Nelly Newt

MATERIALS

Friends Cotton 8/4

2 skeins of color 122

1 skein of color 31

1 skein of color 54

Crochet hook 3.00 mm / US D/3 2 safety eyes, 6 mm Wool needle A piece of black yarn for the mouth Stuffing Stitch marker

YARN QUALITY

Friends cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100 % Cotton 50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 174 yds

GAUGE

Across first 7 rounds = 5 cm / 2"

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dec = decrease

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

htr = half treble crochet

sl st = slip stitch

rep = repeat

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 28 cm / 11"

INFO AND TIPS

This pattern is worked in continuous rounds, there is no sl st join, use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round.

Head

Round 1: Using grey 6 sc into magic ring (6 sts)

Round 2: *Sc 2 in next st* 6 times (12 sts)

Round 3: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next st* 6 times (18 sts)

Round 4: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 2 sts* 6 times (24 sts)

Round 5: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 3 sts* 6 times (30 sts)

Round 6: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 4 sts* 6 times (36 sts)

Round 7: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 5 sts* 6 times (42 sts)

Round 8: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 6 sts* 6 times (48 sts)

Round 9-16: Sc in each st around

Round 17: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts* 6 times (42 sts)

Round 18: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts* 6 times (36 sts)

Round 19: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 4 sts* 6 times (30 sts)

Round 20: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 3 sts* 6 times (24 sts)

Round 21: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts* 6 times (18 sts)

Round 22: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 1 sts* 6 times (12 sts)

Round 23: Sc in each st around

You have now completed the head, do not fasten off, place safety eyes between rows 13-14, 9 sts apart, stuff the head and continue to work the body.

Body

Round 24: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next st* 6 times (18 sts)

Round 25: Sc in each st around, finished stuffing head and neck area

Round 26: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 2 sts* 6 times (24 sts)

Round 27: *Sc 2 in next st. sc in next 3 sts* 6 times (30 sts)

Round 28: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 4 sts* 6 times (36 sts)

Round 29: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 5 sts* 6 times (42 sts)

Round 30-47: Sc in each st around



You have now completed the body, do not fasten off, stuff the body and continue to work the legs.

Legs

Round 48: Sc across the body to the 22nd st from hook, sc in each st around (21 sts)

Round 49-70: Sc in each st around, begin to stuff the head

Round 71: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts* 3 times (18 sts)

Round 72: *Dec over next 2 sts, sc in next st* 6 times (12 sts)

Round 73: *Dec over next 2 sts* 6 times (6 sts)

Fasten off, finish stuffing the head, using tail weave through last 6 stitches to close the hole.

Re-join yarn to round 47.

Round 48: Sc in each st around (21 sts)

Rep instructions from 49 for other leg.

Sew the hole between legs up by weaving yarn in and out in a circle.





Arms

Make 2

Round 1: Using grey 6 sc into magic ring (6 sts)

Round 2: *Sc 2 in next st* 6 times (12 sts)

Round 3: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next st* 6 times (18 sts)

Round 4-26: Sc in each st around

Round 27: Fold the tops of arms together and sc across the top (9 sts)

Sew the arms to the body on row 26 either side of the body.

Chest

Round 1: Using orange 6 sc into magic ring (6 sts)

Round 2: *Sc 2 in next st* 6 times (12 sts)

Round 3: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next st* 6 times (18 sts)

Round 4: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 2 sts* 6 times (24 sts)

Round 5: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 3 sts* 6 times (30 sts)

Round 6: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 4 sts* 6 times (36 sts)

Round 7: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 5 sts* 6 times (42 sts)

Round 8: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 6 sts* 6 times (48 sts)

Round 9: *Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 7 sts* 6 times (54 sts)

Fasten off.



Align the centre of the chest to the centre of the body and sew it on to the body, stitching along the edge.

Crest

Make 2

Row 1: Using orange 77 ch

Row 2 (RS): *Dc 3 in each of next 4 sts, dc in next st, dc 3 in next st, dc in next 4 sts* 7 times, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next st, sl st in last st (145 sts)

Place the crests on top of each other with the wrong sides facing outwards. Sew together.



Tail

Round 1: Using grey 6 sc into magic ring (6 sts)

Round 2: *Sc 2 in next st* 6 times (12 sts)

Round 3: Sc 2 in next st, sc to last st, 2 sc in last st (14 sts)

Round 4: Sc in each st around

Rep rounds 3-4 eight more times.

Round 21: Sc 2 in next st, sc in next 12 sts, dec over next 2 sts twice, sc in next 12 sts, sc 2 in

next st (30 sts)

Round 22: Sc in each st around

Rep rounds 21-22 3 more times.

Round 29: Sc in next 7 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, htr in next 4 sts, dc in next 2 sts, sc in next 11 sts.

Fasten off and stuff leaving the last 4 rows unstuffed. Sew across the top and then sew to the body 4 rows up from the legs.

Sew the crest to the back body starting from the point of the tail and wide end of crest, ending at the head, be sure to lay the crest flat as you sew.









Cheeks

Round 1: Using pink 6 sc into magic ring (6 sts) Round 2: *Sc 2 in next st* 6 times (12 sts)

Fasten off.

Sew the cheeks onto either side of the head, 11 sts apart. Sew the mouth in between the cheeks.
