# Gizmo Soft Toy

## **MATERIALS**

1 skein of **Toucan** col Cappuccino (30) 1 skein of **Honey Bunny** col Black (124)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US/J10)
1 safety nose (16 mm)
2 safety eyes (16 mm)
Fiberfill 300 g
Black and white scrap yarn to embroider around the eyes.

# YARN QUALITY

**Toucan,** Hobbii 100% Polyester 100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

Honey Bunny, Hobbii 100% Polyester 100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

### **GAUGE**

10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4" = 8 st x 9 rows

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

Sc = single crochet
Mr = magic ring
St(s) = stitch(es)
Sl st(s) = slip stitch(es)
Ch = chain st
Rnd = round
Hdc = half double crochet

### **SIZES**

One-size

## **MEASUREMENTS**

Length: 30 cm (12").

## PATTERN INFORMATION

The French Bulldog Gizmo is a tribute to the most loving four-legged friend. Through thick and thin, Gizmo is there for you.

Legs and arms are crocheted directly onto the body to minimize assembly work afterwards.

I recommend embroidering the eyes if the toy is to be used by children under 3 years old.

# **Pattern**







## **INFO AND TIPS**

Start by crocheting arms and legs, then the body. The arms and legs are crocheted directly onto the body, so you don't have to sew them on afterwards. When crocheting on the pieces, crochet through the round on the piece and the body.

## Arm x 2

In col 30

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnds 3-5: (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (12)

Rnd 6: \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (8)

Rnds 7-11: (5 rounds): 1 sc in each st (8)

Stuff the arms, pinch the round together and sl st to close:

Rnd 12: sl st 4 = (4)

Fasten off.

# Leg x 2

In col 30

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc one st\* (18)

Rnds 4-5 (2 rounds): 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 6: 3 sc, (sc2tog x 3), 9 sc (15)

Rnd 7: 2 sc, (sc2tog x3), 7 sc (12)

Rnds 8-11: 1 sc in each st (12)

Stuff tightly, pinch the round together and sl st to close:

Rnd 12: sl st 6 = (6)

Fasten off.



## **Body**

In col 30

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc one st\* (18)

Rnd 4: \*2 sc, 2 sc one st\* (24)

Rnd 5: \*3 sc, 2 sc one st\* (30)

Now crochet the legs onto the body by crocheting through the last round on the legs and the body.

Rnd 6: 6 sc, attach leg (6), 10 sc, attach leg (6), 2 sc (30)

Rnds 7-9 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 10: \*3 sc, sc2tog\* (24)

Rnd 11-14 (4 rounds): 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 15: \*2 sc, sc2tog\* (18)

Rnd 16: 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 17: \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (12)

Now crochet the arms onto the body by crocheting through the last round on the arms and the body.

Rnd 18: 1 sc, attach arm (4), 3 sc, attach arm (4) (12)

Rnd 19: 1 sc in each st (12)

End with a sl st and fasten off with a long thread to sew the head and body together.

Stuff the body.

## Tail

In col 30

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnds 2-3 (2 rounds): 1 sc in each st (6)

Stuff, end with a sl st and fasten off.

## Ear x 2:

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*1 sc, 2 sc one st\* (9)

Rnd 3: \*2 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 4: \*5 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (14)

Rnd 5: \*6 sc. 2 sc in one st\* (16)

Rnd 6: \*7 sc, 2 sc one st\* (18)

Rnds 7-8 (2 rounds): 1 sc in each st (18)

End with a sl st and a long thread to sew the ears onto the head.

# Lower jaw

In col 124

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnds 3-6 (4 rounds) 1 sc in each st (12)



Stuff

End with a sl st and fasten off with a long thread to sew onto the body.

## Head

In col 124

Ch 9, begin in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook:

7 sc, 3 sc in the last ch, continue on the other side of the chain, 6 sc, 2 sc in the last ch (18) Rnd 2: 2 sc in one st, 7 sc, (2 sc in one st) X 3, 6 sc, (2 sc in one st) X 2 (24)

Attach the safety nose between rnds 2 and 3 at the center.

Rnds 3-4: 1 sc in each st (24)

Change col to 30

Rnd 5: 2 sc, (2 hdc in one st) X 6, 16 sc (30)

Rnd 6: 2 sc, (1 hdc in one st, 2 hdc in one st) X 6, 16 sc (36)

Rnds 7-13 (7 rounds): \*1 sc in one st\* (36)

Rnd 14: \*4 sc, sc2tog\* (30) Rnd 15: \*3 sc, sc2tog\* (24)

Attach the safety eyes between rnds 5 and 6 with the snout in the middle of them. Stuff the head <u>but don't stuff the snout</u>, press the snout flat and like an inverted V. Sew the snout around the lower jaw, see the picture guide below.

Rnd 16: \*2 sc, sc2tog\* (18)

Stuff the head but avoid stuffing the snout.

Rnd 17: \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (12)

End with a sl st, stuff one last time, sew the remaining stitches together and weave in the end.







## **Assembly**


Sew the lower jaw onto the head as shown in the picture above.

Crochet eyebrows with sc on rnds 8-9 on the head. To do this attach the yarn with a ch and then insert the hook through the round on the head and catch the "new" thread, which is the one you will use to work the sc. Work approx. 7 sc per eyebrow, see picture guide below.





Sew the ears onto the head between rnds 10 and 13. Shape the ears like a C when sewing them on. Once sewn onto the head, shape the ear further by sewing the lower part of the inner edge to the head, see picture guide below.



Sew the head onto the body so that it looks like Gizmo is lying down and looking forwards. Stuff the body as you go to avoid a wobbly head.

If you like, embroider details around the safety eyes







Sew the tail onto the body between rnds 5 and 7. Embroider black dividing lines on all four paws.
