MATERIALS

Honey Bunny 1 skein of color 124 1 skein of color 05 1 skein of color 40 1 skein of color 22 1 skein of color 82

Crochet hook 4.5 mm / US H/8 Safety eyes 12 mm Stuffing Stitch markers Scissors Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

Honey Bunny, Hobbii
100% Polyester
100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

Mc-magic circle Sc-single crochet Inc-increase Dec-decrease Flo-front loop only Blo-back loop only Ss-slip stitch St-stitch

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS Approx. 30 cm / 12" tall

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is written in continuous rounds. Do not join rounds unless specifically stated.

When a color change is introduced, the pattern will simply state the color before those stitches. Continue using the color stated until another color is written.

After sewing each piece on, tie off and weave in ends unless specifically stated.

Pattern



INFO AND TIPS

The decreases and increases are staggered in order to not get a line or bend where we are in- or decreasing stitches, making the look smoother.

This pattern is written in continuous rounds. Do not join rounds unless specifically stated.

When a color change is introduced, the pattern will simply state the color before those stitches. Continue using the color stated until another color is written.

Legs (make 2)

Row 1: black mc 6sc (6) Row 2: Inc in each (12) Row 3: sc in each st (12) Row 4: (dec, 2sc)x3 (9) Row 5-14: (blue) sc in each st (9) (10 rows) For first leg join with ss and finish off Don't cut the yarn when you finish the second leg!

From second leg, chain 2 and join to first leg with a sc, put a stitch marker in this st as it will be the beginning of row 15 and the beginning of the body.

Body

Row 15: 9sc in the first leg, 2sc in 2ch, 9sc in second leg, 2sc in ch2 (22) Row 16: (red) sc in each st (22) Row 17: 4sc, inc, 10sc, inc, 6sc (24) Row 18-21: sc in each st (24) (4 rows) Row 22: (6sc, dec)x3 (21) Row 23-26: sc in each st (21) (4 rows) Row 26: (5sc, dec)x3 (18) Stop here to stuff legs and body



Row 27: (dec, sc)x6 (12) Row 28: beige sc in each st (12) Row 29: (Inc, sc)x6 (18) Row 30: (sc, Inc, sc)x6 (24) Stop here to stuff the neck firmly so it will not flop when the head is finished Row 31: (3sc, Inc)x6 (30) Row 32: (sc, Inc, 3sc)x6 (36)

Row 33-38: sc in each st (36) (6rows) **Insert safety eyes in between rows 35 and 36 and approx 4 stitches apart**

Row 39: (sc, dec, 3sc)x6 (30) Row 40: (3sc, dec)x6 (24) Row 41: (sc, dec, sc)x6 (18) Stop here to stuff the head Row 42: (dec, sc)x6 (12) Row 43: dec in each st (6) Join with ss and finish off

Arms (make 2)

Row 1: beige mc 6sc (6) Row 2: (Inc, sc)x3 (9) Row 3: sc in each st (9) Row 4: (sc, dec)x3 (6) Row 5-10: red sc in each st (6) (6 rows) Join with ss and finish off

Hat

Row 1: mc 6sc (6) Row 2: Inc in each st (12) Row 3: (Inc, sc)x6 (18) Row 4: (sc, Inc, sc)x6 (24) Row 5: (3sc, Inc)x6 (30) Row 6: (sc, Inc, 3sc)x6 (36) Row 7: Blo sc in each st (36) Row 8-14: sc in each st (36) Row 15: (11sc, Inc)x3 (39) Row 16: Flo 12sc, chain 1 turn, in 2nd st from hook, 12sc. Join with ss and finish off. Stuff lightly so the rim remains flat and secure.

Feather (red)

Chain 9, turn. In 3rd st from hook 2dc, hdc, 4sc. Join with ss and finish off



Button (yellow)

Row 1: mc 8sc (8) Join with ss and finish off
