



CROCHET PATTERN

Penguin and Polar Bear

Reversible Toy

MATERIALS

Honey Bunny

1 skein of col White (01)

1 skein of col Black (124)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US/J10)

Safety eyes 9 mm or black cotton yarn for the eyes

A piece of scrap orange yarn for the beak

A piece of scrap pink yarn for the cheeks

YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny**, Hobbii

100% Polyester

100 g (3.50 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 8 sts x 9 rws

ABBREVIATIONS

Sc = single crochet

Mr = magic ring

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Sl st(s) = slip stitch(es)

Ch = chain

SIZES

One size

MEASUREMENTS

10 cm (4")

PATTERN INFORMATION

The reversible toy Penguin and Polar Bear is crocheted in one piece. When you have finished crocheting the toy and sewn the pieces on, you can tuck one animal inside the other.

You decide whether you prefer to add safety eyes or embroider the eyes with a small piece of scrap cotton yarn.

If you decide to add safety eyes, make sure you use ones that are large enough to fit properly without falling out of the holes. I recommend a minimum of 9 mm, this depends on your gauge.

I recommend embroidering the eyes if the toy is to be used by children under 3 years old.

INFO AND TIPS

The toy is a "2-in-1 reversible toy" that is crocheted in one piece, and then one animal is tucked inside the other so that only one animal is visible at a time. When changing color to white at the penguin's eyes, don't carry the yarn along on the round as the white yarn will show through the black stitches.

PENGUIN



Body

Using black

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: *2 sc in one st* (12)

Rnd 3: *1 sc, 2 sc in one st* (18)

Rnd 4: *2 sc, 2 sc in one st* (24)

Rnd 5: 2 sc (black), 2 sc (white), 3 sc (black), 2 sc (white), 15 sc (black) (24)

Rnds 6-8 (3 rounds): 1 sc (black), 4 sc (white), 1 sc (black), 4 sc (white), 14 sc (black) (24)

Change color to black and weave in the white yarn

Rnds 9-12 (4 rounds): 1 sc in each st (24)

If you use safety eyes, attach them between rnds 7 and 8.

Embroider the beak between rnds 8 and 9.

Now crochet the polar bear as follows:

POLAR BEAR



Body

Rnd 13 (change color to white): 1 sl st in each st (24)

Rnd 14: 1 sc in the back loop of each sl st (24)

Rnds 15-22 (8 rounds): 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 23: *2 sc, sc2together* (18)

Rnd 24: *1 sc, sc2together* (12)

If you use safety eyes, attach them between rnds 20 and 21

Rnd 25: *Sc2together* (6)

Fasten off and sew the last 6 stitches closed.

Ear x 2

Rnd 1 (white): 6 sc in a mr (6)

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew the ears on to the body.

Snout

Rnd 1 (white): 3 sc in a mr (3)

Rnd 2: *2 sc in one st* (6)

Rnds 3-4: 1 sc in each st (6)

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew it on to the body.

Embroider with black on the tip of the snout.

Assembly

I think that you should sew the different pieces on to the toy in the way you think looks best, I did as follows:

Polar Bear

Sew the ears on between rnds 23 and 24.

Embroider eyes or attach safety eyes.

Sew the snout on between rnds 17 and 18

Embroider with pink under the eyes on both animals and black eyebrows on the polar bear.
