



CROCHET PATTERN

Cow and Pig

Reversible Toy

MATERIALS

Honey Bunny

- 1 skein of col Hint of Pink (50)
- 1 skein of col White (01)
- 1 skein of col Black (124)
- 1 skein of col Nougat (09)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US/J10)

Safety eyes 9 mm or black scrap yarn for eyes

YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny**, Hobbii

100% Polyester

100 g (3.50 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 8 sts x 9 rws

ABBREVIATIONS

Sc = single crochet

Mr = magic ring

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Sl st(s) = slip stitch(es)

Ch = chain

* * = repeat

SIZES

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 10 cm (4") (when folded in half)

PATTERN INFORMATION

The reversible toy Cow and Pig is crocheted in one piece. When you have finished crocheting the toy and sewn the pieces on, you can tuck one animal inside the other.

The pattern is beginner-friendly and is easy and quick to make.

You decide whether you prefer to add safety eyes or embroider the eyes with a small piece of scrap cotton yarn.

If you decide to add safety eyes, make sure you use ones that are large enough to fit properly without falling out of the holes. I recommend a minimum of 9 mm, but this depends on your gauge.

I recommend embroidering the eyes if the toy is to be used by children under 3 years old.

Pattern



INFO AND TIPS

The toy is a "2-in-1 reversible toy" that is crocheted in one piece, and then one animal is tucked inside the other so that only one animal is visible at a time.

Pig

Ear x 2

Col Hint of Pink (50)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: *1 sc, 2 sc in one st *(9)

Rnd 3: *1 sc, 2 sc in one st* (12)

Rnd 4: *2 sc, 2 sc in one st* (15)

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew the ears on to the head.

Snout

Col Hint of Pink (50)

Rnd 1: 8 sc in a mr (8)

Rnd 2: 1 sl st in each st (8)

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew the trunk on.

Embroider nostrils on the snout.

Body

Col Hint of Pink (50)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: *2 sc in one st* (12)

Rnd 3: *1 sc, 2 sc in one st *(18)

Rnd 4: *2 sc, 2 sc in one st* (24)

Rnds 5-12 (8 rounds): *1 sc in each st *(24)

Now crochet the cow as follows:

Cow

Body

Rnd 13 (change color to White (01)): 1 sl st in each st (24)

Rnd 14: 1 sc in the back loop of each sl st (24)

Rnds 15-22: 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 23: *2 sc, sc2together* (18)

Rnd 24: *1 sc, sc2together* (12)

Rnd 25: *Sc2together* (6)

Fasten off and sew the last 6 stitches closed.

Ear x 2

Begin with Col Hint of Pink (50)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Change color to White (01)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st (12)

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew the ear on to the body.

Horn x 2

Col Nougat (09)

Rnd 1: 4 sc in a mr (4)

Rnds 2-3: 1 sc in each st (4)

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew the horn on to the body.

Snout:

Col Nougat (09)

Ch 4, turn and begin in the 2nd ch from the hook:

1 sc, 3 sc in the last ch, continue on the other side of the chain, 2 sc, 2 sc in the last ch.

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew the snout on to the body.

Embroider nostrils.

Spot x 3:

Col Black (124)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Fasten off with sufficient yarn to sew the spots on to the body.

Assembly

Sew the different pieces on to the toy in the way you think looks best. I did as follows:

Pig

Press the ears flat to form a triangle, sew them on to the head between rnds 2 and 5.

Sew the snout on between rnds 6 and 9.

Embroider eyes or attach safety eyes.

Cow

Sew the horns on between rnds 23 and 24.

Sew the ear together at the bottom so that it folds in half and sew each of them on between rnds 22 and 21.

Sew the snout on between rnds 16 and 17.

Sew 2 spots on on the front and 1 spot on the back.
