MATERIALS Small Basket

1 skein of **Amigo Giga** color White (01) 1 skein of **Amigo Giga** color Mint (29) 1 skein of **Amigo Giga** color Pool Green (30)

Basket Bottom - Round - Plywood 22 cm/ 8.7"

Large Basket

3 skeins of Amigo Giga color Primrose (35)2 skeins of Amigo Giga color Sunflower (36)2 skeins of Amigo Giga color White (01)

Bag / Basket Base - Round - PU leather 30cm / 11.81"

Crochet hook 6 mm Stitch marker

Yarn QUALITY

Amigo Giga, Hobbii
100% Acrylic
150 g / 5.3 oz = 95 m / 103 yds

GAUGE

12 sts x 12 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4 x 4" in pattern

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 17 (30) cm / 6.7" (11.8") Circumference: 73 (98) cm /28.75" (38.5")

PATTERN INFORMATION

These baskets are inspired by the vichy fabric, a nice vintage chequered pattern but that always inspires. An homage to my country, France, and to my love of weaving.

Created with the Amigo Giga Yarn, for a soft and solid result, the pattern is very easy to make. You will crochet around a base, and after the first two rounds, you will repeat the same round over the whole height and turn after each round. This model is perfect for beginners who would like to learn or improve the technique of color changes, and carry Yarn. Photos for learning all of these techniques are included for these techniques.

ABBREVIATIONS

st = stitch(es) ch = chain sc = single crochet spike = single crochet extended sl st = slip stitches inc = crochet 2 single crochet in same st/hole RS = right side WS = wrong side

INFO AND TIPS

You will start crocheting around a base. After the first two rounds, you will repeat the same round over the whole height and turn after each round to work on the right and wrong sides. Ch 1 at the beginning of a round doesn't count as a st. You'll always close the round by slip stitching in the first st of the round. (see pictures) Weave in ends as you go.

SPECIAL STITCH

A spike stitch is a regular single crochet but instead of working it into the st of the previous row, you'll work 2 rows below.





SMALL BASKET

Yarn A: Mint (29) Yarn B: Pool Green (30) Yarn C: White (01)

R1 (RS): Insert your hook in one of the holes from the base. Make a slip knot with Yarn A and pull it through the hole. Place Yarn B above Yarn A and ch1 with Yarn A, catching Yarn B (doesn't count as 1 st).



Continue with Yarn A and carry Yarn B (see "how to"). 1 sc in the same hole, 1 sc in next hole, inc in next, 1 sc in next.

*Change to Yarn B (see "how to") and work inc next hole, 1 sc in next, inc in next. ** Change to Yarn A and work 1 sc in next 2 holes, inc in next, 1 sc in next hole * Repeat from * to * all around, finish at **.

Change to Yarn A, sl st in the first sc, change to Yarn B by ch1. Turn (see "how to") (total: 70sts, you must have 5 sts in Yarn A following by 5 sts in Yarn B)

R2 (WS): *With Yarn B, work 1 sc in the next 5 sts, change to Yarn A and work 1 sc in next 5 sts.* Repeat from * to * all around. You must crochet with Yarn B in the stitches color B and with Yarn A in stitches color A. With Yarn A sl st in first st and ch1. Turn (see "how to")

R3 (RS): *With Yarn A, work (1 spike (see "SPECIAL STITCH"), 1 sc) x2, 1 spike. Change to Yarn B, (1 sc, 1 spike) x 2, 1 sc* Repeat from * to * all around. Change to Yarn A, sl st in the first sc, change to Yarn B by ch1. Turn

R4 (WS): it's the same as R3 but start with Yarn B. *With Yarn B, work (1 spike, 1 sc) x2, 1 spike. Change to Yarn A, (1 sc, 1 spike) x 2, 1 sc* Repeat from * to * all around. SI st in first st and ch1 with Yarn A. Turn

R5 and R6: Repeat R3 and R4.

In the end of R6, you must anticipate the color changes and work the last ch1 with Yarn C, fasten off Yarn B.

R7 (RS): it's the same as R3 but with other colors. *With Yarn C, work (1 spike, 1 sc) x2, 1 spike. Change to Yarn A, (1 sc, 1 spike) x 2, 1 sc* Repeat from * to * all around. Change to Yarn C, sl st in the first sc, change to Yarn A by ch1. Turn

R8 (WS): it's the same as R3 but start with Yarn A. *With Yarn A, work (1 spike, 1 sc) x2, 1 spike. Change to Yarn C, (1 sc, 1 spike) x 2, 1 sc* Repeat from * to * all around. SI st in first st and ch1 with Yarn C. Turn



R9 to 10: Repeat R7 and R8.

In the end of R10, you must anticipate the color changes and work the last ch1 with Yarn A, fasten off Yarn C.

R11 to 22: Repeat R3 to R10 once again and R3 to R6 one last time or until your desired height.

R23: Carrying and crossing the Yarns. On RS, work with Yarn A, 4 sl st, *change to Yarn B work 5 sl st, change to Yarn A, 5 sl st* Repeat from * to * all around until the last color block. Finish with Yarn B, work 5 sl st, sl st in the first st to join. Fasten off and weave in ends.

BIG BASKET

Yarn A: Primrose (35) Yarn B: Sunflower (36) Yarn C: White (01)

R1 (RS): Insert your hook in one of the holes from the base. Make a slip knot with Yarn A and pull it through the hole. Place Yarn B above Yarn A and ch1 with Yarn A, catching Yarn B (doesn't count as 1 st). See "small basket"

Continue with Yarn A and carry Yarn B (see "How to"). 1 sc in the same hole, inc in next, 1 sc in next hole, inc in next.

*Change to Yarn B (see "how to") and work (1 sc in next, inc in next) x 2. ** Change to Yarn A and work (1 sc in next hole, inc in next) x2 * Repeat from * to * all around, finish at **. Change to Yarn A, sl st in the first sc, change to Yarn B by ch1 Turn (see "how to"). (total: 108 sts, you must have 6 sts in Yarn A following by 6 sts in Yarn B)

R2 (WS): *With Yarn B, work 1 sc in the next 6 sts, change to Yarn A and work 1 sc in next 6 sts.* Repeat from * to * all around. You must crochet with Yarn B in the stitches color B and with Yarn A in stitches color A. With Yarn A sl st in first st and ch1 (see "how to") Turn

R3 (RS): *With Yarn A, work (1 spike (see "how to"), 1 sc) x3. Change to Yarn B, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3* Repeat from * to * all around. Change to Yarn A, sl st in the first sc, change to Yarn B by ch1. Turn

R4 (WS): it's the same as R3 but start with Yarn B. *With Yarn B, work (1 spike, 1 sc) x3. Change to Yarn A, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3* Repeat from * to * all around. SI st in first st and ch1 with Yarn A. Turn

R5 to R8: Repeat R3 and R4.

In the end of R8, you must anticipate the color changes and work the last ch1 with Yarn C, fasten off Yarn B.

R9 (RS): it's the same as R3 but with other colors. *With Yarn C, work (1 spike, 1 sc) x3. Change to Yarn A, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3* Repeat from * to * all around. Change to Yarn C, sl st in the first sc, change to Yarn A by ch1. Turn

R10 (WS): it's the same as R3 but start with Yarn A. *With Yarn A, work (1 spike, 1 sc) x3. Change to Yarn C, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3* Repeat from * to * all around. SI st in first st and ch1 with Yarn C. Turn



R11 to R14: Repeat R9 and R10.

In the end of R14, you must anticipate the color changes and work the last ch1 with Yarn A, fasten off Yarn C.

R15 to 32: Repeat R3 to R14 once and R3 to R8 once more.

R33 (Handles): With Yarn C, *work (1 spike, 1 sc) x3. Change to Yarn A*, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3 Repeat from * to *. Then work the handles like this:



Cross the Yarns



Grab the Yarn of the current color



Ch1



Cross the Yarns and Ch4, crossing the Yarns each time



Change to Yarn C and ch6, crossing the Yarns each time



Change to Yarn A and ch1. Skip 2 blocks (12 sts).

Work *with Yarn A, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3, change to yarn C, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3*, repeat from * to * 2 more times, change to Yarn A, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3, change to yarn C. Work a second handle as the first one, ch5, change to Yarn A, ch 6. *Change to yarn C, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3, change to Yarn A, (1 spike, 1 sc) x 3* repeat once. Change to Yarn C, sl st in the first sc, change to Yarn A by ch1. Turn





R34 to R38: Repeat R10 to R14.

Note about R34: work in pattern all around, work 1 sc in each ch of the handle, with the corresponding color.

Note about R35: work in pattern all around. When working a spike stitch on the handle, insert the hook in the chain under the corresponding sc.

R39 (RS): Carrying and crossing the Yarns. On RS, work with Yarn C, 5 sl st, *change to Yarn A work 6 sl st, change to Yarn C, 6 sl st* Repeat from * to * all around until the last color block. Finish with Yarn A, work 6 sl st, sl st in the first st to join. Fasten off and weave in ends

HOW TO CARRY THE YARN



To carry the Yarn you must crochet over the Yarn you want to carry. This is the result on the wrong side.



Insert hook in next st, the Yarn to carry above the hook. Grab the current Yarn with hook and finish the stitch as usual, working over the Yarn. The picture shows when you work on the right side. Hold the Yarn on the back of your work.



The picture shows when you work on the wrong side. Work as the right side but hold the Yarn on the front of your work.



HOW TO CHANGE COLOR



Pull lightly the Yarn you are carrying. Do not over-tighten or the circumference will shrink



This is to prevent the Yarn to be visible on the wrong side. Like here.



In the last st before changing color, insert hook, yo with current color and pull through



On the right side, place the current Yarn on the back of the work



On the wrong side, place the current Yarn on the front of the work



Yo with the new color and pull through the 2 loops on hook

HOW TO CLOSE THE ROUND IN RS



Change Yarn on the last st of the rounds



Sl st in the first sc



Change to Yarn B by ch1 and turn



HOW TO CLOSE THE ROUND IN WS



Do not change color this time, work 1 sl st in the first stitch of the round



Then, ch1 and turn.
