# Docker

Hat

Design: Apple of My Eye | Hobbii Design




## MATERIALS

2 (2) skeins of **Friends Wool** color Off White (02)

Circular needle 4 mm (US 6) – 60 cm (24")  
Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Wool**, Hobbii  
100 % Wool  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

## GAUGE

18 sts x 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4") in pattern

## ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)  
k = knit  
p = purl  
tbl = through the back loop  
rnd(s) = round(s)  
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together  
dec = decrease  
co = cast on  
BOR = beginning of round

## SIZE

S (M) L

## MEASUREMENTS

Length: 24 (25) 26 cm / 9.4 (9.8) 10.2"  
Circumference: 40 (44) 48 cm / 15.7 (17.3) 18.9"

## ABOUT THE PATTERN

The Docker Hat is perfect for both beginners as well as intermediate and expert knitters. Using simple techniques and a beautiful Gansey pattern, you get a lovely and warm hat that is ideal for the cold months.

The hat is shown in the colors Off White (02) and Cappuccino (10).

# Pattern



## INFORMATION AND TIPS

The hat is worked bottom up. First, a folded brim is worked in rib stitch. Next, the hat is worked in pattern with decreases for the top.

## Docker Hat

### Ribbing and pattern

Using circular needle 4 mm (US 6), co 96 (112) 128 sts and work rib stitch in the round as follows: \*k2, p2; repeat from \* to end. Work rib stitch until the work measures 8 cm / 3.1". On the next rnd, begin working the pattern (see Pattern below). Work pattern until the work measures 16 (17) 18 cm / 6.3 (6.7) 7.1". Then begin decreasing for the top of the hat. Make left-leaning (dec-l) and right-leaning (dec-r) decreases before and after each marker.

### Decreasing for the top

Place 4 markers with 24 (28) 32 sts between each of them. Begin at the BOR. Decrease on the first rnd of the pattern as follows: K2tog (dec-r), work pattern until next marker, \*k2tog tbl (dec-l), slip marker, k2tog (dec-r); repeat from \* another 2 times. Work pattern until the last marker, k2tog tbl (dec-l). You have now decreased a total of 8 sts. Continue decreasing on every other rnd until 16 (16) 16 sts remain. Cut off the yarn and pull the tail through the 16 (16) 16 remaining sts.

### Pattern

Rnd 1: \*p2, k2; repeat from \* to end.

Rnd 2: \*k1, p2, k1; repeat from \* to end.
