



CROCHET PATTERN

Bunny and Chicken

Reversible Toy

MATERIALS

1 skein of **Honey Bunny** col Silver (118)
1 skein of **Honey Bunny** col Pastel Yellow (21)
1 skein of **Toucan** col Peach (08)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US/J10)
Safety eyes 9 mm or black scrap yarn for eyes

YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny**, Hobbii
100% Polyester
100 g (3.50 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

 **Toucan**, Hobbii
100% Polyester
100 g (3.50 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 8 sts x 9 rws

ABBREVIATIONS

Sc = single crochet
Mr = magic ring
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Sl st(s) = slip stitch(es)
Ch = chain
Dc = double crochet
Hdc = half double crochet

SIZES

One size

MEASUREMENTS

10 cm (4")

PATTERN INFORMATION

The reversible toy Bunny and Chicken is crocheted in one piece. When you have finished crocheting the toy and sewn the pieces on, you can tuck one animal inside the other.

You decide whether you prefer to add safety eyes or embroider the eyes with a small piece of scrap cotton yarn.

If you decide to add safety eyes, make sure you use ones that are large enough to fit properly without falling out of the holes. I recommend a minimum of 9 mm, this depends on your gauge.

I recommend embroidering the eyes if the toy is to be used by children under 3 years old.

INFO AND TIPS

The toy is a "2-in-1 reversible toy" that is crocheted in one piece, and then one animal is tucked inside the other so that only one animal is visible at a time.

CHICKEN



Wings x 2

Using Honey Bunny color pastel yellow (05)

Ch 5, turn and begin in the 2nd ch from the hook, 3 hdc, 1 sl st, continue on the other side, 3 hdc

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew the wings on to the head.

Body

Using Honey Bunny col pastel yellow (05)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: *2 sc in one st* (12)

Rnd 3: *1 sc, 2 sc in one st* (18)

Rnd 4: *2 sc, 2 sc in one st* (24)

Rnds 5-12 (8 rounds): 1 sc in each st (24)

If you use safety eyes, attach them between rdns 6 and 7.

Don't break off the yarn. Now crochet the bunny as follows:

BUNNY



Body

Using Honey Bunny color silver (118)

Rnd 13 (change color to gray): 1 sl st in each st (24)

Rnd 14: 1 sc in the back loop of each sl st (24)

Rnds 15-22 (8 rounds): 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 23: *2 sc, sc2together* (18)

Rnd 24: *1 sc, sc2together* (12)

If you use safety eyes, attach them between rnds 20 and 21.

Rnd 25: *Sc2together* (6)

Fasten off and sew the last 6 stitches closed.

Ear x 2

Using Honey Bunny color silver (118)

Ch 10, turn and begin in the 3rd ch from the hook, 5 hdc, 2 sc, 1 sl st, continue on the other side, 2 sc, 4 hdc, 2 hdc in the last, end with a sl st.

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew the ears on to the body.

Assembly

I think that you should sew the different pieces on to the toy in the way you think looks best, I did as follows:

Chicken

Make the cockscomb as follows: Attach Toucan yarn color Peach (08), ch 6, sl st in same sc, repeat 5 times.



Sew the wings on between rnds 7 and 8.
Embroider eyes or attach safety eyes.
Embroider the beak with Toucan color Peach (08)

Bunny

Sew the ears on between rnds 24 and 25.
Embroider eyes or attach safety eyes.
Embroider the snout with Toucan color Peach (08).
