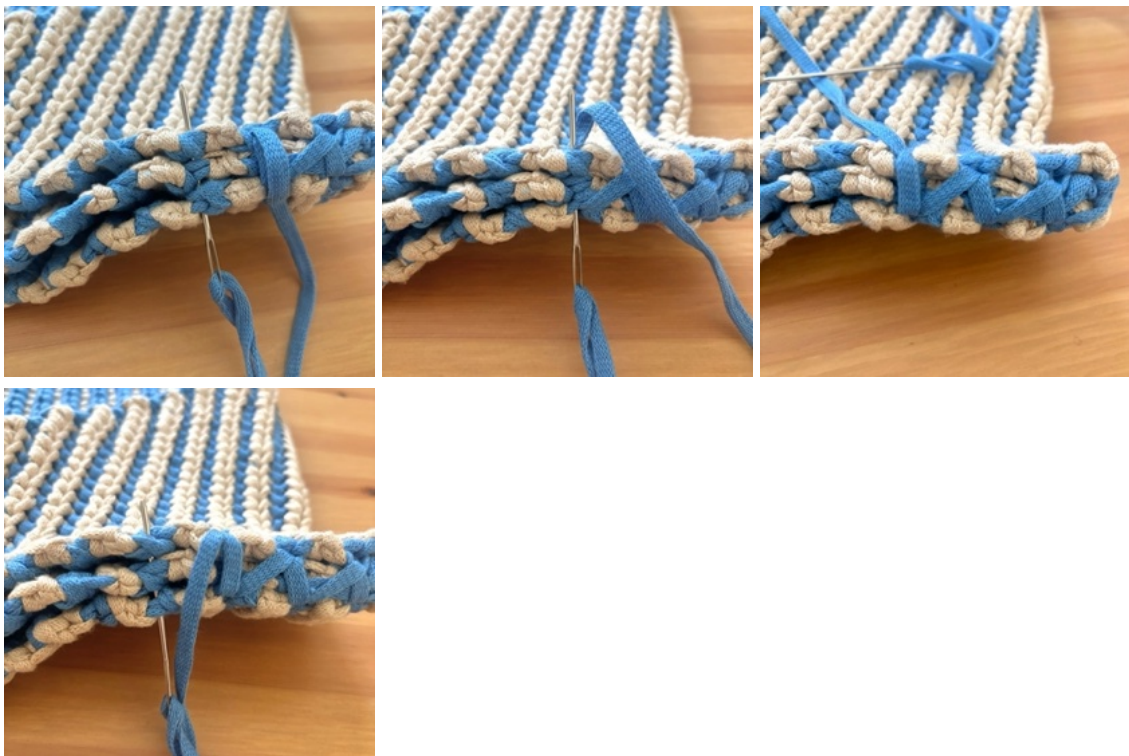
Continue decreasing until R83. (3)



Now fold both corners as shown in the pictures:



Cut a long piece of blue yarn, and using your tapestry needle, sew the bottom of the basket. Align all the blue rows together and sew along them.



Sew with your tapestry needle at the point where both sides overlap to secure the opening of your basket.



HANGING LOOP

Chain 5 and then fo. Make a loop by sewing both ends together. Attach the loop to the basket with your tapestry needle at the end of row 42 and weave in the ends.
