## MATERIALS


2 skeins of Unicorn color: Free (06) **(A)**  
1 skein of Unicorn Solid in the following colors:

Hazel (22) **(B)**  
Green Tea (26) **(C)**  
Cream (01) **(D)**  
Mustard (20) **(E)**

Crochet hook 3.5 mm

## YARN QUALITY

 **Unicorn**, Hobbii  
75% Wool, 25% Polyamide  
100 g = 400 m

 **Unicorn Solid**, Hobbii  
75% Wool, 25% Polyamide  
100 g = 400 m

## GAUGE

22 sts x 13 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4" in dc

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 45 cm / 18"  
Length: 215 cm / 85"

Whether you are looking for an elegant shawl to colour an outfit or an oversized scarf for a lot of comfort and warmth, Johanna shawl is made for you! Wrap yourself in softness with this beautiful shawl with a geometric pattern created thanks to the crochet log cabin technique. It is an easy model to make. All in double crochets, with some variations to add texture. Play with colors to make it completely your own.

## ABBREVIATIONS

sts = stitch(es)  
 ch = chain  
 tch = turning chain  
 sc = single crochet  
 dc = double crochet  
 tc = treble crochet  
 dec = work 2 sts together  
 blo = back loop only  
 flo = front loop only  
 sk = skip  
 sp = space  
 RS = right side  
 WS = wrong side

## INFO AND TIPS

Ch4 count as tc

The number of sts are important, make sure to count them regularly. Especially before a section change.

Weave in ends as you go.

All the pictures are Right Side facing.

## MAKE TWO IDENTICAL PIECES

### SECTION 1

With yarn A,

**R1:** in a magic ring, ch4 (count as 1tc, here and throughout), work 5dc, ch3, 5dc, 1tc. Turn (6 sts per side + 1 ch3-sp)

**R2:** Ch4, (2dc flo in same st as ch4), 1 dc flo in each st to the middle ch3-sp, (2dc, ch3, 2dc) in the middle ch3-sp. 1 dc flo in each st to the last st, (2 dc, 1tc) in the 4th tch. Turn (10 sts per side + 1 ch3-sp)

**R3:** Ch4, (2dc blo in same st as ch4), \*ch1, sk1, 1 dc blo in next st\* repeat until 1 st left before middle ch3-sp, ch1, sk1, (2dc, ch3, 2dc) in the middle ch3-sp, repeat \*\* until 2 sts left. Ch1, sk1, (2 dc, 1tc) in the 4th tch. Turn (9 sts, 5 ch1-sp per side, 1 ch3-sp)

**R4:** Ch4, (2dc in same st as ch4), 1dc in next st, \*ch1, sk1, 1dc in next ch-sp\* repeat until 2 sts left before middle ch3-sp, ch1, sk1, 1dc in next st, (2dc, ch3, 2dc) in the middle ch3-sp, 1dc in next st, repeat \*\* until 3 sts left. Ch1, sk1, 1dc in next st, (2 dc, 1tc) in the 4th tch. Turn (12 sts, 6 ch1-sp per side, 1 ch3-sp)

**R5:** Ch4, (2dc blo in same st as ch4), 1dc blo in each st and ch (work in the ch and not around), until middle ch3-sp, (2dc, ch3, 2dc) in the middle ch3-sp, 1dc blo in each st and ch (work in the ch and not around) until 1 st left. (2 dc, 1tc) in the 4th tch. Turn. (22 sts per side, 1 ch3-sp)

**R6 to R10:** repeat R2 to R5 once, then R2 one last time. Change to yarn B in last st.

For this section you worked 10 rows and you have 42 sts per side and 1ch3-sp.

## SECTION 2

With yarn B, RS facing

**R1:** Ch4, (2dc blo in same st as ch4), 1dc blo in each st until middle ch3-sp, 1dc in middle ch3-sp. Turn (45 sts)

**R2:** ch3 (count as 1dc here and throughout), 1dc in each st until 1st left. (2 dc, 1tc) in the 4th tch. Turn. (47 sts)

**R3:** Ch4, (2dc in same st as ch4), 1dc in each st across. Turn. (49 sts)

**R4 to R9:** repeat R2 and R3 three times. Change to yarn C in last st after R9 and do not turn.

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 61 sts for this section.



## SECTION 3

With yarn C, RS facing

**R1:** ch3, work 1dc around the first dc row end, 2dc around the next and all the dc rows ends (see picture below) of section 2 (you must have 18dc on section 2), work 1dc in ch3-sp from section 1, 1dc blo in each st from section 1 until 1 st left, (2 dc, 1tc) in the 4th tch. Turn (63 sts)



Working around the dc rows ends

**R2:** Ch4, (2dc in same st as ch4), 1dc in each st across. Turn. (65 sts)

**R3:** ch3, 1dc in each st until 1st left. (2 dc, 1tc) in the 4th tch. Turn. (67 sts)

**R4 to R9:** repeat R2 and R3 three times. Change to yarn D in last st after R9 and turn.

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 79 sts for this section.



## SECTION 4

With yarn D, WS facing.

**R1:** Ch4, dec flo twice, 1dc flo in each st to the end of the row. Turn. (77 sts)

**R2:** ch3, 1dc in each st until 5 sts left, dec twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn. (75 sts)

**R3:** Ch4, dec twice, 1dc in each st to the end of the row. Turn. (73 sts)

**R4 to R9:** repeat R2 and R3 three times. Change to yarn E in last st after R9 and do not turn.

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 61 sts for this section.



## SECTION 5

With yarn E, WS facing.

**R1:** ch3, work 1dc around the first dc row end, 2dc around the next and all the dc rows ends of section 3 and section 4 (you must have 18dc on section 3 and 18dc on section 4), work 1dc flo in each st from section 2 until 5 sts left, dec twice. Turn (95 sts)

**R2:** Ch4, dec twice, 1dc in each st to the end of the row. Turn. (93 sts)

**R3:** ch3, 1dc in each st until 5 sts left, dec twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn (91 sts)

**R4 to R9:** repeat R2 and R3 three times. Change to yarn A in last st after R9 and turn.

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 79 sts for this section.



## SECTION 6

With yarn A, RS facing.

**R1:** Ch4, dec blo twice, 1dc blo in each st until 1st left in previous section, (1dc, ch3, 1dc) in the last st (it's a ch3, a tch so work in the 3rd ch), work 1dc around the first dc row end, 2dc around the next and all the dc rows ends of previous section (you must have 18dc in this section), 1dc blo in each st from section 4 until 5 sts left, dec blo twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn (77 sts per side, 1 ch3-sp)

**R2:** Ch4, dec flo twice, 1 dc flo in each st to the middle ch3-sp, (2dc, ch3, 2dc) in the middle ch3-sp. 1 dc flo in each st until 5 sts left, dec flo twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn (77 sts per side + 1 ch3-sp)

**R3:** Ch4, dec blo, ch1, sk1, dec blo, \*ch1, sk1, 1 dc blo in next st\* repeat until 1 st left before middle ch3-sp, ch1, sk1, (2dc, ch3, 2dc) in the middle ch3-sp, repeat \*\* until 7 sts left. \*Ch1, sk1, dec blo\* repeat \*\* twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn (40 sts, 37 ch1-sp per side, 1 ch3-sp)

**R4:** Ch5 (count as 1tc + ch1), sk 1dc, dec over the next 2 ch1-sps (skipping the dc between), \*ch1, sk 1dc, 1dc in next ch1-sp\* repeat until 2 sts left before middle ch3-sp, ch1, sk1, 1dc in next st, (2dc, ch3, 2dc) in the middle ch3-sp, 1dc in next st, repeat \*\* until 4 sts and 2 ch1-sps left. Ch1, sk1, dec over the next 2 ch1-sps (skipping the dc between), ch1, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn (40 sts, 37 ch1-sp per side, 1 ch3-sp)

**R5:** Ch4, dec blo over the first ch1-sp and next dc twice (don't forget that the first ch1-sp is between the first tc and dc), 1dc blo in each st and ch (work in the ch and not around), until middle ch3-sp, (2dc, ch3, 2dc) in the middle ch3-sp, 1dc blo in each st and ch (work in the ch and not around) until 3sts and 2 ch-sps left. (Don't forget that the last ch1-sp is between the dc and the tch from the previous row), dec blo over the next dc and ch-sp twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn. (77 sts per side, 1 ch3-sp)

**R6 to R10:** repeat R2 to R5 once, then R2 one last time. Change to yarn D in last st.

For this section you worked 10 rows and you have 77 sts per side and 1 ch3-sp.



## SECTION 7

RS facing, yarn D

**R1:** Ch4, dec blo once, 1 dc blo in each st until middle ch3-sp. Work 1 dc in middle ch3-sp. Turn (77 sts)

**R2:** Ch3, 1dc in each st until 5 sts left, dec twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn (75 sts)

**R3:** Ch4, dec twice, 1dc in each st until the end of the row. Turn (73 sts)

**R4 to R9:** Repeat R2 and R3 three times. Change to yarn E in last st after R9 and do not turn

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 61 sts for this section.



## SECTION 8

RS facing, yarn E

**R1:** Ch3, work 1dc around the first dc row end, 2dc around the next and all the dc rows ends of section 7 (you must have 18dc on section 7), work 1dc in ch3-sp from section 6, 1dc blo in each st from section 6 until 3 sts left, dec blo once, tc in the 4th tch. Turn (95 sts)

**R2:** Ch4, dec twice, 1dc in each st until the end of the row. Turn (93 sts)

**R3:** Ch3, 1dc in each st until 5 sts left, dec twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn (91 sts)

**R4 to R9:** Repeat R2 and R3 three times. Change to yarn B in last st after R9 and do not turn.

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 79 sts for this section.



## SECTION 9

WS facing, yarn B

Repeat section 4 BUT change to yarn C in last st after R9 and do not turn.

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 61 sts for this section.



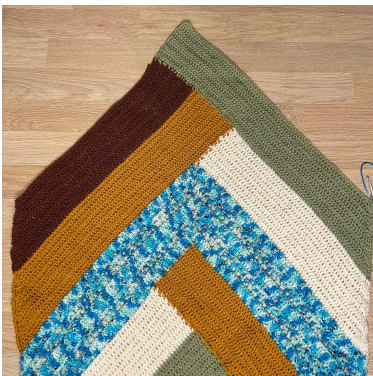


## SECTION 10

WS facing, yarn C

Repeat section 5 BUT change to yarn A in last st after R9 and do not turn.

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 79 sts for this section.



## SECTION 11

RS facing, yarn A

Repeat section 6 BUT do not change yarn and fasten off

For this section you worked 10 rows and you have 77 sts per side and 1 ch3-sp.



## SECTION 12

WS facing, with D. Join the yarn in the tch so join in the 4th ch from tch.

**R1:** Ch4, dec flo once, 1 dc flo in each st until middle ch3-sp. Work 1 dc in middle ch3-sp. Turn (77 sts)

**R2:** Ch3, 1dc in each st until 5 sts left, dec twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn (75 sts)

**R3:** Ch4, dec twice, 1dc in each st until the end of the row. Turn (73 sts)

**R4 to R9:** Repeat R2 and R3 three times. Change to yarn E in last st after R9 and do not turn

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 61 sts for this section.



## SECTION 13

WS facing, yarn E

**R1:** Ch3, work 1dc around the first dc row end, 2dc around the next and all the dc rows ends of section 12 (you must have 18dc on section 12), work 1dc in ch3-sp from section 11, 1dc flo in each st from section 11 until 3 sts left, dec flo once, tc in the 4th tch. Turn (95 sts)

**R2:** Ch4, dec twice, 1dc in each st until the end of the row. Turn (93 sts)

**R3:** Ch3, 1dc in each st until 5 sts left, dec twice, 1tc in the 4th tch. Turn (91 sts)

**R4 to R9:** Repeat R2 and R3 three times. Change to yarn A in last st after R9 and do not turn.

For this section you worked 9 rows and you have 79 sts for this section.



## SECTION 14

RS facing, yarn A

Repeat section 6. Fasten off and make your second piece.

For the second piece, do not fasten off, enlarge the loop and proceed to seam



## ASSEMBLY AND BORDER

*Assembly*

Lay flat your two pieces, the right side facing you and the flat edges against each other. Sew the middle of the shawl together stitch by stitch with the corresponding color.



### *Border*

Now you'll work the border. Retake the loop you left from the last st with the right side facing.

Ch1, \*2 sc in first st, 1 sc in each st until ch3-sp, 3 sc into it, 1 sc in each st until end of the row. 2 sc in the last st and turn to work in the ends of the rows. Work sc around each tc and tch, changing color each time to work with the color of the corresponding row. The number of sc depends on your tension. I recommend working around 3 or 4 sections and see if the work curls or shrinks to adapt the number of sc if necessary. I work 3 sc around each end of rows until the end of the long side.\*. Repeat from \* to \*, weaving the ends as you go. Finish with 1 sl st in first st.
