



CROCHET PATTERN

Snowdrop

Kerchief

MATERIALS

2 skeins of **Friends Extra Fine Merino**, color 52

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G/6

Scissors
Tapestry needle
Locking stitch marker
Wet blocking supplies

YARN QUALITY

Friends Extra Fine Merino, Hobbii 100 % Wool 50 g / 1.75 oz = 165 m / 180 yds

GAUGE

6 tr sts x 12 rows = 15 cm x 15 cm / 6" x 6"; stitch gauge measured over a Row 7 repeat

ABBREVIATIONS

Tr = treble crochet

Ch = chain
Dc = double crochet
Hdc = half double crochet
Pic = picot (see Special Stitches)
Sk = skip
Sl St = slip stitch
Sp = space
St(s) = stitch(es)
Tch = turning chain

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 103 cm / 40.5" Length: 60 cm / 23.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Liven up a chilly winter day with the beauty and elegance of the Snowdrop Kerchief. This mini-shawl gets its charm from a beginner-friendly crochet lace pattern worked from the bottom up. The arched picot border is the perfect finishing touch. Style your kerchief as a scarf with a belted trench coat, or tie it in your hair as a bandana for a whimsical addition to your everyday outfit.

SPECIAL STITCH

Picot (pic): ch 3, sl st in the first chain made Shell (shell): (3dc, ch 1, 3dc) in the same stitch

PATTERN NOTES

- Starting ch-4 = dc + ch 1
- Starting ch-7 = tr + ch 3

SHAWL PATTERN

ROW 1: Ch 4, (2dc, ch 1, 3dc) in 4th ch from hook, turn. *(1 shell)*

ROW 2: Ch 7, (sc, ch 3, sc) in ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in 3rd ch of tch, turn.

ROW 3: Ch 4, shell in st at base of ch, sk next ch-3 sp, sc in the following ch-3 sp, (shell, ch 1, dc) in 4th ch of tch, turn. (2 shells)

ROW 4: Ch 7, sk first ch-sp and next 3dc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in next sc, ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in 3rd ch of tch, turn.

ROW 5: Ch 4, shell in st at base of ch, sc in next ch-3 sp, shell in next tr, sc in next ch-3 sp, (shell, ch 1, dc) in 4th ch of tch, turn. (3 shells)

ROW 6: Ch 7, sk first ch-sp and next 3dc, [(sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in next sc, ch 3] 2 times, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-sp, ch 3, tr in 3rd ch of tch, turn.

ROW 7: Ch 4, shell in st at base of ch, sc in next ch-3 sp, (shell in next tr, sc in next ch-3 sp), 2 times, (shell, ch 1, dc) in 4th ch of tch, turn. (4 shells)

ROW 8: Ch 7, sk first ch-sp and next 3dc, [(sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr I next sc, ch 3] 3 times, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in 3rd ch of tch, turn.

ROW 9: Ch 4, shell in st at base of ch, sc in next ch-3 sp, (shell in next tr, sc in next ch-3 sp), to tch, (shell, ch 1, dc) in 4th ch of tch, turn.



ROW 10: Ch 7, sk first ch-sp and next 3dc, [(sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr I next sc, ch 3] to last shell, sk 3 dc, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in 3rd ch of tch, turn.

ROWS 11-48: Repeat Rows 9-10.

ROW 49: Repeat Row 9. (25 shells)

ROW 50: Ch 7, sk first ch-sp and 3dc, (sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in next sc, ch 3) to last shell, sk 3dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, tr in last ch-sp, turn. Do not fasten off.

BORDER

SETUP ROUND (RS):

- Part 1 Ch 1, sc in st at base of ch, 2sc in next ch-sp, (sc in next sc, 2sc in next ch-sp, sc in next tr, 2sc in next ch-sp) across row, placing the last sc in 4th ch of tch, rotate to work along Row Ends. (51 sc)
- Part 2 **Ch 1**, (3sc around next tr, 2sc around next dc) to tip of shawl, 3sc in tip of shawl. Rotate to work along next Row Ends. (128 sc)
- Part 3 (2sc around next dc, 3sc around next tr) to next corner, ch 1, sl st in first sc of round, turn. (125 sc)

Rows 1 and 2 are worked across the bottom sides of the shawl. There are no more stitches worked along the top of the shawl.

ROW 1 (WS): Ch 1, sc in ch-sp, mark sc just made, sc in next sc, (ch 5, sk 3, sc in next st) 63 times, sc in next ch-1 sp, turn.

ROW 2 (RS): Ch 1, sk 2 sc, (sc 2, hdc 1, dc 1, pic, dc 1, hdc 1, sc 2) in each ch-5 sp to last 2 sc, sl st in each of the last 2 sc of the row (last sl st goes into marked st). Remove marker. Fasten off.

FINISHING

- Weave in all ends.
- Wet block to final dimensions.
