Fingerless Mitts

MATERIALS

1 skein of **Diablo Wild Print** col. 22, Desert Fox
1 skein of **Friends Extra Fine Merino** col. 04, Cream

Circular needle 4.0 mm, 50 cm /US 6, 20"
Tapestry needle
Scissors
Measuring tape
2 locking stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Diablo Wild Print**, Hobbii
40% Acrylic, 30% Mohair, 30% Polyamide
25 g / 0.9 oz = 225 m / 246 yds

 **Friends Extra Fine Merino**, Hobbii
100% Superwash Merino Wool
50 g / 1.75 oz = 165 m / 180 yds

GAUGE

24 sts x 34 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
p = purl
pm = place marker
RS = right side
st = stitch
WS = wrong side

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 20 cm / 8"
Length: 27 cm / 10.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Keep the winter chill at bay with the super cute Willow Fingerless Mitts. These extra long wrist warmers keep you cozy while leaving your fingers free for texting, snacking, and even a little bit more knitting. Luxurious fibers make an appearance as a multicolored laceweight mohair blend meets the warmth of extra fine merino wool. A darling bow adds the final touch of whimsy to channel your inner fashionista while battling the elements.

INFO AND TIPS

Worked flat to allow for a thumb opening if you want to wear them as fingerless mitts.

These mitts can be knit two at a time. If you opt to do so, do each of the instructions twice, once on each mitt.

2x2 rib: *k2, p2; repeat from * to end of row.

I-cord: Cast on 5 stitches with a long-tail cast-on. Do not turn. Slide the stitches to the other end of the needle. *With yarn in back, knit 1 row, do not turn, slide the stitches to the other end of the needle; repeat from * until you reach the desired length.

CONSTRUCTION

Cast on 48 sts using stretchy cast-on method of your choice (for example, long-tail or Jeny's Surprisingly Stretchy Cast On).

Work in 2x2 rib for 7.5 cm / 3".

Knit 2 rows (this will create a purl bump on the RS).

Work in stockinette stitch for 14 cm / 5.5".

Work in 2x2 rib for 5 cm / 2"

Bind off using stretchy bind-off method of your choice.

I-CORD EMBELLISHMENT

Make two 43 cm / 17" I-cords, leaving a 12 cm / 5" tail at the beginning and end of each.

Left mitt: Lay first mitt RS up with the cast-on edge closest to you. Beginning at the right edge of the purl ridge, count to the left across 10 purl stitches, pm, count across another 6 purl stitches, pm (there should be 32 purl stitches remaining from the second marker to the left edge).

Thread one I-cord down through the stitch to the right of the right-hand marker, then back up through the stitch to the left of the left-hand marker. Tie I-cord into a bow.

Thread each of the two I-cord tails through the body of the mitt, 6 cm / 2.5" toward the bound-off edge.

Whip stitch each tail into the WS of the fabric to tack down the ends of the bow.

Right mitt: Repeat as for left mitt EXCEPT begin at the left edge of the purl ridge and count to the right.



SEAMING

For wrist warmers: Using mattress stitch, sew side seam from cast-on edge to bound-off edge.

For fingerless mitts: Using mattress stitch, sew side seam for 16.5 cm / 6" from cast-on edge, leave a 5 cm / 2" gap for the thumb opening, then continue seaming to bound-off edge.

Block with light steam iron.

Enjoy your dual use wrist warmers/fingerless mitts!
