MATERIALS


Highland Wool

1, 1, 1, 1 skein of col. 10
1, 1, 1, 2 skein(s) of col. 09
1, 2, 2, 2 skein(s) of col. 07
2, 2, 3, 3 skeins of col. 05
3, 3, 5, 5 skeins of col. 03

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G/6

Other: needle and white thread

YARN QUALITY

 **Highland Wool**, Hobbii
100% Peruvian Highland Wool,
50 g / 1.75 oz = 175 m / 191 yds

GAUGE

1 square = 13 cm x 13 cm / 5" x 5"

ABBREVIATIONS

yo = yarn over
ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
dc3tog = 3 dc crochet together
hdc sl st = half double crochet slip stitch
tc = treble crochet
Rep = repeat

SIZE

(S/M), L/ XL, 2XL/3XL, 4XL/5XL

MEASUREMENTS

Width: (51), 76, 89, 93 cm / (20"), 30", 35",
36.5"

Length: 52 cm / 20.5"

Adjust the length by incorporating extra rows of squares.

PATTERN INFORMATION

This slipover is created using individual crocheted squares, each designed to form a gradient illusion, transitioning from a deep black center to a milky white outer edge. You'll learn how to crochet a half double crochet slip stitch (hdc sl st) and how to create the pixel fade square motif. The pattern is ideal for intermediate crocheters, but a detailed photo guide is included, making it accessible even for adventurous beginners. Whether you're looking to expand your crochet skills or create a stylish and unique garment, this pattern provides clear instructions for success.

INFO AND TIPS

You have flexibility in adjusting the slipover's length by incorporating extra rows of squares.

SQUARE PATTERN

S-M: make 24 squares

L-XL: make 38 squares

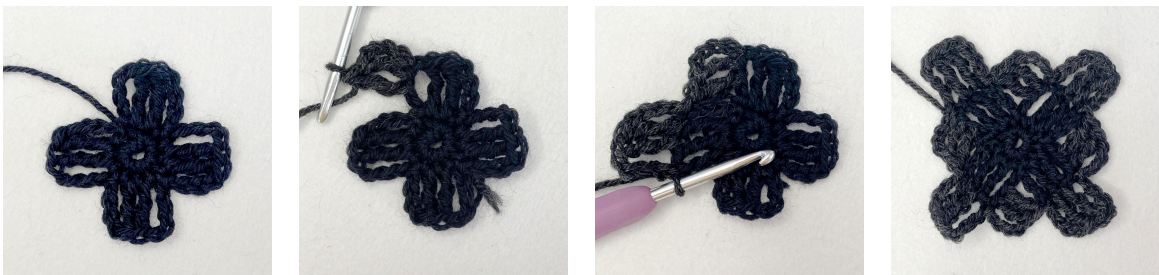
2XL-3XL: make 50 squares

4XL-5XL: make 54 squares.

Round 1 (col. 10): Make a magic ring, ch 1, 12 sc into the circle, join with sl st to the first sc.

Round 2 (col. 10): * Ch 4, tc in next 2 sc, ch 4, sl st in next sc **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round. Cut the yarn. 4 blocks.

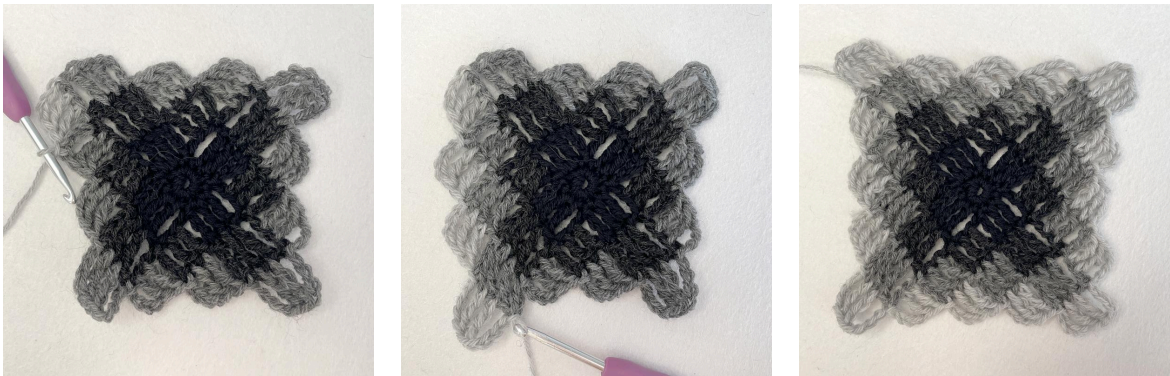
Round 3 (col. 09): Connect the yarn to top of the last ch 4, * ch 4, tc in next 2 chs, connect with sl st to top of next ch 4, ch 4, tc in next 2 tc, ch 4, sl st in the top of the next ch 4 **, rep from * to ** three times. Cut the yarn. 8 blocks.



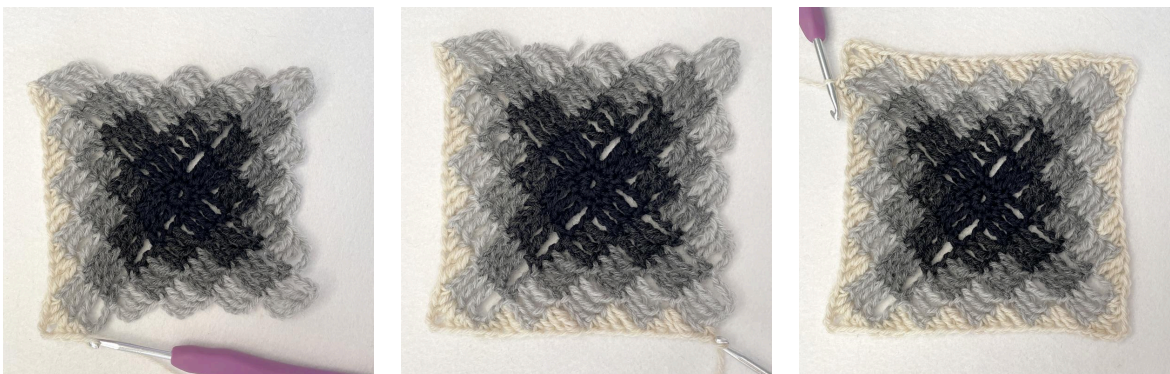
Round 4 (col. 07): Connect the yarn to top of the last ch 4, * ch 4, tc in next 2 chs, connect with sl st to top of next ch 4, ch 4, tc in next 2 tc, sl st in the top of the next ch 4, ch 4, tc in next 2 tc, ch 4, sl st in the top of the next ch 4 **, rep from * to ** three times. Cut the yarn. 12 blocks.



Round 5 (col. 05): Connect the yarn to top of the last ch 4, * ch 4, tc in next 2 chs, connect with sl st to top of next ch 4, (ch 4, tc in next 2 tc, sl st in the top of the next ch 4) twice, ch 4, tc in next 2 tc, ch 4, sl st in the top of the next ch 4 **, rep from * to ** three times. Cut the yarn. 16 blocks.



Round 6 (col. 03): Connect the yarn to top of the last ch 4, ch 1, sc in same ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tc in next ch, (sc in the top of next ch 4, hdc in next tc, dc in next tc, tc in same tc) three times, * sc in the top of next ch 4, hdc in same ch, dc in next tc, ch 2, dc in same tc, hdc in next tc, sc in same tc, sc in next top of ch 4, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tc in next ch, (sc in the top of next ch 4, hdc in next tc, dc in next tc, tc in same tc) three times **, rep from * to twice, sc in the top of next ch 4, hdc in same ch, dc in next tc, ch 2, dc in same tc, hdc in next tc, sc in same tc, join with sl st to the first sc.

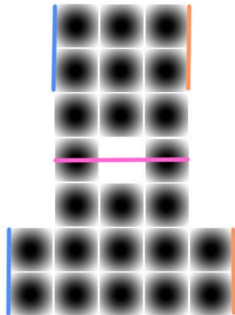


Connect all the squares from the wrong side through the back loops only with a needle and white thread according to the schemes and your size.

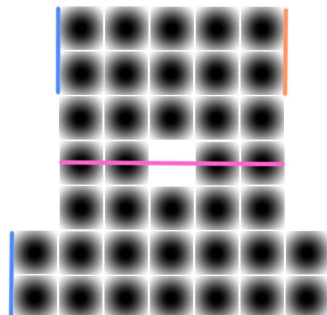


Pink lines = shoulder lines
Orange and blue lines = side seams.

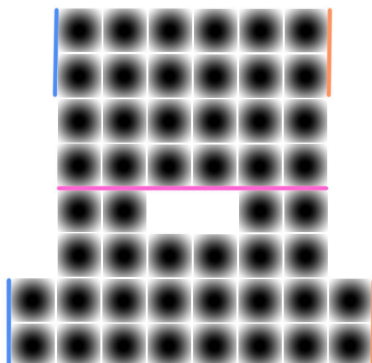

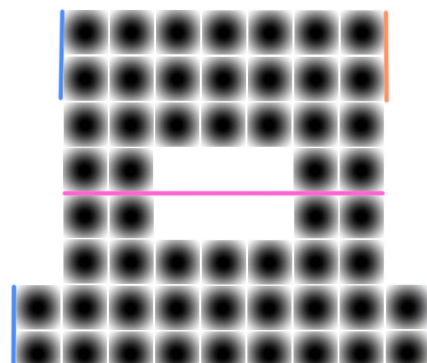

4XL-5XL



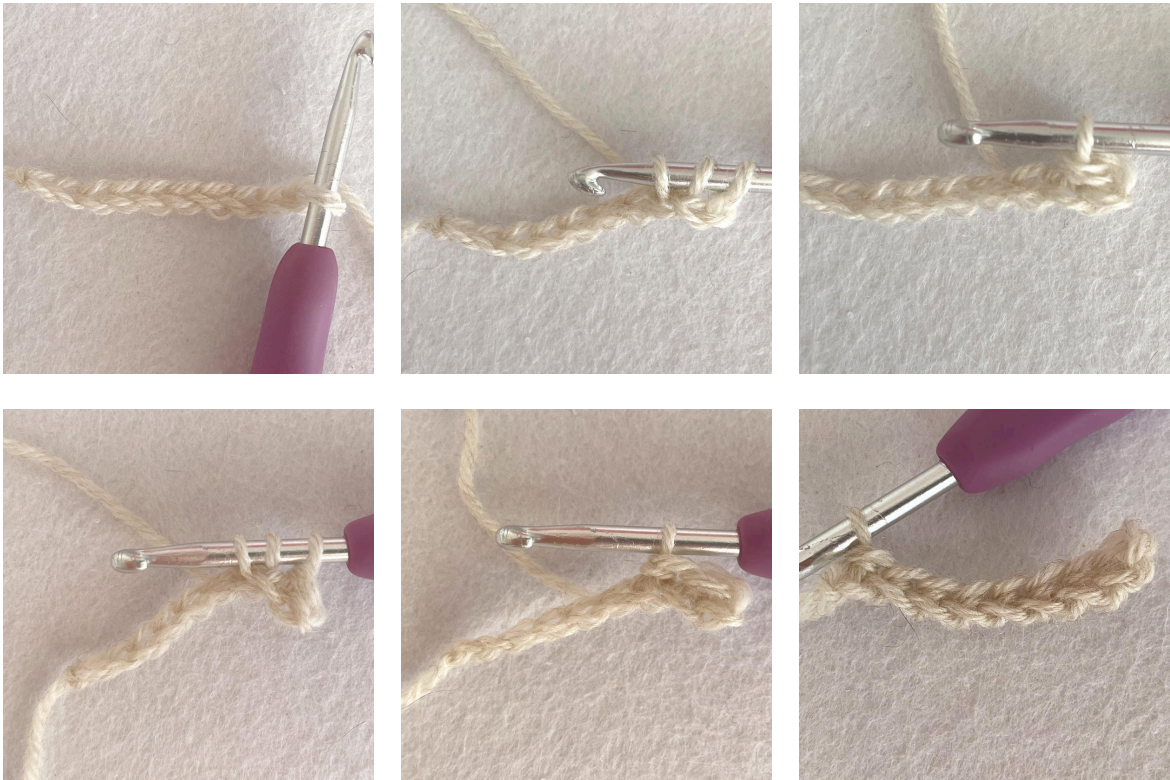
Make a row of single crochet (sc) around the bottom, neckline, and armholes. In each corner (where 3 squares are joined), work a dc3tog (double crochet 3 together). Be sure to place one stitch in each corner.

Elastic Band

Half Double Slip Stitch (or Yarn Over Slip Stitch) YO, insert your hook through the back loop only, YO, pull up a loop and pull directly through two loops on hook.

NOTE: the thickness of the elastic band depends on the number of chains, the length of the elastic band depends on the number of rows.

Row 1: Ch 9, hdc sl st in the second ch from the hook, hdc sl st in each ch to the end of the row.



Row 2: Ch 1 (turning chain, don't count as a stitch), turn, hdc sl st in the back loop only to the end of the row.



Repeat Row 2 until you reach the desired length.



Sew elastic bands to the bottom, neckline and armholes through the back loop only with a needle and thread.

Cut the yarn after you sew the elastic band to the bottom, armholes and neckline, it will allow you to regulate the length of the band in the process of sewing.

Make a row of sc around elastic bands to achieve the narrow look of it. Connect the yarn to any rib (through the two loops) from the wrong side of the band to the second outer stitch (photo 1). Work sc in each stitch around, join with sl st to the first stitch. Notice the difference between the version without the sc row (photo 2) and with the sc row (photo 3).
