## MATERIALS

### Friends Cotton 8/4

- 1 skein in color 03 (A)
- 1 skein in color 83 (B)
- 1 skein in color 09 (C)
- 1 skein in color 37 (D)
- 1 skein in color 60 (E)

Crochet hook 3.25 mm / US D/3  
Scissors  
Tapestry needle  
Steam blocking supplies

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii  
100 % Cotton  
50 g / 1.75 oz = 160 m / 174 yds

## GAUGE

19 sts x 22 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

## ABBREVIATIONS

Cc = change color  
Ch = chain  
Dc = double crochet  
Hdc = half double crochet  
Sc = single crochet  
Sk = skip  
Sl st = slip stitch  
Sp = space  
St = stitch

Crocheted using the inset mosaic technique, this cloth gives you a dynamic motif pattern without the drawbacks of traditional mosaic construction. Colors are carried up the side of the work, leaving you with less ends and more time to admire your amazing skills. Customize your cloth by changing the border color or rearranging your color palette.

# Pattern



## UNDERSTANDING INSET CROCHET

- This inset crochet pattern is worked with two rows of each color. Change color at the end of the row, and do not cut any colors until instructed. Instead, carry colors up the side of the work.
- All rows start with a single crochet BEFORE the first pattern repeat, and end with a single crochet AFTER the last pattern repeat.
- Odd number rows are the Right Side, and even number rows are the Wrong Side.
- Always work into both loops of the stitch.
- Stitches marked with an **X** are a double crochet worked in the skipped stitch 3 rows down. Work in front of the chain spaces and catch both loops of the skipped stitch.
- The mosaic pattern is worked from a chart. Right-handed stitchers should work from the bottom-right corner – RS rows are read right to left, and WR rows are read left to right. Left-handed stitchers should work from the bottom-left corner – RS rows are read left to right, and WS rows are read right to left.

## TOWEL PATTERN

**STEP 1:** With A, ch 66. Begin chart at Row 1. Complete Rows 1 and 2 with Color A. Cc to B at end of Row 2. DO NOT FASTEN OFF color A. Alternate colors every 2 rows.

**STEP 2:** Continue through the chart as follows:

1. ROWS 1-14: Work Chart Rows 1-14 with Colors A & B. Fasten off A at end of last row.
2. ROWS 15-28: Work Chart Rows 15-28 with Colors B & C. Fasten off B at end of last row.
3. ROWS 29-42: Work Chart Rows 1-14 with Colors C & D. Fasten off C at end of last row.
4. ROWS 43-56: Work Chart Rows 15-28 with Colors D & E. Fasten off D at end of last row.
5. ROWS 57-70: Work Chart Rows 1-14 with Colors E & A. Fasten off E at end of last row.
6. ROWS 71-84: Work Chart Rows 15-28 with Colors A & B. Fasten off A at end of last row.



7. ROWS 85-98: Work Chart Rows 1-14 with Colors B & C. Cc to preferred Border color at end of Row 98.

**STEP 3:** Weave in all ends.

**STEP 4:** Make Border.

**ROUND 1:** Ch 1, hdc in first st and each st across row, ch 2, rotate to work along row ends, hdc in each row end, ch 2, rotate to work along starting chain, hdc in each st across row, ch 2, rotate to work along row ends, hdc in each row end, ch 2, sl st in first hdc of row.

**ROUND 2:** Ch 1, sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> loop of each st to ch-2 sp, (sc, ch 8, sc) in ch-2 sp (*hanging loop made*), \*sl st in 3<sup>rd</sup> loop of each ch to next ch-2 sp, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-2 sp; rep from \* around. Fasten off. Join with invisible slip stitch ([tutorial](#)).

**STEP 4:** Weave in any remaining ends. Steam block your towel to finished dimensions.
