MATERIALS

Friends Cotton Silk

1 skein in color 51 (A)

1 skein in color 03 (B)

2 skeins in color 21 (C)

Crochet hook 4 mm / US F/6 Scissors Tapestry needle Steam blocking supplies

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton Silk, Hobbii 78 % Cotton, 22% Silk 50 g / 1.75 oz = 120 m / 131 yds

GAUGE

6 clusters x Rows 1-8 = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Measurements taken with bag laid flat Width: 29 cm / 11.5"

Length: 32 cm / 12.5" Handle drop: 23 cm / 9"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Why buy a project bag when you can make the perfect one?! The Camellia Bag is a granny bucket bag made with three alternating colors of luxuriously soft Cotton Silk yarn. The sturdy handle is made with simple Tunisian crochet techniques. Thoughtful assembly and finishing steps add a necessary polish to elevate this handmade bag into something truly special.

ABBREVIATIONS

Cc = change color

Ch(s) = chain(s)

Ch-sp = chain space

Clu = cluster (see Special Stitches)

Dc = double crochet

Dc2tog = double crochet 2 together

Inc = increase (see Special Stitches)

Lts = Last Tunisian Stitch (see Special Stitches)

MR = magic ring

RetP = return pass (see Special Stitches)

RS = right side

Sc = single crochet

Sk = skip

Sl st = slip stitch

Sp(s) = space(s)

St(s) = stitch(es)

Tch = turning chain

Tss = Tunisian simple stitch

WS = wrong side

Yo = yarn over

SPECIAL STITCHES

- Cluster (clu): (3dc, ch 1) in same ch-sp
- Increase (inc): (3dc, ch 1) 2 times in the same ch-sp
- Join: sl st in the 3rd ch of the tch, sl st in each of the next 2 dc, sl st into the next ch-sp and pull up the loop with the next color
- Last Tunisian Stitch (*Lts*): insert hook under BOTH vertical bars of the last stitch and complete as for Tss
- Return Pass (RetP): Ch 1, (yarn over, pull through next 2 loops) until 1 loop remains on hook

PATTERN NOTES

Starting ch-3 counts as first dc of round.



- Do not fasten off any colors until instructed throughout pattern.
- Portions of this pattern are written in crochet shorthand. For example, 2dc means to place 2 double crochet stitches in the same space.

BAG BODY

ROUND 1: With A, (ch 3, 2dc, ch 1, clu x 4) in MR, join and cc to B. (5 clusters)

ROUND 2: With B, (ch 3, 2dc, ch 1, clu) in first ch-sp, inc in each ch-1 sp around, join and cc to C. (10 clusters)

ROUND 3: With C, (ch 3, 2dc) in first ch-sp, ch 1, (inc in next ch-1 sp, clu in next ch-1 sp) to last ch-1 sp, inc in last ch-1 sp, join and cc to A. (15 clusters)

Continue changing color at the end of each round in established A-B-C pattern throughout Bag Body.

ROUND 4: (Ch 3, 2dc) in first ch-sp, ch 1, clu in each ch-1 sp around, join. (15 clusters)

ROUND 5: (Ch 3, 2dc) in first ch-sp, ch 1, clu in next ch-1 sp, inc in next ch-1 sp, (clu in each of the next 2 ch-1 sps, inc in next ch-1 sp) around, join. (20 clusters)

ROUND 6: (Ch 3, 2dc, ch 1, clu) in first ch-sp, clu in each of the next 3 ch-1 sps, (inc in next ch-1 sp, clu in each of the next 3 ch-1 sps) around, join. (25 clusters)

ROUND 7: (Ch 3, 2dc) in first ch-sp, ch 1, clu in each ch-1 sp around, join. (25 clusters)

ROUND 8: (Ch 3, 2dc) in first ch-sp, ch 1, clu in next ch-1 sp, inc in next ch-1 sp, (clu in each of the next 4 ch-1 sps, inc in next ch-1 sp) around, clu in each of the last 2 sps, join. (30 clusters)

ROUND 9: (Ch 3, 2dc) in first ch-sp, ch 1, clu in each of the next 4 ch-1 sps, (inc in next ch-1 sp, clu in each of the next 5 ch-1 sps, inc in next ch-1 sp) around, join. (35 clusters)

ROUND 10: (Ch 3, 2dc) in first ch-sp, ch 1, 3dc in each ch-1 sp around, join.

From here, there are no longer ch-1 sps between clusters. Instead, work 3dc in the sps between 3dc groups.

ROUNDS 11-29: (Ch 3, 2dc) in first sp, 3dc in each sp around, join and cc to next color. Continue to Side A at the end of Round 29.

SIDE A

COLOR CHANGES: You will continue in the established color pattern. Fasten off the two colors not currently in use. When you add the new colors in, leave colors attached to work and carry them up the sides of the rows.

Work in the space between 3dc groups.



ROW 1 (RS): Ch 3, dc2tog over same sp and next sp, dc in 2^{nd} sp of dc2tog, (3dc in next sp) 6 times, dc in next sp, dc2tog over same sp and next sp, dc in 2^{nd} sp of dc2tog, cc to next color, turn. (8 – 3dc groups)

ROW 2 (WS): Ch 3, sk the first 3dc group, (3dc in next sp) 7 times, dc in top of tch, cc to next color, turn. (7 – 3dc groups)

ROW 3: Ch 3, sk the first 3dc group, (3dc in next sp) 6 times, dc in top of tch, cc to next color, turn. (6 – 3dc groups)

ROW 4: Ch 3, sk the first 3dc group, (3dc in next sp) 5 times, dc in top of tch, cc to next color, turn. (5 – 3dc groups)

ROW 5 (RS): Ch 3, 2dc in sp at base of ch, (3dc in next sp) 4 times, 2dc in tch-sp, dc in top of tch. (6 – 3dc groups)

Fasten off all colors.

SIDE B

With RS facing, return to the end of Side A, Row 1. Skip 7 unworked sps. With next color in sequence, sl st into the following sp.

Repeat Rows 1-5 of Side A, continuing to change color in established pattern. Fasten off all colors at the end of Row 5.

Weave in all ends.

Proceed to border.

BORDER

ROUND 1: With C, join with a standing sc (<u>tutorial</u>) in the side of any dc. Sc around the entire top edge as follows –

- For Row Ends, 2sc around each dc
- For Stitches, sc in each dc

Join with a sl st in the first sc of the round. Fasten off.

TABS

Return to Side A with the RS facing. Locate the 16 sc sts at the center of the short side. Insert hook into the first of the 16 sts. Pull up a loop with color A.

ROW 1: Ch 8, pull up a loop in the 2nd ch from the hook and each of the remaining ch (8 loops on hook), pull up a loop in the st at the base of the ch (9 loops on hook), (yo, pull through 2 loops on hook) until 2 loops remain, yo with next color, pull through last 2 loops on hook.



ROW 2: Tss across row, pull up a loop in next sc, (yo, pull through 2 loops on hook) until 2 loops remain, yo with next color, pull through last 2 loops on hook.

Continue changing color at the end of each row in established A-B-C pattern.

ROWS 3-16: Repeat Row 2. Do not change color at the end of Row 16.

BIND OFF: SI st in each stitch across the row. SI st in the same sc as Row 16. Fasten off, leaving a 25.5 cm / 10" tail. Fasten off other colors.

ASSEMBLY: Weave in all ends *except* the 25.5 cm / 10" tail. Fold the Tab in half with RS facing out. Using the long tail, seam the long side of the tab to the sc at the base of the tab. *DO NOT WEAVE THE SHORT ENDS TOGETHER*. Weave in the final end.

Proceed to Side B and repeat all Tab instructions.



STRAPS

Lay your bag flat with the Tabs resting atop one another. Determine which side will be the Front and which side will be the Back. Use the image below to orient yourself as you proceed with the straps.

Back of Bag



STRAP A Using C, join with a sl st in the back loop $+ 3^{rd}$ loop of any sc in the approximate area as indicated in the image.

ROW 1: Ch 8 loosely, pull up a loop in the 2^{nd} ch from the hook and each of the remaining ch (8 loops on hook), pull up a loop in the back loop + 3^{rd} loop of the st at the base of the ch (9 loops on hook), (yo, pull through 2 loops on hook) until 1 loop remains on hook.



ROW 2: Tss across row (8 loops on hook), pull up a loop in the back loop + 3rd loop of the next sc (9 loops on hook), (yo, pull through 2 loops on hook) until 1 loop remains on hook.

Repeat Row 2 until you reach the short ends of the next Tab. Continue in Strap pattern, working 3 rows of Tss along the short sides of the Tab and be sure to work through both thicknesses.

After Tab is complete, continue to work in Tunisian simple stitch over 9 stitches for 70 rows as follows: Tss each st across to last st, Lts, RetP.

Now we will join to the short ends of the opposite Tab. Continue in Strap pattern, working 3 rows of Tss along the short sides of the Tab and be sure to work through both thicknesses.

Repeat Row 2 until you reach the start of the Strap.

BIND OFF: SI st in each stitch across the row. SI st in the same sc as last row. Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY: Using a long tail, seam the starting chain to the bind off edge. Fold the Strap in half with RS facing. Using the same long tail, seam the long side of the strap to the sc at the base of the tab. For the free rows not anchored to sc stitches, whip stitch the row ends together. Complete these instructions for the entire strap.

STRAP B

Using C, join with a sl st in the back loop $+ 3^{rd}$ loop of any sc in the approximate area as indicated in the image.

Repeat all instructions from Strap A.

FINISHING

- Weave in any remaining ends.
- Steam block bag to finished dimensions. Take care to untwist the straps and pin them flat before steaming.
